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# 1. Introduction

## 2. Creatures of the air

### 2.1 Introduction

*A creature appeared and was assigned to our task concerning the creatures of air and wind.*

Windy: Hello, I want you to call me Windy. I am a being of wind and I like the term. I have been appointed to initiate transmissions to the world, regarding beings of air and wind. I am not the only one, others will come after me. My mission is to introduce the subject.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: We welcome you warmly. We look forward to your assignment.

Bartosz: You are a very joyful being. So far I have spoken to less joyful beings.

Windy: I think that is also why I have been appointed, to put you in a good mood with our conversations. There are many beings of nature who are joyful and through contact with me, you should see that too.

Tobias: Please start your message.

Lifts: Let me start by saying that I am a young being of the wind. Air beings can be divided into two main types. These are beings of the air and beings of the wind. Air beings are often referred to as sylphs, whereas wind beings do not have a specific name. Anyway, the terms are often conventional and can be different in each culture. We accept that you should call the beings of the air sylphs.

*After a while.*

Lifts: In addition to the two different types, namely beings of the air and beings of the wind, there are other types that are less known, but these will be told to you by others appointed for this purpose. We are happy to give you knowledge about us.

Bartholomew: In what way will we talk? Will it be similar to the way we had with the beings of earth and fire?

Windy: Yes, I think the way will be similar, however, we will give you advance notice of the topics one or two days in advance that we will be taking up, so that you have time to think about them and then be more proactive when talking to us.

Tobias: Is there anything else you would like to add by way of introduction?

Windy: I wanted to say that there is a great joy among the beings of nature, also the beings of air and wind caused by the fact that humanity will know more about us. We hope to bring human beings closer to us. Remember people, even though we cause a lot of damage with our actions to your homes and other objects, you must know that we have to act this way because it is an expression of God's will. Despite everything, we love you and treat you as brothers. We know that most of your

species is lost, however, we trust that the awakening to love and spirituality will progress in you. Open yourselves to the knowledge and messages we will send to you through this book.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: We look forward to hearing from you! We look forward to hearing from you!

## 2.2 The essence of air - preliminary cognition

*We continued our conversation with Windy that same day.*

Tobias: Windy welcome back! Please start.

Lifts: Hello! There are many species of air beings that we call sylphs. Their main role is to refine the air. Their radiation purifies the air. Their role in creation is invaluable and it is worth every human being to appreciate it. When man goes out for a walk and feels the fresh air, let him realise the truth that the quality of this air is due to the sylphs. Man, unfortunately, causes more work for the sylphs. Man pollutes the air, which the sylphs then have to clean up. It is sad that so few people are aware of this. We love you people, however, the fact that you pollute this planet a lot is your fault and we are fully aware that you will reap the fruits of this.

Bartholomew: How do the sylphs clean the air?

Lifts: their very presence fulfils this task. Where there is a sylph and its radiation, there the process of cleansing the air in its own way takes place. Of course, their dancing movements, which they often undertake, accelerate this process. If man were to see the sylph at least once and its beneficial effect on air quality he would appreciate nature and its children in the form of nature's creatures more.

Tobias: Does the polluted air cause the sylphs any suffering or pain?

Lifts: Above all, the enormous air pollution created by humans builds up pain in the sylphs, as they often see their tremendous effort and work go in vain, which is why sylphs often dislike humans and their environmentally destructive actions. The sylphs would like to work together with humans for the flourishing of the planet, however, at this stage of human development this is impossible.

Bartosz: Would you add anything by way of introduction to cognition about sylphs?

Windy: Yes, I want to add something. Sylphs are wonderful creatures that improve air quality. Their role in creation is invaluable, and so little known among humans. Every sylph knows that their tasks in creation refine and beautify our planet. People, realise that air pollution is actually the cause of many diseases and dysfunctions in humans and animals. Dear people be more aware that air quality must be taken care of. Sylphs alone will not do the job. Here, your commitment is also needed so that your industry and everything you pollute the air with is improved in a more environmentally friendly direction.

## 2.3 The essence of wind - pre-cognition

*We continued our conversation with Windy and moved on to the creatures of the wind.*

Bartosz: Dear Windy, what can you say about the creatures of the wind?

Windy: Finally, something about my species, of which I am a representative.

*After a pause.*

Lifts: Many people probably wonder where the wind comes from and what the role of wind beings is in the process of creating it. Well, we are the initiators of all winds. Our movement is the father of all winds. If there were no wind beings, there would be no winds. Do you have any questions?

Tobias: What is the purpose and role of wind?

Winds: primarily cleansing, but not only. Winds carry climate change and can build or destroy.

Tobias: To build?

Lifts: For example, favourable wind currents can influence better yields. They can carry benefits for any species of tree and, of course, carry seeds to long distances where a plant can later germinate.

Bartosz: How do you initiate the wind? You talk about some kind of movement... Can you describe it?

Windy: Like any species of natural beings, we want to keep some secrets, but I can tell you that our movement, which initiates the wind, is very noble, but I do not have permission to describe it in more detail.

Bartosz: I fully understand you. Is there anything else you want to add?

Lifts: It is also important to know that we too operate under the dictates of God's will. Our movements that initiate the winds are never accidental and, as I said, can build or destroy. This building up and destroying is always in harmony with the justice of God. People should finally see this, that the movements of the winds, as well as of nature as a whole, are not by chance. We see a deeper purpose in our actions and joyfully strive to fulfil it. The goal is always to harmonise with God's will. Here there is no room for any coincidences or any arbitrariness. Every creature of the wind must and even wants to conform to what God's will dictates.

Tobias: As with sylphs, are there many species of wind creatures?

Lifts: There are many species of wind beings that depend on the power of the wind that they can initiate. You must know that there are many powerful beings that can destroy huge cities like houses of cards with their movement. Being aware of this should bring humility in your life towards the forces of nature.

Tobias: Is there anything else you would add?

Lifts: These days, man is increasingly resenting and rebelling against what the wind forces bring. Increasingly, the wind forces bring destruction. Hurricanes, tornadoes, orcas and other actions of the winds destroy human properties. Man must humbly acknowledge the justice of what the winds bring. Very few people, and in many cases no one, recognise the justice of God's laws that also guide



the forces of the wind. We want the world to know the truth that there is no coincidence and anyone who has lost something through the force of the wind has deserved it. The force of nature is ruthless to those who have strayed from the Light. Remember this, people.

Tobias and Bartosz: Thank you!

## 2.4 Guardians of the sylphs and wind creatures

*The next day we continued our conversation in Windy.*

Tobias: Hello Windy! Tell us more today about the care of wind beings and sylphs.

Windy: Today's message will be brief. Just like other beings of nature, sylphs and wind beings have their own guardians. These guardians are a different species to the sylphs and wind beings, and their role is very important in organising the tasks that the individual nature beings receive.

Bartholomew: Is it similar to gnomes in that there are species guardians and sector guardians?

Windy: Yes, it is exactly as you say. One type of caretakers takes care of the development of the beings of a given species, i.e. the elevation of a given species of sylphs, for example. The other type of guardians are the so-called sector guardians, who take care of a particular area and, for example, the tasks that are assigned to the sylphs or wind beings of a particular area. The division of tasks directs the guardians and the guardians themselves have higher superiors, who can also be called guardians.

Bartosz: Is the guardian system similarly pyramidal in other natural beings?

Lifts: Yes, you must know that such an arrangement applies to all the guardians of the individual beings of nature. Each higher caretaker has a larger area or a larger number of beings under them. Such an arrangement is very simple and yet very effective. It makes working in creation and fulfilling tasks a living pleasure. The higher the guardian, the greater the responsibility.

*After a while.*

Windy: We are grateful to our caretakers for working so well with us. If it were not for their reliable and dedicated service there would be chaos throughout creation. Every guardian is a magnificent being who is fully aware of their tasks and their goals. The highest guardians are powerful beings who have insight into the wind and air movements of the entire planet. Contact with them is a great honour for the lower ranked guardians.

Tobias: How often do you talk to your carers?

Windy: A very good question Tobias. I speak to the species guardian extremely rarely, but his comments about elevating my being are very valuable. I last spoke to him probably a month ago. In contrast, I talk to my sector guardian more often. It even happens several times a day, but sometimes there are breaks of several days. Initiating and directing the wind in a given direction and with a given force is the main topic of our conversations. The caretaker knows exactly what God's will is in this regard and gives me guidance. Sometimes there are quiet days, such as today, and I don't

have many tasks. You could say that I have time to rest, but there are days when the wind is supposed to be very intense and then my activity is also more active.

Tobias: And what do you talk about with the species guardian?

Windy: These are details that we don't want to talk about completely, but it's more or less about me developing in line with the direction of my species. We are also evolving and have stages of development shown to us. The purpose of us beings of nature is also to evolve and, as you probably know, our ultimate goal is to return to the circle of essence from which our immortal sparks originate.

