2. Beings of the Air

2.1. Introduction

A being appeared, designated to guide us in our task regarding the beings of air and wind.

Windy: Greetings, I want you to call me Windy. I am a being of the wind, and I like this name. I have been chosen to initiate the messages for the world concerning the beings of air and wind. I am not the only one; others will follow after me. My mission is to introduce the subject.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: We warmly welcome you. We are happy about your assignment.

Bartosz: You are a very joyful being. Until now, I've spoken with less joyful ones.

Windy: I believe that's why I was chosen as well — to bring a good mood into our conversations. There are many beings of nature who are joyful, and through your contact with me, you should start to notice this too.

Tobiasz: Please, begin your message.

Windy: I'll start by saying that I am a young wind being. Beings related to the air can be divided into two main types: air beings and wind beings. Air beings are often called sylphs, while wind beings don't have a specific name. In fact, these terms are often conventional, and they can differ across cultures. We accept that you call air beings sylphs.

After a moment of reflection.

Windy: Besides these two different types — air beings and wind beings — there are other, lesser-known types, but others designated for this purpose will tell you about them. We are happy to pass on knowledge about us to you.

Bartosz: How will we communicate? Will it be in a similar way to how we communicated with the beings of earth and fire?

Windy: Yes, I think the approach will be similar. However, we will inform you in advance, with one or two days' notice, about the topics we'll cover, so you have time to reflect and be more engaged during the conversations with us.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to add by way of introduction?

Windy: I wanted to say that there is great joy among the beings of nature, including the beings of air and wind, because humanity will come to know more about us. We hope for human beings to draw closer to us. Remember, people, even though we may cause damage to your homes and other structures through our actions, you must understand that we are acting as an expression of the Divine Will. Despite everything, we love you and treat you as brothers. We know that most of your species is lost, but we trust that the awakening to love and spirituality will continue within you. Open yourselves to the knowledge and messages we will send through this book.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: We are so excited to be in contact with you! Until we meet again!

2.2. Air Beings – Initial Understanding

On the same day, we continued our conversation with Windy.

Tobiasz: Windy, welcome again! Please, begin.

Windy: Welcome! There are many species of air beings that we call sylphs. Their main role is to purify the air. Their radiation cleanses the air. Their role in Creation is invaluable, and it is worth every person appreciating it. When someone goes for a walk and feels the fresh air, they should realize that the quality of that air is thanks to the sylphs. Unfortunately, humans create more work for the sylphs. Humans pollute the air, which sylphs then have to clean. It is sad that so few people are aware of this. We love you humans, but the fact that you pollute this planet so heavily is your fault, and we are fully aware that you will reap the consequences of this.

Bartosz: How do sylphs purify the air?

Windy: Their very presence accomplishes this task. Wherever a sylph is and its radiation exists, the process of air purification happens naturally. Of course, their dance-like movements, which they often perform, accelerate this process. If a human could see a sylph just once and understand its beneficial effect on air quality, they would appreciate nature and its children — such as the beings of nature — much more.

Tobiasz: Does polluted air cause sylphs any suffering or pain?

Windy: Primarily, the extreme pollution that humans create causes pain for sylphs because they often see that their enormous efforts and work are in vain. That's why sylphs often dislike humans and their destructive actions toward the environment. Sylphs would like to cooperate with humans to help the planet thrive, but at this stage of humanity's development, this is impossible.

Bartosz: Would you add anything as an introduction to understanding sylphs?

Windy: Yes, I would like to add something. Sylphs are magnificent beings that improve the quality of the air. Their role in Creation is invaluable, yet so little known among humans. Every sylph knows that its tasks in Creation is to refine and beautify our planet. Humans, please realize that polluting the air is actually the cause of many diseases and dysfunctions in both humans and animals. Dear people, be more conscious of the fact that the quality of the air must be taken care of. The sylphs alone cannot fulfill this task. Your involvement is also necessary to ensure that your industries and all the things you use to pollute the air are improved and made more environmentally friendly.