Tobias: Is there anything else you would add on this topic at the end?

Windy: You need to know that the caretakers of the different sectors often work together and combine in individual activities. We are grateful that the Lord has arranged it in such a way that we can count on care and support. All this supports our further development and we, as grateful beings, can fulfil God's will in creation.

Tobiasz and Bartosz: Thank you!

## 2.5 Wind generation

*The next day we decided to talk to Windy about the formation of wind. Here is a transcript of the conversation:*

Tobias: Hello Windy, today we wanted to talk more about wind.

Windy: Hello to you my friends.

Tobias: Earth science says that wind is created by pressure differences, temperature changes and differences in terrain. How would you comment on this?

Windy: These are the conditions and circumstances supporting the emergence of the winds.... Anyway, behind these conditions and circumstances is also the action of the essentials. We creatures of the wind are drawn to precisely those places where the given conditions and circumstances occur. Through these circumstances we initiate given winds without much effort....

Bartholomew: Given that the given conditions and circumstances would have occurred, would the wind have also been created without your participation?

Windy: I am convinced that it is not possible without our participation.

Bartosz: Forgive me Windy, but I have some doubts.... I think mainly because this is something new for me....

Windy: Take it easy Bartholomew. I know this information is new to most people. We initiate all winds. If we did not, our existence would not make much sense.... Winds do not come into being by themselves, a vital force is needed and we wind beings are that force....

Tobias: How do we understand this with Bartholomew: one being of the wind creates it, and other beings intercept this created wind, and possibly amplify, redirect...? Is it like that?

Windy: Yes Tobias what you have presented is absolutely true.... Often there are many smaller wind beings alongside the initiators supporting the action with a given force and in a given direction. Often the more powerful wind beings take over the wind that the smaller beings initiated and increase its strength.... Reverse cases also occur, i.e. smaller wind beings take over a given wind and decrease the strength.... The cases and possibilities are really many and I don't want to say too much, because to you people the overall picture is enough....

Tobias: Man himself is able to artificially induce air movement, e.g. through fans. Are wind beings involved in some way in this too?

Lifts: wind beings could only increase the strength of a given wind or air movement initiated by a fan, however, they do not do so because it is not the will of the Light to do so....

*And after a short pause he added.*

Lifts: we operate in harmony with nature and to the rhythm of its laws, and all fans are an artificial human creation.

Tobias: I think this short talk will give us people a lot.... Is there anything else you would add?

Windy: Thank you Tobias for these questions. They give people the opportunity to get to know us better. I must admit that the questions were very interesting and showed me how people think about the formation of winds. Without us beings of the wind, no wind on earth would be created. In initiating the wind lies our power. This ability is given to us by the Light.... We do not want to go into detail to speak more broadly about what exactly we do to initiate the wind.... It is enough for people to know that our movement and our activity initiates the winds. Let the details remain our secret, which perhaps we will reveal to people one day. But at the moment it is not wanted to be done. Come closer to us people. Let your understanding about us become right and true.

Tobias: Thank you Windy!

Bartosz: Thank you!

Windy: Thank you. I'm happy to be able to tilt the truth about wind beings to you.

## 2.6 The appearance of the sylphs

*The next day we decided to talk about appearance. We started with the sylphs.*

Bartosz: Hello Windy. Could you describe the appearance of the Sylphs?

Windy: Yes, I'm ready...

Bartosz: Start, please.

Lifts: Sylphs are translucent. They have wings that allow them to move through the air....

Tobias: Wings from what?

Bartosz: Do these wings look like those of angels?

Lifts: The wings are translucent and are probably wings made of feathers. Sylphs resemble angels, except that their wings and hands are one whereas in angels the wings and hands are separate.

Bartosz: Do they have footwear?

Lifts: No, they don't have shoes. They don't need them because they are practically in the air all the time.

Tobias: And their clothing?

Lifts: They have these short shorts and sort of a T-shirt. Everything is translucent and not clear.

Bartosz: Do they shimmer in any colours?

Lifts: I think every sylph shimmers in different colours of the rainbow depending on your preference. They don't have, in my opinion, fixed colours in their appearance.

Tobias: And the face - eyes, ears, nose, hair?

Lifts: Their eyebrows are bushy and long, and their eyes are large. Their ears are human. Hair below their shoulders, which is quite long. Nose very close to human. Their countenances are usually serene. They are translucent and do not have solid colours on their faces, but luminosity and beauty generally prevail.

*A sylph has emerged...*

Sylph: There are very many sylphs that are compatible in appearance to this description.... I just wanted to add that there are a great many species of us that differ in appearance.... Let this description be a description of one type of sylph. I think that is enough to stimulate people's imagination. However, remember people that there are a great many of us and we differ in appearance....

*After a moment, he added.*

Sylf: We also have in our clothes endings with such fringes.... They're not typical shorts and shirts like humans.

Tobias: Hello, would you add anything else regarding your appearance?

Sylf: I think that is sufficient. The description of the appearance should be illustrative. If some painter saw us one day, then he could paint us. I think there will be such attempts in the future....

Tobias: Then thank you and move on to the creatures of the wind.

## 2.7 The appearance of creatures of the wind

*We continued our conversation with Windy...*

Tobias: Please Windy, start.

Lifts: wind creatures are slightly more dense than sylphs.... Their appearance is also translucent.

Bartosz: Do they also have wings?

Lifts: Of course they do... Compared to sylphs, however, the wings of wind creatures are huge.

*After which he added.*

Lifts: the wings of the wind creatures obviously have a large role in initiating the wind but, as this is not wanted, I will not go into detail.

*And he continued.*

Lifts: we have slightly longer trousers interestingly often supported by braces.... Our clothes also adorn the ends with tassels.... To see the difference between a sylph and a wind creature you would have to see us.... The main difference is the length of the wings and the greater density of the wind beings, also noticeable in appearance.

Bartholomew: So the syphons are more subtle?

Windy: They also have more subtle tasks. I think the sylph you spoke to today will visit you again and say something more about the tasks.

Tobias: And your faces?

Lifts: Faces resemble human faces.... There's not really much difference... Our hair is usually long and we are almost always smiling.... It is a very joyful experience to be a creature of the wind....

Tobias: I have read that some wind beings have three eyes<sup>1</sup> ... Is this true?

Lifts: There also happen to be some with three eyes.... My face, however, is human...

Tobias: What is this third eye used for?

Windy: Just to stimulate your imagination, let me just say that there are thousands of different species of us.... I haven't even met half of them, and I am one of those beings.... That's why it's very difficult to talk about it, encapsulating it in a general framework. In my opinion, the creatures of the

wind vary a bit depending on the climate. That's how I feel about it, because I'm also a being operating in Poland and I can guess that the ones in Argentina are completely different....

*After a while...*

Windy: I've never been to Argentina, but there are probably many differences between us....

*He added:*

Windy: I think that this third eye might be an additional sense, but I'll be honest and say that I don't know, because I don't have one....

Tobias: I understand... The description I'm drawing from probably comes from another species of wind beings. Supposedly this eye shines like a searchlight and with its strong radiation it can cause storms etc....

Bartosz: Thank you Windy, for what you have given us today.... I think the overall picture you've given us gives us some ideas, which are probably just an overview, but it's still a lot.

Windy: Thank you ... I feel that my task has come to an end.... You will now be visited by more beings who will expand your cognition. I will admit that it was a very difficult task to present an overall picture of the sylph and the creature of the wind, but I think I passed this exam as well. Thank you, I feel contentment and fulfilment....

Tobias: Be a blessed creature of the wind!

Windy: Thank you!

## 2.8 The role of the sylphs

*Here is a transcript of our conversation with sylph.*

Bartosz: Hello sylphs, you expressed your willingness to talk yesterday. What can you say more about sylphs?

Sylf: As you already know, our job is to take care of air quality. Today I wanted to talk a little bit about that.

Tobias: Hello, we are listening...

Bartholomew: I understand that you are simply clearing the air?

Sylf: Yes. We are cleaning up the air so that the air quality is better. I don't want to go into detail, because it's wanted, just to give a general picture....

*After a brief pause.*

Sylf: The first way to purify the air, and therefore to fulfil our task, is simply by our presence.... Our very presence, or more precisely our radiation cleanses the air.

Tobias: And do you also purify the air of negative energies that are created by human actions that are not in accordance with God's will?

Sylf: We are only improving air quality. People already have to take care of the energy cleanliness around them themselves....

*After the break...*

Sylf: Our second way of purifying the air is through our physical activity. What that looks like, we don't want to say, but we can say that our movement cleanses the air.

*After a brief pause.*

Sylf: The third and final way to purify the air is by blowing. We don't create wind this way, well maybe minimally, but we clean the air this way.... Our ability to blow is much greater than that of humans....

Bartosz: Thank you for your message ... Could you say a bit more about the sylph species mentioned yesterday....

Sylph: Yes, there are very many species of sylphs. Each species differs in appearance and also in the size of its body. Therefore, I remind you that the appearance of the sylph, which was presented yesterday, is very illustrative. However, the most important characteristic and differentiating difference for us is the type of pollutants that a given sylph can clean.... I, for example, clean the air of dust.... There are also sylphs that purify the air from different types of gases, for example.... As you can probably imagine, there are many species of sylphs and each one cleans from something different.... This knowledge is completely sufficient for humans.

Tobias: Is there anything else you want to say?

Sylf: Remember people, the good air quality of your area is largely down to us. Don't make our work more difficult and people take care not to pollute the air. Because of your irresponsible attitude, we have a lot more work to do. However, we believe that there will come a time when man will not make our task more difficult, but will make it easier. Thank you for being able to expand your knowledge of us sylphs at least a little. I feel that I have fulfilled my task.

Bartholomew and Tobias: Thank you! Be a blessed sylph!

Sylf: Thank you.

## 2.9 Vento

*A creature of the wind has emerged to expand our cognition that Windy gave us. We have decided to call him Vento for ease of communication.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello, do you like the name Vento that we gave you?

Vento: Welcome! I like it a lot. I will consider whether to use it on a daily basis....

Tobias: What can we talk about today?

Vento: I think we can talk about, and more specifically define, what the species division of wind beings is.

Bartholomew: So how does such a division look?

Vento: I think the overall picture I want to give you is perfectly adequate.

*After a while.*

Vento: I think there are thousands of species of wind beings. We distinguish between small supporting beings, to increasingly larger beings that can already initiate wind on their own, up to beings that are powerful beings that can initiate powerful storms, storms, and hurricanes.

Bartosz: So I take it that any species can trigger or initiate a wind of a given strength?

Vento: Yes, you get it right. Each species has a range of wind power it can initiate, from small whirlwinds to huge hurricanes. You probably want to know how storms are created? They are initiated by powerful wind beings in combination with other high beings. The beings of each species that are to participate in the formation of the storm are assigned by the guardians, who themselves have been guided as to what force is to be initiated and how great a change the storm is to cause in the area.

Tobias: Are clouds formed by wind beings, or do clouds form separate beings?

Vento: There are many beings in the air that can be classified as air beings, but they are not sylphs. The beings that form the clouds are another species that you can get to know. They work together with the beings of the wind and I think they can, together with the sylphs, be classified as simply beings of the air.

Tobias: Is there any other species of air beings you can tell us about?

Vento: There are bird guides. They are the ones who initiate bird migrations and guide the birds to their areas of destination.

Bartosz: Thank you for the information you have given us today, and we would very much like to ask you to prepare a broader study on the creatures of clouds and bird guides.

Vento: My cognition in this matter may be insufficient, but I feel that there may be beings who could speak more broadly about this. I am a creature of the wind and can mainly speak about my species.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you and see you tomorrow!



## 2.10. The essence of clouds

*The next day we decided to talk to Vento about the creatures of the clouds.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello Vento! We hope you are prepared to talk about the creatures of the clouds.

Vento: Welcome! I believe I am up to the task.

Bartosz: What can you say about the creatures of the clouds?

Vento: Cloud beings, as the name suggests, live in the clouds. They are the ones who ennoble and nurture those parts of nature that we call clouds. As you probably know, there are many species of clouds, and consequently many species of cloud beings. They differ in appearance and also in the tasks they have to perform.

Tobias: What are their tasks?

Vento: As I mentioned, they refine the clouds, but not only. They support the process of cloud formation. We can also say that they partly form them, however, the lion's share is performed here by nature itself and its laws.

Tobias: Can cloud creatures form clouds into the shapes they want?

Vento: Yes, however, this is not common. Cloud beings can form any shape from clouds. If a person is pure enough, his or her wanting can also participate in this. This involves the cloud beings responding and merging with the pure wanting of the human being.

Bartosz: I once expected a heart made of clouds and saw a heart formed from clouds.

Vento: Yes. This is a confirmation of what I said.

Bartosz: And what are the other tasks of cloud beings?

Vento: Cloud beings decide when and where rainfall will occur. Of course, they cooperate with other beings of nature in this task. Mainly with the beings of the wind. Cloud beings, also nurture and care for the crystals and droplets in the clouds. They also take care of their purity. A big part in this process is their radiation. As you can see, this is the task of refining the clouds. Refining itself is the main task of all beings of nature. Through the guardian beings, the cloud beings get information about when and where precipitation is to occur and in what quantities. This process is mainly done by nature, but the cloud beings also have some control over it.

Tobias: Is there anything else you would add?

Vento: I think the cognition that comes from my message is sufficient. Be aware, people, that all processes in nature are supported or performed directly by natural beings. Let the cognition that flows from this simple message become established in you, and if it is the will of the Creator, it will be extended some day.

## 2.11. Bird guides

*We then decided to talk about bird guides.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Vento, can you say more about bird guides?

Vento: I have gained a cognition about these beings that I did not have before. Also, contact with you enriches my knowledge as well.

Tobias: Please start.

Vento: Bird guides are those creatures of the air who, by their presence, support bird migrations. They guide groups of birds to areas of the planet where their future habitats are located. The guiding process itself is simple, however, a few important things need to be said here. The beings themselves, who are the guides, are able to communicate with the birds. To do this, they send out a kind of sound that only the birds can hear.

*After a while...*

Vento: These sounds are able to influence the decision of a group of birds relating to the migration route taken.

Bartosz: Do bird handlers also guide birds on the basis that they fly in front of them?

Vento: They can do it, but they don't have to. Birds often already feel where they are supposed to fly.

Bartholomew: So these sounds you mentioned are information to the birds about where to fly?

Vento: Yes, but communication continues during the flight and so the birds know where to fly. Flight paths are often similar, but not the same as in previous years. Often the flight path avoids some kind of unpleasantness related to storms or strong winds.

Bartosz: Do the bird guides create a so-called corridor along which the birds move?

Vento: The corridor is created according to harmonious laws. God's will takes care of the birds so that no harm comes to them during their flight. Yes, the bird guides create the safest and most favourable flight paths, thus ensuring the safety of the birds. Sometimes they fly in front of the birds and guide whole clusters of birds. However, this is not always necessary, as birds feel and understand well through sound communication where they are supposed to fly.

Tobias: How are these sounds created? Do these creatures have any special instruments?

Vento: Through the speech apparatus. However, this sound is not heard by humans.

Bartosz: Do we differentiate between the species of these guides?

Vento: Yes, guide species are matched and adapted to many bird species. Each bird species has its own specific type of guides that it fully trusts and lets guide it.

Tobias: Can these creatures be called filgies?

Vento: Yes, it is one of the verbal forms that is known in the world and that is attributed to bird guides.

Bartholomew: Do you want to add anything?

Vento: People often refer to the journeys of birds as their instinctive inner guidance. However, there is only a grain of truth in this, as their inner guidance is initiated by guides specially appointed for this purpose. These guides take care of the best possible flight paths for whole clusters of birds. This knowledge is new to most people, however, it is wanting people to know about it.

## 2.12. Hurricanes

*The next day we decided to talk to Vento about the formation of hurricanes.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello Vento! We wanted to talk about hurricanes today....

Vento: Hello! I am prepared for the interview.

Bartosz: So what can you say about hurricanes?

Vento: Science distinguishes the factors that need to be present for a hurricane to form. However, science omits one very important factor. This is the presence of natural beings during the occurrence of a hurricane.

Bartosz: Is the hurricane created by a single being? Or is it a group of beings driving it?

Vento: First of all, you must know that hurricanes are formed by powerful beings of nature, who are high beings of the wind. Each hurricane is initiated by one powerful being, who has a dominant influence in the creation of the hurricane, but alongside him are a number of supporting beings, not only wind beings.

*After a short while.*

Vento: The power of a hurricane is no mean feat, so the beings who initiate and form it can already be called powerful. They act on the orders of the high essentials from the circle of the essential. The whole thing is controlled by the will of God, and this tells us that every hurricane is fully willed by the Light.

Bartholomew: I understand that the effects of the hurricane, like the damage, are also anchored in law?

Vento: It can be said that there is no coincidence in the material losses that affect people. We must know that God's will controls through justice and love all destruction. Therefore, you must realise,

people, that all losses caused by the force of the hurricane are deserved. We beings of nature cannot act arbitrarily and we always reflect the will of the Light in our actions.

Bartosz: I understand that the dominant being in the formation of the hurricane influences the supporting beings. Can you say something more about it?

Vento: Its circular, swirling movement can appear like a powerful elemental dance. It is the one that has a great influence on the power of the hurricane. The powerful being who performs it knows full well that it cannot act arbitrarily and the force it generates cannot be too little or too much, but must be adapted to what the Light dictates through its high guidance.