2.3. Wind Beings – Initial Understanding

We continued our conversation with Windy and moved on to discussing the wind beings.

Bartosz: Dear Windy, what can you tell us about the wind beings?

Windy: Finally, something about my species, of which I am a representative.

After a brief pause.

Windy: Many people probably wonder where the wind comes from and what the role of wind beings is in its creation. Well, we are the initiators of all winds. Our movement is the father of all winds. Without wind beings, there would be no wind. Do you have any questions?

Tobiasz: What is the purpose and role of wind?

Windy: Primarily, it is cleansing, but not only that. Winds bring climate changes and can build or destroy.

Tobiasz: Build?

Windy: For example, favorable wind currents can improve crop yields. They can benefit every species of tree and, of course, carry seeds over great distances, where they may later sprout into plants.

Bartosz: How do you initiate wind? You mentioned some kind of movement... Can you describe it?

Windy: Like every species of nature beings, we too want to keep some secrets, but I can tell you that our movement, which initiates the wind, is very noble. However, I am not permitted to give more detailed descriptions.

Bartosz: I fully understand. Is there anything else you'd like to add?

Windy: It's important to know that we also act under the command of the Divine Will. Our movements that initiate winds are never random, and as I mentioned, they can build or destroy. This building and destroying is always in alignment with God's Justice. People should finally realize that the movements of the winds, like all of nature, are not accidental. In our actions, we see a deeper purpose and joyfully strive to fulfill it. The goal is always to harmonize with the Divine Will. There is no place here for chance or arbitrariness. Every wind being must — and even desires to — align with what the Divine Will dictates.

Tobiasz: Like the sylphs, are there many species of wind beings?

Windy: There are many species of wind beings, depending on the strength of the wind they can initiate. You must know that there are many powerful beings whose movements can destroy vast cities like houses of cards. This awareness should bring humility into your lives regarding the forces of nature.

Tobiasz: Would you like to add anything else?

Windy: In modern times, humans are increasingly resentful and rebellious against what the forces of the winds bring. More and more frequently, wind forces cause destruction. Hurricanes, tornadoes, cyclones, and other wind actions destroy human properties. Humans must humbly accept the justice of what the wind brings. Very few people, and in many cases, no one, sees the Justice of God's Laws that also govern the forces of the wind. We want the world to know the truth that nothing is by chance, and everyone who has lost something due to the force of the wind deserved it. The force of nature is ruthless to those who have distanced themselves from the Light. Remember this, people.

Tobiasz and Bartosz: Thank you!

2.4. Guardians of Sylphs and Wind Beings

The next day, we continued our conversation with Windy.

Tobiasz: Welcome, Windy! Today, tell us more about the guardians of wind beings and sylphs.

Windy: Today's message will be brief. Just like other nature beings, both sylphs and wind beings have their own guardians. These guardians are a different species from sylphs and wind beings, and their role is crucial in organizing the tasks assigned to each nature being.

Bartosz: Is it similar to the gnomes, where there are species and sector guardians?

Windy: Yes, it's exactly as you say. One type of guardian oversees the development of a specific species, such as enhancing the qualities of a particular group of sylphs. The second type of guardian is the sector guardian, responsible for a specific area and for tasks assigned to the sylphs or wind beings in that region. Task distribution is managed by the guardians, and the guardians themselves have higher overseers, who can also be called guardians.

Bartosz: Is the guardian system, like with other nature beings, hierarchical?

Windy: Yes, you must understand that this structure applies to all the guardians of nature beings. Each higher guardian oversees a larger territory or a greater number of beings. This structure is both simple and highly effective. It ensures that the work in Creation and the fulfillment of tasks becomes a living pleasure. The higher the guardian, the greater the responsibility.

After a moment of reflection.

Windy: We are grateful to our guardians for working so well with us. Without their diligent and dedicated service, there would be chaos in all of Creation. Every guardian is a magnificent being, fully aware of their tasks and goals. The highest guardians are powerful beings who have insight into the movements of wind and air across the entire planet. For lower-ranked guardians, having contact with them is a great honor.