Tobias: Are stronger hurricanes planned in the future that will bring major destruction?

Vento: It is in the plans of the Light to increase the intensity of the activity of all the elements. Also those that flow from the activity of the wind beings. The forces of the hurricanes and the destruction they cause will increase, but at the same time we want to make it clear that the human beings who serve the Light will be protected during this time. Also the one who has a pure desire and fully lives in accordance with God's will, i.e. God's laws, can feel fully safe.

Tobias: Will people also be warned about this by those appointed to do it?

Vento: The strength of a hurricane can be predicted a few days in advance, but total devastation cannot be predicted. Personally, I have no information on planned warnings by people appointed for this purpose, but I know that if such warnings were to occur, they would probably not be sufficiently publicised by the world media, among others. I think that people should mainly listen to their intuition and decide on the basis of their inner feeling what to do and where to go in order to survive the force of the elements.

Bartholomew: Perhaps you want to add something else at the end?

Vento: Just as the strength of hurricanes will be gradually increased in the present time, the strength of typhoons, tornadoes, cyclones or orkans will reflect the increase in the activity of the wind beings in the end times. All this has to do with the cleansing of the planet, so the intensity of the force of the elements, including the element of air, will increase.

Bartholomew: Can a person somehow prepare for the current times?

Vento: Only directing oneself to the Light in these times can give effective protection against the action of all the elements. There are, of course, very few people who have such protection at the present time, so I call out to you people: Draw closer to the Creator in your daily life! Try with all your might to live in harmony with His laws! In this way you will not be affected by the force of a hurricane or any other element! Be alert and listen to the voice of your intuition, your hearts. He will always show you the right way to survive the hard times ahead.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you Vento!

Vento: Thank you!

## 2.13. Ability and gender

*After a break of a few days, we returned to our discussions with Vento.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello Vento!

Vento: Welcome! What do you want to talk about?

Tobias: Today about ability and gender....

Vento: Maybe I can start with our gender. My kind of activity is more masculine, however, I am a very delicate creature and in a way I have a lot of feminine qualities.

Tobias: Are all creatures of the wind male?

Vento: All these wind beings that I know are similar to me, so it's a male form with a lot of female characteristics, but I can't speak about all of them because I don't know all the wind beings.

Tobias: And how do you perceive the sylphs?

Vento: I think the same with me. I also have a similar perception of bird guides and cloud creatures. However, I can't talk about all of them because there are many species that I may not know.

Bartosz: We have learnt a lot about the abilities of the other species of natural beings. Could you say something about yours?

Vento: First and foremost, this is our main ability. We can create and amplify wind power. We are specialists in this field.

Tobias: And do you have the ability to relocate, change or increase your form?

Vento: The ability to relocate is common among older wind beings. Increasing form in us does not occur. We can change our experimental form for a while, however, I do not use this.

Bartholomew: I understand that it is the same with sylphs, bird guides and cloud beings as with you?

Vento: Yes, we are similar beings in species and the abilities I have outlined are also present in them.

Tobias: I think we can conclude the topic. Vento, is there anything you would add?

Vento: I think that is all I could say on the subject. Now I am ending my discussions with you, because I feel that my knowledge on the following topics is insufficient and an elder being will come to you.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you Vento for your transmissions, you really gave us a lot! Be a blessed being of the wind!

Vento: I feel fulfilled! Thank you guys!

## 2.14. Beneficial effects of air and wind

*Moments later, two beings, rather than one, appeared to expand our knowledge so far. We decided to start with the beneficial effects of air and wind.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Welcome! Do you accept the names William and Victor, which we would like to give you for the duration of this task?

William: Yes, I like that name very much. Remember Bartholomew, I'm a tad happier so you can tell us apart.

Victor: I accept that name. For ease of use I will be heard in Bartholomew's left ear and William in his right ear....

Tobias: Tell us about the effects of air and wind on the health of earthlings....

William: Clean and good air quality has a huge impact on health. We know that dirty, polluted air causes numerous diseases. Humans are contributing to the fact that the air quality is getting worse and worse and we, as representatives of air beings, are calling for humans to no longer pollute the air as much as the planet.

Victor: We are aware that man's impact on air quality is negative. Man is hindering the tasks of the beings that clean the air, the sylphs. We would like this book to increase people's awareness of the creatures of air and wind. People we do not expect your gratitude for our activity, because gratitude is due to the Creator, but we want you to know about our activity and to do more to not hinder us in this activity.

Bartholomew: I understand that in nature the wind has a major cleansing role....

William: Yes, tree-dwelling beings, trees and plants are waiting for the purification that the wind gives. Such a cleansing process from time to time is necessary for all of nature. Even thunderstorms, which often arouse terror among creatures, have a great cleansing role. Thanks to them, nature gains vigour and brings refreshment to all beings.

Victor: The wind is necessary. Already during the formation and transformation of the planet, the wind had an important role and since then not much has changed. We beings of the wind, know of the benefits William mentioned and thus we approach our tasks with great love. It is an extraordinary joy to feel so useful and so needed throughout the vast Creation.

Bartosz: Is there anything you would like to add at the end of this broadcast?

William: I am honoured to have been able to provide these brief words and give you an idea of how I see the subject. I think my individual insight does not differ much from the overall picture of the subject.

Victor: I feel that man will change, that he will be changed by events and the very man who survives the great cleansing will care more about the planet as a whole, as well as the air.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Victor and William thank you!

William and Victor: We thank you too! We'll be in touch...

## 2.15. Rest and calling of William and Victor to a new task

*The next day we continued our conversations with the two higher beings of the wind.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello! What about your rest and sleep?

William: We don't need as much sleep as humans, so as often as humans we don't sleep, but we do rest and it's wanted so that we have that time to ourselves.

Tobias: And how do you rest?

William: We can rest in designated areas. There are designated places where we also have these little huts. Every such place is under constant protection and so we feel safe there.

Tobias: These places are in the air?

William: No Tobias, these places are usually by woods or clearings. Interestingly, we can also relax in the air. Simply relaxing the whole body, or even allowing ourselves to take a nap in the air.

Bartosz: Is there anything you want to add Victor?

Victor: I know that you and Tobias are considering the subject of the so-called Aeolian Islands. There are islands in the seas that are inhabited by highly evolved beings of the wind. As you probably know, each species has its headquarters on earth. Just as the gnomes have their headquarters inside the earth and the fire beings have their headquarters in the core of the earth, we wind beings have our headquarters on the Aeolian Islands.

Bartosz: Are these the higher levels of the Aeolian Islands, or the so-called Aeolian Islands?

Victor: At the level of subtle densomateriality, the wind beings have their earthly capital there.

Bartholomew: So I take it you also have an earthly leader? Is Eol his name?

Victor: As far as I know, he uses many names. Whether he currently uses the name Eol, I don't know, but he probably used one in the past.

Bartholomew: I understand that he cannot be treated as a god? Because that's what people often call him....

Victor: Of course, he is only the king of the earthly wind beings and has not a shred of divinity in him.

Bartholomew: Did I get it right that you are both called to visit the Aeolian Islands?

William: Our joy is great. During that conversation we got the message that the two of us were to visit the Aeolian Islands and maybe see the King himself too.

Tobias: We are happy to be with you and look forward to hearing from you!

*With this happy note, we ended the conversation.*

## 2.16. Description of the capital of the Aeolian Islands

*We looked forward to William and Victor's account of their mission the next day.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Welcome! We are listening to your report.

William: Welcome! Our joy is immense. We have been to the Aeolian Islands and hosted by the King. We have been met with such a great honour that we feel the constant uplifting of our beings. It is difficult to describe what I feel, but I am in awe of what I have seen.

Victor: I, like William, am overjoyed with happiness. We want to share with you at least a substitute of what we experienced.

Bartholomew: Does the king use the world-famous name Eol?

William: It's a name he hasn't used for a long time, but if it's known on Earth and fully describes his person, it can be used.

Tobias: William would you add anything at the end of today's messages?

William: It should also be mentioned that the king of the wind beings is also the king of all air beings throughout the earth and not only the wind beings are subject to him, but also the sylphs and the other air beings.

Bartholomew: Victor, and will you also add something?

Victor: This experience that I have been a part of has been the most wonderful experience in my entire being. I am happy and feel that I have gained as a being. I feel that this experience is like a pearl that will shape me in the future, add beauty and nobility to me.

William: We know that you want to touch on a topic, but we know that we have already completed our mission and we just want to say thank you and thus close this chapter in our being. We are honoured to have been part of your project and we are convinced that the cognition that comes out of your book is sufficient for humanity for this moment.

Bartholomew and Tobias: Thank you! Be blessed beings of the wind!

William and Victor: Thank you!

## 2.18. The kingdom of air beings in paradise essential

*The next day we took up the theme of the paradise of the vital beings of the air.*

Tobias: Welcome the called being to talk about the paradise of the beings of air and wind. Please begin!

Essence: I wanted to start by saying that I am honoured to be able to pass on something. The beings of wind and air have their paradise. Of course, wind and air are in every sphere of the circle of materiality and there the mature beings who have gained their maturity in matter have their tasks. However, they also have their centres where they have their headquarters. These are their places of rest. There are many beautiful objects and many leaders there. Many of them reached their maturity on earth and on other planets, but there are also those who never had to experience in matter. Among them are the greatest leaders, whose names you already know.

Tobias: Do you mean Typhon, Tisiphon and Zephyr?

Essence: Yes, they are based in Wallhalla<sup>2</sup>. Their will, which is an extension of the divine will, radiates to all beings of the air and wind. In this way you get to know the supreme leaders, who are subject to Zeus, and therefore the king of the vital circle.

Bartholomew: Do you want to add anything?

Gist: We are aware that the cognition emanating from your book is in many cases illustrative, not including broader details. For the moment it is sufficient. If humanity does not fail, there will be further vocations among them who can build on this general picture that flows from your book. For example, there are a multitude of species of beings and, in fact, what your book contains is an introduction to the broader explanations.

Tobias: Thank you creature! Be blessed! I am extremely grateful to God that I can participate in this beautiful mission of expanding people's knowledge of nature's creatures....

## 3. The essence of water

### 3.1 Preliminary information

*We opened ourselves up to contact with water beings. A nymph appeared.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello nympho! What can you say at the outset about the creatures of water of which you are a representative?

Nymph: Welcome! This noble element that is water needs beings who care for it. We water beings have mainly female forms and are in rivers, ponds, lakes, seas and oceans.

Tobias: What are we going to talk about with you beings of water?

Nymph: First of all, we will introduce you to the main species of water creatures, which are nymphs, russets and mermaids. We want people's awareness of water beings to increase, so the description will be intended to enrich knowledge. It is not only our wish, but it is also the will of the Light to expand human cognition about us.

Bartosz: Could you say something in general about your specific genre?

Nymph: We have been on earth for a very long time. We are also on all the planets where there is water. We nourish the water and you could say that we are the guardians of those places where there is water. Our tasks resonate with the will of God and what is assigned to us as our daily activities is always willed by God.

Bartosz: What else are we going to talk about?

Nymph: As with other species, we want to briefly introduce you to the appearance of our female forms. We also want to talk about our care and therefore guidance. Finally, we will give you the truth about our leaders and, if it is the will of the Light, we will give you a brief description of our aquatic capital.

Bartosz: Do nymphs, mermaids and mermaids also ennoble other levels of creature? It's obvious to me, but I'd like you to talk about what that looks like....

Nymph: Of course we are on the dense-material planets, but also on other levels of creation. Where there is water throughout creation, there we are too. There is a main principle that the higher the level of creation, the greater the maturity of the water beings that operate there. On earth we are temporary and our main goal is to mature and return to the circle of essence. Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you. We will be thinking of you!

### 3.2 Preliminary information on russets

*Two days later, we started a discussion with a water creature named Ruslana. She is a representative of the Ruslana species.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello Ruslano! What can you say about your species?

Ruslana: We are creatures of the water who nurture and refine streams and smaller rivers. We are often mistaken for nymphs, who are larger than us and have their business on larger rivers, ponds and lakes. There are many species of us, and we fulfil our duties, which are imposed on us by the Light, with joy.

Bartholomew: Is a nymph actually the same species as a russet but larger?

Ruslana: There are different approaches to this subject. For me nymphs, especially those of ponds and lakes, are a different species. However, I have also encountered the term that nymphs are larger russets.

Tobias: How many of you are there? E.g. by a small river, what is the distance you might encounter a russet?

Ruslana: The number of ruslana in a given river is strictly adjusted to the needs that the river has. Such regulations are watched over by our caretakers, who take care of the river enhancement tasks. E.g. if there are several russets in a particular stretch, but their action shows the keepers that fewer are enough, then one russet is recalled and moved to another river. In the reverse case, if there are greater needs in the care of a section and if the number of russets is insufficient, then the caretakers allocate another russet in that place and divide the river into sectors for their action.

Tobias: Tell us what it's like to be a russet woman and how do you feel on a daily basis?

Ruslana: It is an amazing feeling to be a rusalka who is needed by the Creator and creation. We Ruslans are happy to fulfil any task that God's will dictates. Because of this, we are very often smiling and simply feel good. We feel good in our bodies and are grateful for the form of our bodies, which was also formed by God's will.

Bartholomew: Dear Ruslano, what would you say about the human impact on your experience and action?

Ruslana: Unfortunately, man is making our task very difficult. He does not care about the cleanliness of the rivers and streams. Often the rivers are so dirty that we can be called back from our missions because our continued activity in a particular place would not make much sense. It is only man who disturbs the proper functioning of nature and does not see it in himself. He thinks he is allowed everything and does not want to conform to the law of keeping clean that the creatures of nature keep.

Tobias: This question applies to all creatures of nature, but I will ask it to you as a russet woman... Are there any russet women who are lazy and procrastinate in completing their tasks?

Ruslana: I don't know how it is on other planets, but on Earth such cases are practically non-existent. All earthly Ruslans fulfil their tasks happily and with admirable diligence.

Tobias: What else would you add by way of introduction?

Ruslana: We are grateful to the Lord for all the tasks we perform. Our will is for man to know the truth about us and our specific work. Therefore, we are happy that this book can make this available to man. We believe that on the basis of the knowledge that will flow from it, man will change and care more for both nature and water itself, which is a gift from the Creator.

Tobias: Thank you for that initial introduction!

Ruslana: Thank you!

### 3.3 Preliminary on nymphs

*After a short break, we decided to talk to the nymph who had appeared. We gave her the name Neira with her consent.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello Neira! By way of introduction, what can you tell us about your genre?

Neira: Hello! I want to start by saying that you gave me a beautiful name. I think I will use it. We nymphs are very similar to russets. We look like their older sisters. Our area of water care concerns larger rivers, ponds and lakes. We have noble tasks in creation and are grateful for our existence.

Bartosz: Do you nurture larger areas than russets because of their size?

Neira: Yes, it is a logical conclusion, because we are bigger, we also cover larger areas with our action. Our radiation also reaches over greater distances than the radiation of the russets....

Tobias: What is it like to be a nymph?

Neira: Beautiful question Tobias... We are aware of our beautiful form that we experience. Our beauty not only has an aesthetic value, but it is ennobling in itself. Being a nymph is a great joy. We are aware of our beauty and our sublime tasks. This awareness, however, does not cause our vanity, but pure happiness, which we sometimes experience as great bliss.

Tobias: I am touched by your response....

Bartosz: Is there one nymph assigned for each lake?

Neira: A nymph of a certain species and also of a certain size is assigned to a given size of lake. Usually one nymph nurtures one whole lake. However, for very large bodies of water, more nymphs are needed, the number of which is regulated by the keepers. However, such large lakes are not so numerous and the rule: 'one nymph per lake' is common.

Tobias: You said you don't do anything for show... So humility is common among you nymphs, as well as other creatures of nature?

Neira: We know that many people misunderstand humility. We are humble beings, which is mainly characterised by the fact that we do not exalt ourselves above other beings. There is also no vanity in us. Although we are humble beings, we have within us a great joy and desire to act in the service of the Light.

Tobias: It's beautiful what you say! We humans should take an example from you creatures of nature....

Bartholomew: Can you, as in the case of russets, be transferred to another field of action?

Neira: Yes, however, this is relatively rare. It is the rule that one nymph is assigned to one lake permanently.

Tobias: What else would you tell people by way of introduction about your species?

Neira: I think time will tell if man will get closer to the creatures of nature and begin to understand their great role in nature as well as all of creation. Our role is very important and we want man to recognise and appreciate it. It is willed by the Light that this should happen!

Tobias: Thank you dear Neiro!

Neira: Thank you!

### 3.4. Preliminary information on sirens

*In the evening of the same day, we began our conversation with a mermaid, whom Bartosz gave the name Sirith for this task.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Welcome Sirith! We're looking forward to you expanding our cognition about mermaids... Get started!

Sirith: Thank you for your beautiful name. I don't use names myself, but I like yours so much that I think I will use it.

*After a pause.*

Sirith: We are the refining beings of the seas and oceans. We have practically been refining them since their inception. We have many tasks that we perform with a grateful heart, and our joy and desire to serve the Light drives us to act in ways that always resonate with the eternal laws. We love God and His creation of which we are a part.

Tobiasz: We are in Silesia, there is no sea here. Where did you come to us from?

Sirith: I am part of the great support that is refining the waters of the Baltic Sea.