Tobiasz: How often do you speak with your guardians?

Windy: That's a very good question, Tobiasz. I speak with my species guardian very rarely, but their insights into the elevation of my being are invaluable. I last spoke with them about a month ago. However, I talk more frequently with my sector guardian. Sometimes, we communicate several times a day, but there can also be pauses of a few days. The main topic of our discussions is the initiation and direction of the wind, including its strength. The guardian knows exactly what the Divine Will is in this regard and provides me with guidance. Sometimes, there are quiet days, like today, when I don't have many tasks. You could say I have time to rest, but there are also days when the wind is meant to be very intense, and then my activity is also more heightened.

Tobiasz: And what do you discuss with your species guardian?

Windy: These are details we don't fully wish to share, but generally, it's about ensuring I develop in alignment with the path set for my species. We too evolve and have stages of development ahead of us. The goal for us, nature beings, is also growth, and as you likely know, our ultimate aim is to return to the Animistic Realm, from which our immortal sparks originate.

Tobiasz: Would you like to add anything else on this topic?

Windy: You should know that the sector guardians often collaborate and join forces in various tasks. We are grateful that the Creator has arranged things in such a way that we can rely on guidance and support. All of this aids in our further development, and as grateful beings, we can carry out the Divine Will in Creation.

Tobiasz and Bartosz: Thank you!

2.5. The Origin of Wind

The next day, we decided to talk with Windy about the origin of wind. Here is the record of our conversation.

Tobiasz: Welcome, Windy. Today, we'd like to talk more about the wind.

Windy: Greetings, my dear friends.

Tobiasz: Earthly science says that wind is created by differences in pressure, temperature changes, and variations in the terrain. How would you comment on this?

Windy: Those are the conditions and circumstances that support the formation of winds. However, behind these conditions and circumstances also lies the work of animistic beings. We wind beings are drawn to such places where these conditions exist. Thanks to these circumstances, we initiate the winds without much effort.

Bartosz: Considering that such conditions and circumstances might arise, would wind still form without your involvement?

Windy: I am convinced that without our involvement, it would not be possible.

Bartosz: Forgive me, Windy, but I have some doubts... I think it's mainly because this is something new to me.

Windy: Don't worry, Bartosz. I know this information is new to most people. We initiate all winds. If that weren't the case, our existence wouldn't have much meaning. Winds don't create themselves; the force of animistic beings is necessary, and we wind beings are that force.

Tobiasz: As we understand it, one wind being creates the wind, and then others pick up the created wind, possibly strengthening or redirecting it. Is that correct?

Windy: Yes, Tobiasz, what you described is completely accurate. Often, alongside the initiators, there are many smaller wind beings that support the actions with a certain strength and in a specific direction. Frequently, more powerful wind beings take over the wind initiated by the smaller ones and increase its strength. The opposite can also occur, where smaller wind beings take over the wind and reduce its power. There are many possibilities and cases, and I don't want to go into too much detail, as a general overview is enough for you humans.

Tobiasz: Humans can artificially create air movement, for example, with fans. Do wind beings also participate in this process in some way?

Windy: Wind beings could only enhance the strength of the air movement initiated by a fan, but we do not do so, as it is not the Will of the Light for us to engage in such actions.

After a short pause, Windy added.

Windy: We act in harmony with nature and in accordance with its laws, and all fans are artificial human creations.

Tobiasz: I think this short conversation will give us humans a lot to think about. Is there anything else you would like to add?

Windy: Thank you, Tobiasz, for these questions. They give people the opportunity to get to know us better. I must say, the questions were very interesting and showed me how humans think about the creation of winds. Without us, wind beings, no wind would form on Earth. Our strength lies in the initiation of wind. This ability is given to us by the Light. We don't want to go into the details of how

exactly we initiate wind. It's enough for humans to know that our movement and activity create the winds. Let the details remain our secret, which we may reveal to humans one day. But for now, it's not the right time. Draw closer to us, humans. Let your understanding of us become proper and true.

Tobiasz: Thank you, Windy!

Bartosz: Thank you!