Tobias: Are mermaids only female, or does the sea appear male as well?

Sirith: Generally, most mermaids are female forms. But there are also male mermaids, of which there are far fewer.

Tobias: How many of you are in our sea?

Sirith: A very difficult question. I have never counted it. There are many species of us in every sea and we often operate in groups where we support each other and cheer each other on to continue serving.

Tobias: So you are not acting alone?

Sirith: I have two sisters with whom I look after an area. Sirens have their own areas of operation.

Bartosz: What is it like to be a mermaid?

Sirith: It is a beautiful experience. We have beautiful tasks that are an expression of God's Will. We love to experience as mermaids. Our existence is full of joy and even moments of great bliss. We love all beings in the seas and oceans, as they are also part of our aquatic community. Our love drives us to support these other species of beings.

Tobias: What do the mermaids think love is?

Sirith: Love is trust, support and service. One who truly loves also gives respect to other beings and offers them what is beneficial to them.

Bartosz: What else would you add by way of introduction?

Sirith: We mermaids are the creatures that are the main support of the seas and oceans. We want humans to care more about the cleanliness of these waters and to increase their awareness of us. That is why we are happy that this book is being written. May God's will guide people to the Truth.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you dear Sirith!

Sirith: Thank you!

### 3.5 The role of water

*After a few days' break, we returned to our conversations. Ruslana appeared.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello Ruslano! What can you tell us about the role of water in creation?

Ruslana: It is wanting to talk about it. The role of water is crucial to building life on any planet. We beings of nature know that water has to be pure so that its radiation is also pure. Unfortunately, man has forgotten this and this is the reason for the sadness of many beings who need water to live.



Bartosz: How does the radiation of pure water affect humans?

Ruslana: First of all, water can be purified. Man can do this by filtering, of course, but also by unconventional ways like sending positive thoughts and saying positive words to the water. If a person does this with love, the water purified in this way will be the fruit of this love. Everyone can make an experience at home and send positive thoughts full of love into one jar of water and negative thoughts into another, then the structure of the water will change and after such an experience everyone will know that love can purify and refine water<sup>3</sup>.

Bartosz: Thank you. Can you talk a bit more about the impact of clean water on humans?

Ruslana: As you probably know, a human being is made up of several tens of per cent water, also the impact of the radiation of pure water is of great importance for humans. Just sit near a lake with clean water and feel this energy.

Tobias: And bathing in clean water?

Ruslana: Of course, purifying the body in pure water also affects the spirit and its radiation. Before such a bath one can make the intention that through such a bath one wants to purify not only the dense-material body, but also one's other subtle bodies. If we express such an intention sincerely and lovingly then our purification will be much more effective.

Bartosz: Could there be life on earth without water?

Ruslana: Water is the giver of life. It is an ingredient of plants, animals and also humans. Without it, there is no life, which is why scientists who know this are looking for planets where there is water, because they know there could be life there.

Tobias: How would you sum up this topic?

Ruslan: Water is the only one that exists in three states of aggregation on earth. Only on the basis of this observation can we conclude how important it is. Knowing this, that without water there is no life, we can build our inner respect for water. People, despite knowing this truth, do not care about the purity of rivers, lakes, seas and oceans. For them, the only thing that matters is quick profits, and unfortunately the losses they receive by doing so are enormous. I know that many beings have already told you this, but I want to repeat it. Take care of the earth, people, it is the giver of life. Also take care of the water, because without it there would be no life.

Tobias: Thank you for your beautiful message Ruslano!

### 3.6 Appearance of russets

*After a break of a few days, we returned to the talks. Ruslana appeared.*

Bartosz: Hello Ruslano! We wanted to talk about Ruslana's appearance. To this end, I am handing you a mirror to describe your appearance.

Ruslana: Hello, beautiful tool this mirror is. I didn't know it. We Ruslans have a feminine look.

Tobias: Hello, and what kind of clothing do you have and are you translucent?

Ruslana: Only beings of air have translucency. Our density as beings is slightly higher than that of air beings. Depending on the species of ruslana, the appearance also varies. I have a short skirt down to my knees of a blue-green colour with a local predominance of green or blue. My legs are barefoot. I also have a short shirt of blue more or less, up to where the navel is in humans.

Bartosz: And what colour is your skin?

Ruslana: It is a light blue colour. But it can also change, influenced by my attitude at the moment.

Tobias: Describe your face to us.

Ruslana: My face is also pale blue and my eyes are dark blue. Ears, nose and mouth like those of an earthly woman. Of course, our attire in which we move can also be changed, but in general there is an injunction to cover most of the body.

Bartholomew: Where did this order come from?

Ruslana: It is an injunction from the Light that we should not tempt young earthly men in particular with our appearance.

Tobias: Lips are what colour?

Ruslan: The lips are also blue, it is also a pale blue, but slightly darker than the skin colour.

Bartosz: How would you describe your hair and eyebrows?

Ruslana: Different Ruslans have different colours and different lengths of their hair. I have very long hair reaching down to my waist. The colour of my hair, is dark blue, my eyebrows are similar to those of a typical earth woman, the same colour.

Tobias: Thank you or would you add anything else?

Ruslana: I have to say this, my appearance is not standard in russellas. There are many species that differ in appearance and even in the size of their body. My height is about 1.25m and there are, of course, taller russellas. The taller the creature, the more terrain it can have under its protection. I hope my appearance will give more or less an idea of humanity about us.

### 3.7 Appearance of nymphs

*We then asked Neire about the appearance of the nymphs.*

Tobias: Hello, Bartosz will now hand you a mirror so that you can describe your appearance and how it relates to the appearance of other nymphs.

Neira: I'm touched, it's the first time someone has given me a mirror. We nymphs are very similar to russets. We look a bit like the elder sisters of the russets. Also, we don't have shoes and our robes are adapted to refine our appearance.

Bartosz: Do you also have a blouse like this and a skirt like this?

Neira: Yes, my body is also pale blue, and my skirt and what you call blouse or shirt are also blue. Except that the colour of my robes is slightly darker than that of the russets.

Bartosz: How tall are you, more or less?

Neira: I feel it is roughly between 1.60m and 1.65m. There are also taller nymphs than me whose radiations embrace larger water communities.

Bartosz: Do you have any necklaces or bracelets as decoration?

Neira: I have many treasures in my home, which is under water. These include bracelets and necklaces. But to be honest, I rarely wear them.

Bartosz: And where did you get them from?

Neira: Often, when Light thinks we have done a task correctly, we receive small gifts from our mentors.

Tobias: Describe your face to us.

Neira: The description would be very close to what Ruslana presented. However, I have been around this part of the matter a little longer, so my facial features are more mature. But overall I resemble Ruslana's older sister in appearance.

Tobias: And what colour are your eyes?

Neira: It is a very dark blue. My eyes are darker than Ruslana's.

Tobias: And the hair?

Neira: Across the board, the difference is quite significant. My hair appears black on first contact. However, it is a very dark blue. It reaches more or less to my waist.

Tobias: Is there anything you would add at the end?

Neira: There are, of course, lots of species of nymphs that vary in appearance. The mirror you gave me made me even more aware of how much I love my appearance. I am grateful for the form and for the look that the laws of creation have formed.

Tobias: Thank you!

### 3.8 The appearance of sirens

*We then decided to talk to Sirith about the appearance of mermaids.*

Bartosz: Hello Sirith! I'm handing over the mirror to you... What can you say about your appearance?

Sirith: As most readers probably know, from the waist down I have the appearance of a fish, while from the waist up I have the appearance of a woman.

Tobias: Describe to us your skin and the clothes you wear....

Sirith: My fish body is made up of scales that shimmer multicoloured. The dominant colour in me is green. It is a very bright green. Each mermaid has a different dominant colour when it comes to scales. It is possible to see scales shimmering blue, green and even red, although this is less common.

*After a brief pause.*

Sirith: We take care of our tails so that they are pure and always shimmer with pure shades of colour. In this way we thank the Creator and appreciate the form in which we experience.

Bartosz: So what does the upper part of your bodies look like? What colour is it?

Sirith: In my case it is pale blue, but I have also seen mermaids who have bodies in other colours such as pale green or pink. We also have short shirts that cover part of the body. It is obviously willed by the Light that we cover ourselves.

Tobias: Describe the face and hair for us.

Sirith: Still about the body. They are also covered by such strands of seaweed. It is part of our experimental form.

*After a pause.*

Sirith: I have a deep gaze that is accentuated by my blue big eyes. It is a dark blue. My hair is a little shorter than russet, reaching just below my shoulder blades. They are light green. There are many species of mermaids that have different hair. My form attracts specific fish, which I also look after, but this will be mentioned more extensively on another occasion. My face resembles that of earthly women. I am usually a smiling creature.

Bartosz: And the colour of the lips?

Sirith: Dark blue.

Tobias: Thank you dear Sirith! What would you add at the end?

Sirith: As far as I can tell, there are thousands of species of mermaids, so their appearance usually varies. Mermaids are famous for their beauty and sublimity of form. Thank you for being able to give you an idea of what we mermaids more or less look like.

### 3.9 Luring young men

*Two days later, we decided to talk to Ruslana about the lure of human men by water beings.*

Bartosz: Hello Ruslano! What can you say about the so-called luring and temptation of young men by mermaids, nymphs and sirens? Many legends and tales speak of this phenomenon, so we ask, does it happen?

Ruslana: Yes, it happens, although it is not that frequent.

Bartholomew: What, then, prompts creatures of water such as mermaids, nymphs and sirens to do such acts?

Ruslana: The main reason for this phenomenon is the decline of earthly women. They are the ones who affect the creatures of the nature of female activity with the attitude they bestow on men.

Tobias: Are they at fault because of this?

Ruslana: Like humans, beings of nature are also anchored to the law. It is the fault of those beings who do so.

Tobias: Is repentance very painful for them?

Ruslana: First of all, such a being has to get on the right track and start serving again in purity and love. Sometimes this is not easy, as so-called luring often turns into inclination. Beings of nature who do so must expect to be removed from service.

Tobias: Is this removal from service already the final punishment, or do they still have to experience other suffering?

*A carer appeared.*

Keeper: Hello to you! I had to interrupt the connections with Ruslana, because you are entering with your questions already very advanced knowledge. The punishments for such beings are usually severe, but always just. Many beings have a very ingrained luring tendency, which is combined with the vanity of earthly women. We do not wish to speak of all the punishments, for that is not the subject of this book. Let man be aware that also among the beings of nature there are falls, sometimes very deep ones. And we carers must also pay attention to this.

Bartholomew: Dear Guardian, is this a common phenomenon?

The Guardian: Most creatures are pure and would never use such baiting, however, just as among humans, there are black sheep among the creatures of nature. Dear readers, bear in mind that these are only isolated cases that deviate from the norm.

Tobias: Is there anything you would add?

The Guardian: Yes. I wanted to say at the end that if any person reading this text encounters such baiting in the future, such a creature of nature should be rebuked and dealt with harshly with a harsh word.

Tobias: Thank you Guardian!

### 3.10. On the care and guidance of water creatures

*The next day, the carer we spoke to yesterday turned up and we decided to discuss the issue of care with him.*

Bartosz: Hello, what can you say about yourself?

Keeper: I am a keeper of russets. I am a sector guardian and I have a number of rusalka under my care. We sector guardians make sure that the mermaids are aware of their tasks and do them to the best of their ability. To my knowledge, when it comes to sector guardians of nymphs and mermaids, the situation is similar.

Bartosz: In addition to sectoral guardians, are there so-called species guardians?

Caretaker: Yes, every being of nature has two types of caretakers. The species guardian ensures that the being develops with the general predictions of the species. That is, that it ennobles its surroundings more and more with its radiation in accordance with the nature of its species.

Tobias: I understand that you have hierarchies and a pyramidal structure among the carers?

Keeper: Yes, this is correct. Each higher guardian, who has the lower ones under him, listens to the will and guidance of the higher ones. The will of the highest guardians is created by the will of God. In this we see the Creator's intention that all things should harmonise with His will. There is great wisdom in the hierarchical and pyramidal structure, and any lapses or departures from the norm are immediately picked up and corrected.

Bartholomew: You are the guardian of the russets... Do you often communicate with them?

Keeper: I only communicate with them when necessary. Generally, the rusals know what they are supposed to do and do their tasks intuitively. If there is a sudden change, I communicate it to them. The rusalka always listen to me because they know that I am an extension of God's will.

Tobias: Are there also guardians, or female beings among the caste of guardians of water beings?

Keeper: Yes. Caregivers usually look after the younger water beings mentioned in this book. They make sure that they develop properly and that the beings mature properly. When the creatures reach a certain level of maturity, then the male guardians take over.

Tobias: Is there anything else you would add?

Keeper: I am pleased to have been able to give you an overview of the care of water beings. This picture is completely sufficient and nothing more needs to be added. It is always God's will that guides us, and this is what I would like to emphasise in my message that is most important.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your message!

### 3.11. Tasks of the rushers

*In the afternoon of the same day, we decided to talk to Ruslana about the tasks of the Ruslans.*

Tobias: Hello Ruslano! What can you say about Ruslana's tasks?

Ruslana: Hello, first of all our main task is to clean and refresh the waters. We achieve this goal through our specific radiation, which is tailored to the river in question.

Bartosz: Do you also have any influence on the fish that are in a particular river?

Ruslana: We can support the fish that see us. We understand their needs and can meet them by, for example, pointing out where the food is. But the fish also have their keepers, whose will we have to respect. Generally we can cooperate with them.

Bartosz: Do you have any other tasks besides this?

Ruslana: We also have an influence on the strength of the river current. We can regulate it with our action, although when the big floods come, we are no longer able to do any regulation.

Bartosz: Can you tell us how you do it?

Ruslana: It is simple. Our movement affects it. That is, for example, when we swim against the current, we merge with the current and weaken it, but such actions are rare and we don't do it many times.

Bartosz: Do the caregivers give you any special assignments?

Ruslana: Yes, sometimes they communicate to us which places we should sail to in order to refresh and cleanse them. I'm always happy to listen to my mentors, who see more and show us places where we should serve.

Tobias: Do you have time to rest and sleep?

Ruslana: Yes. Each of us has our own place of rest. It is underwater, but we can also rest on the shore.

Bartholomew: Are you asleep?

Ruslana: In winter we have more time to sleep and rest, but in summer we also sleep. Nature beings also rest and regenerate through sleep.

Tobias: Is there anything you would add?

Ruslana: We Ruslana are so built and so formed by creation that our radiation ennobles the rivers. Our very presence is a blessing to the rivers and we are happy to take part in refining nature as well as all creation.

Tobias: Thank you!

### 3.12. Tasks of the nymphs

*We immediately moved on to the tasks of the nymphs.*

Tobias: Hello Neira! What can you tell us about the tasks of the nymphs?

Neira: As we are called the elder sisters of the russets, our tasks could not be more different either. We ennobles larger rivers and lakes with our radiation. Because we are bigger we have a larger field of action and with our radiation we encompass larger spaces and, as Ruslana said, we purify and refresh the water at which we radiate.

Bartosz: Do you also support fish?

Neira: I personally leave their keepers free. There are many species of fish that have many keepers. This knowledge you don't have in you yet, and I can expand it a bit.

Tobias: Please!

Neira: Fish keepers and guardians take care of the fish so that they always move in safe sectors. They communicate with them by a kind of sound or singing. The fish understand this perfectly and react almost immediately. I think that is enough to give you an overview.

Bartholomew: Do you nymphs also live inside a river or lake?

Neira: Yes, we have our headquarters where we rest deep at the bottom. I personally also keep my treasures there, which I received from my keepers. And, like the russets, we also sleep mainly in winter.

Bartosz: Do you have a hut under the water?

Neira: Yes, that is exactly the word that fits well with our small homes. My hut was once formed by substantial helpers who are specialists in their craft.

Tobias: Do you have any more tasks?

Neira: For example, when there is a storm, we can increase the strength of the waves. Anyway, a storm is a wonderful phenomenon in which all nature is refreshed and cleansed. I love to dance to the rhythm of the storm in the depths of the lake or on the surface.



Bartholomew: Are you often disturbed by people doing your job?

Neira: People, unfortunately, pollute the rivers, ponds and lakes, making our tasks more difficult. Humans do not appreciate nature, and it was nature that was here before them and prepared the entire planet for them. Man, unfortunately, through his self-will, is stepping into nature with his shoes and polluting it.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you would like to add?

Neira: In addition to us, there are still many supporting beings in the waters such as the fish keepers mentioned above. We nymphs take care of our little kingdoms so that they are always clean and accessible to humans and animals. We are content and happy to be part of nature.

Tobias: Thank you!

### 3.13. Tasks of the sirens

*We then moved on to the sirens.*

Tobias: Hello Sirith! What can you tell us about the tasks of the mermaids?

Sirith: Welcome! Just as mermaids and nymphs clean and refresh rivers and lakes with their radiation, we clean and refresh the areas in the oceans and seas with our radiation.

Bartosz: The ocean is quite big. It would probably take a lot of mermaids to clean it up. I understand that you are acting locally on behalf of your guardians?

Sirith: Each mermaid or groups of mermaids have their own sector and together as a group we take care of the harmony in that sector. So if the caretaker points out a particular place that needs to be cleaned, we go right over there. However, our next main task, and perhaps even more important, is to look after the fish.

Bartosz: Do you communicate with them through your singing?

Sirith: Yes. The fish understand our singing and always head to safe areas that we indicate with our singing. There are many species of sirens that are responsible for looking after the fish species in question.