Windy: Thank you. I'm glad I can share the truth about wind beings with you.

2.6. The Appearance of Sylphs

The next day, we decided to talk about appearance, starting with the sylphs.

Bartosz: Hello, Windy. Could you describe the appearance of sylphs?

Windy: Yes, I'm ready...

Bartosz: Please, begin.

Windy: Sylphs are semi-transparent. They have wings, which allow them to move through the air.

Tobiasz: Wings made of what?

Bartosz: Do these wings look like those of angels?

Windy: The wings are semi-transparent and are likely feathered wings. Sylphs resemble angels, except that their wings and arms are one, whereas angels have separate wings and arms.

Bartosz: Do they wear shoes?

Windy: No, they don't wear shoes. They don't need them since they are almost always in the air.

Tobiasz: And their clothing?

Windy: They wear short shorts and something like a shirt. Everything is semi-transparent and not very distinct.

Bartosz: Do they shimmer in any colors?

Windy: I believe each sylph shimmers in various rainbow colors, depending on their preference. In my opinion, they don't have fixed colors in their appearance.

Tobiasz: And their face — eyes, ears, nose, hair?

Windy: Their eyebrows are bushy and long, and their eyes are large. They have human-like ears. Their hair reaches below their shoulders, so it's fairly long. Their nose is quite similar to a human's. Their expressions are usually cheerful. They are semi-transparent and don't have fixed colors on their faces, but generally, luminosity and beauty dominate.

A sylph appeared...

Sylph: There are many sylphs who match this description in appearance. I just wanted to add that there are many species of us, and we differ in appearance. Let this description serve as a depiction of one type of sylph. I think that's enough to spark the imagination of humans. But remember, humans, there are many of us, and we vary in appearance.

After a moment, the sylph added.

Sylph: Our clothing also has fringed edges... They're not exactly like typical human shorts and shirts.

Tobiasz: Welcome! Is there anything else you'd like to add about your appearance?

Sylph: I think that's enough. The description of our appearance should be general. If an artist were to see us one day, they could paint us. I believe there will be such attempts in the future.

Tobiasz: In that case, thank you, and we'll move on to the wind beings.

2.7. The Appearance of Wind Beings

We continued our conversation with Windy...

Tobiasz: Please, Windy, begin.

Windy: Wind beings are somewhat grosser than sylphs... Their appearance is also semi-transparent.

Bartosz: Do they also have wings?

Windy: Of course... However, compared to sylphs, wind beings have much larger wings.

After a pause, he added.

Windy: The wings of wind beings play a significant role in initiating wind, but since it's not desired to delve into details, I won't go further on this.

He continued.

Windy: We wear slightly longer pants, often held up by suspenders, which is interesting. Our clothing is also adorned with fringed edges... To see the difference between a sylph and a wind being, you'd have to see us in person... The main difference is the length of the wings and the greater density of wind beings, which is also noticeable in their appearance.

Bartosz: So sylphs are more delicate?

Windy: They also have more delicate tasks. I think the sylph you spoke to today will visit you again and tell you more about their duties.

Tobiasz: And your faces?

Windy: Our faces resemble human faces... There's really not much difference... We usually have long hair, and we almost always smile... It's a very joyful experience to be a wind being.

Tobiasz: I've read that some wind beings have three eyes¹... Is that true?

Windy: There are some with three eyes... But my face is human-like.

Tobiasz: What is the purpose of the third eye?

Windy: To spark your imagination, I'll just say that there are thousands of different species of us... I haven't even met half of them, and I'm one of these beings... So it's very hard to generalize. In my

opinion, wind beings vary slightly depending on the climate. I feel this because I'm a being that operates in Poland, and I can guess that those in Argentina are quite different.

After a moment of reflection...

Windy: I've never been to Argentina, but I'm sure there are many differences between us...

And he added:

Windy: I think the third eye could be an additional sense, but honestly, I don't know because I don't have one.

Tobiasz: I understand... The description I've read probably refers to a different species of wind beings. Apparently, this eye shines like a spotlight and, with its strong radiation, can trigger storms, etc.