Tobias: Is your singing only for the purpose you mentioned?

Sirith: We also communicate with each other in this way. Singing itself also has a soothing, even therapeutic role for all creatures living in the seas and oceans. He also cleanses and can heal.

Tobias: Do you also worship the Creator with it?

Sirith: Of course we do. With our singing, we often express gratitude for the gift of life and for who we are. We are happy when we can serve our Lord.

Bartosz: Can people hear you singing?

Sirith: They can hear those who open their inner hearing well enough. Our singing that we initiate inside the seas and oceans also reaches the surface and if someone with the aforementioned gift expresses pure intention, they will be able to hear us.

Tobias: What language do you sing in?

Sirith: We sing our songs in the universal language of mermaids. This language is understood by fish and by most inhabitants of the seas and oceans. Whoever hears our song once will remember it for the rest of his days.

Bartosz: Dear Sirith, thank you for your message, is there anything else you want to add at the end?

Sirith: Each of the mermaids performs lovingly the duties given to her by the Light. We are extremely happy to serve the Light through our tasks. The satisfaction and fulfilment that comes after each task completed motivates us to continue to serve joyfully. Thank you for being able to say something about us.

### 3.14. Capacity of water beings

*Two days later, we decided to talk to Ruslana's mentor about the abilities of water beings.*

Bartholomew: Hello, I understand that water beings have similar or the same abilities as other beings of nature?

Keeper: There is one ability that is specific to creatures of water. With their underwater dance, which consists of species-specific mobility, water beings can increase the strength of their radiation. In this way, they contribute to a more perfect refinement of the sector in which they operate. Each species has different movements, which I call dance. When they dance in this way, they are accompanied by a greater inner concentration, which is what causes them to increase the strength of their radiation.

Bartosz: For example, can older beings also use relocation, voice change, temporary change of form?

Keeper: Yes. These are universal abilities of nature beings, except that water beings rarely use this. There is also one ability that you have spoken little about, which also needs to be mentioned. Nature beings who are mature enough can communicate with other beings, including humans through images and visions. Often such a vision or image shows more of the gist of the issue being addressed and promotes a better understanding of the subject.

Tobias: Is there anything else you would add?

Keeper: I think the topic is exhausted. One can still, of course, mention the singing of mermaids that you have discussed. This singing is extremely beautiful and any being who hears it is able to feel the closeness of nature, as well as of the Light itself.

Tobias: Thank you for this short message!

The Guardian: Thank you for inviting me to this talk. I am honoured to have been able to contribute to increasing cognition about water beings.

### 3.15. Interaction with other natural beings and with humans

*Some time later, Ruslana and her mentor appeared.*

Bartosz: Welcome to you! We wanted to ask you what kind of interactions take place between water beings and other natural beings, as well as between them and humans.

The Guardian: In terms of interaction with people, it is at a very low level because very few people take into account that such beings exist. However, it does happen and I would like Ruslana to comment here.

Ruslana: I have been on earth for a very long time and such interactions with humans have been extremely rare in my experience. I have this habit, which is quite common among water beings. I put garlands I have woven on the heads of people who know about us and see us. This is how I appreciate people who are pure and mindful of the beauty of nature and its laws. Now I wanted to give you these garlands. Accept them from me.

*Ruslana put garlands around our necks.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you Ruslana!

Keeper: When it comes to interactions between water beings and other natural beings, of course they happen. They are usually determined by the need to perform common tasks, e.g. soil gnomes under a river can also affect the biota of a river. Perhaps Ruslana will say something more.

Bartholomew: Ruslana, do you have friends among other creatures of nature?

Ruslana: I used to have a close relationship with a certain gnome, but I don't know if I would call it a friendship. Of all the creatures of nature, I am currently friends with two ruslana in my area of operation.

The Guardian: I think intra-species friendships are more common among natural beings. This is because such beings understand each other more and have common goals. I will say of myself as a russet caregiver that I also have friendship relationships among caregivers. As with me, it is easier to befriend someone whose activities we fully understand because they are similar to our own.

Tobias: Do you have any free time and do you spend it together?

Carer: We don't have any kind of schedule and I generally concentrate on doing whatever the need of the moment dictates. I also have free time which I spend alone or talking to my friends, other carers, but generally I am always alert and on standby.

Ruslana: I like to lie down in my hut in a moment of leisure and relax. I usually feel that in such moments I connect more with the Creator.

Tobias: Is there anything you would add?

Caregiver: Just like humans, creatures of nature and their caregivers have time to fulfil their duties, and free time. We know very well what friendship is and we also enter into such friendship relationships. We appreciate people who want to get close to us and build friendships with us. We believe that there will be more and more such relationships on the planet.

Ruslana: I would just add that what the guardian said at the end, about friendships between humans and beings of nature, is very pleasing to our Creator. Let us draw closer to each other and serve the Light together, for it is wanted.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

### 3.16. Water-related disasters

*We decided to continue the conversation with the mentor by asking about disasters related to the element of water.*

Tobias: Welcome back! What would you say about natural disasters such as floods, tsunamis, etc.?

The Guardian: I think I can say something more broadly about floods, although I am not some great expert on disasters. Floods, of course, are seen by people as an unwanted calamity, however, they also have benefits in nature. The Egyptians, for example, valued the annual flooding of the Nile because they were grateful for the benefits it gave to their soils.

*After a while.*

The Guardian: From my conversation with Bartosz, I know that the torrential rains and associated floods in Bangladesh allow the people there to harvest three times a year. However, I can tell you more about the destructive elemental activity of the floods.

*After a brief pause.*

The Guardian: The fact that someone will be affected by this element is no accident. Like everything in nature, the effects of floods are also anchored in law.

Tobias: People do not have this knowledge and even often reject it... What would you say to those who are seeking the truth on this issue?

The Guardian: Both floods and great tsunamis, which can bring death, are formed by beings that are anchored in the will of God. Beings of nature are even forbidden to act otherwise, and often would not even be able to do so. Therefore, it must be taken into account that nature does not give people a just reckoning. However, if people were more aware of the beings of nature they could be warned more often. Unfortunately, the error of ignorance in this matter of earthly people can even cost earthly lives.

Bartholomew: Would I like to add something?

Guardian: The element of water brings life, but it can also bring destruction. Man, who lives on this planet, should respect this element more and have respect for it. Man can no longer feel that he is the master of nature, because he is not. Nature is made available to him to give him benefits and man, according to the law of balance, should return the same. Man of the earth, use and accept the gifts of nature, such as water, remembering that you should and even must return the favour by preserving the purity and harmony of your waters.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your messages!

### 3.17 Governors of the seas

*The next day we decided to ask Ruslana's caretaker about the so-called Governors of the Seas.*

Bartholomew: Hello Guardian! You told me that you were prepared to give us knowledge about the governors of the seas. We are listening to you!

Guardian: Every sea has its own leader, or king. It is coveted to call them governors. All kings have their female partners and together they rule the seas. The division of power is between male and female, between the governor and his wife. There are many female beings in the seas, led by a woman.

Tobias: You're talking about the seas, what's the situation with rivers, lakes or oceans?

The Guardian: When it comes to lakes and rivers they have their higher superiors and are also male and female. The supervisors have a division by area, which covers quite a large range of continents. They also have a say in the guardians of individual russets, nymphs or other creatures.

*After a while.*

Keeper: The oceans are also divided into spheres of influence, but I wanted to talk about the governors of the seas. The governors and governesses of the seas have a great influence on the guardians, as well as on the mermaids themselves and all beings in the seas. Bartholomew: I understand that all governors and superiors are subject to the king of earthly water beings. I have already had a message that such a being exists.

Keeper: There is a king and a queen. They are based in the heart of the Pacific Ocean and stand highest in the hierarchy of water beings. They do not rank among the beings of nature or the elemental beings, but among the great elemental leaders themselves. ## 4. Conclusion

Finally, we wanted to draw attention to one important aspect that applies to all beings of nature, not only those discussed in this book. When interacting with beings, one must constantly take into account the degree of their maturity. This is extremely important because the knowledge that our books give is already very advanced, especially if we are referring to the abilities that a being can awaken (such as relocation or the ability to change body size). It is a matter of great importance that especially young beings are not given information about abilities that they could only awaken in the distant future. Beings are simply not ready to awaken the abilities in question, and they could wish to do so. They do not have knowledge of these abilities and it is not beneficial for them to have it at this stage. Such topics as potential abilities should be avoided, because we cannot always count on a given caregiver to break the transmission and tell us about it. We write about this because we ourselves have made many mistakes in this area, especially at the beginning. This is a very important point. Remember that it is the degree of maturity that should shape the degree of a given contact and a given conversation. Young beings are bound to be happy to express themselves on other topics, and their level of current maturity in no way detracts from them.