Bartosz: Thank you, Windy, for what you've shared with us today... I think the general picture you've given us provides some insights, which, although general, are still very helpful.

Windy: Thank you... I feel my task has come to an end... Other beings will now visit you to expand your understanding. I must admit that presenting an overall image of a sylph and a wind being was quite a challenging task, but I believe I've passed this test as well. Thank you, I feel content and fulfilled...

Tobiasz: Be a blessed wind being!

Windy: Thank you!

2.8. The Role of Sylphs

Here is the record of our conversation with the sylph:

Bartosz: Hello, sylph. Yesterday, you expressed a desire to talk. What more can you tell us about sylphs?

Sylph: As you already know, our task is to care for the quality of the air. Today, I wanted to say a bit more about that.

Tobiasz: Hello! We're listening...

Bartosz: I understand that you simply purify the air?

Sylph: Yes. We purify the air to improve its quality. I don't want to go into details, as it is preferred to only present a general picture...

After a brief pause.

Sylph: The first way we purify the air, and thus fulfill our task, is simply by our presence... Our very presence, or more precisely, our radiation, cleanses the air.

Tobiasz: Do you also purify the air of negative energies created by human actions that go against the Divine Will?

Sylph: We only improve the quality of the air. Humans must take care of the energetic cleanliness around them themselves...

After a pause...

Sylph: The second way we purify the air is through our physical activity. We don't wish to explain exactly how this looks, but we can say that our movement cleanses the air.

After a brief pause.

Sylph: The third and final way we purify the air is by blowing. We don't create wind this way, well, maybe in a minimal sense, but we do cleanse the air. Our ability to blow is far greater than that of humans...

Bartosz: Thank you for your message. Could you tell us more about the different species of sylphs mentioned yesterday?

Sylph: Yes, there are many species of sylphs. Each species differs in appearance and body size. That's why I remind you that the sylph's appearance described yesterday is only a general representation. However, the most important distinguishing factor between us is the type of pollution that each sylph can cleanse. For example, I purify the air from dust particles. There are also sylphs that purify the air from different kinds of gases. As you can imagine, there are many species of sylphs, and each cleanses something different. This knowledge is completely sufficient for humans.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to say?

Sylph: Remember, humans, that the good quality of the air in your area is largely thanks to us. Don't make our work harder — take care not to pollute the air. Due to your irresponsible actions, we have much more work to do. However, we believe that the time will come when humans will no longer hinder our tasks but instead make them easier. Thank you for letting me expand your understanding of us sylphs, even just a little. I feel that I have fulfilled my task.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you! Be a blessed sylph!

Sylph: Thank you.

2.9. Vento

A wind being appeared to expand our understanding, following what Windy had shared with us. We decided to call him Vento to simplify communication.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Welcome! Do you like the name Vento that we've given you?

Vento: Hello! I like it very much. I might even consider using it on a daily basis...

Tobiasz: What can we talk about today?

Vento: I think we can discuss, or rather define, the species classification of wind beings.

Bartosz: So how is that classification structured?

Vento: I believe the general overview I want to present will be fully sufficient.

After a moment of reflection.

Vento: I think there are thousands of species of wind beings. We distinguish between small supporting beings, progressively larger beings who can initiate wind on their own, all the way to powerful beings capable of initiating mighty storms, tempests, and even hurricanes.

Bartosz: So I understand that each species can generate or initiate wind of a certain strength?

Vento: Yes, you understand correctly. Each species has a range of wind force they can initiate, from small breezes to enormous hurricanes. You're probably curious about how storms form, right? They are initiated by powerful wind beings in combination with other high-ranking beings. The beings of specific species that participate in storm formation are assigned by guardians, who themselves are guided on what force to initiate and how great the changes in a given area should be caused by the storm.

Tobiasz: Are clouds created by wind beings, or do separate beings form the clouds?

Vento: There are many beings in the air that can be classified as air beings, though they are not sylphs. The beings that form clouds are another species you could get to know. They cooperate with wind beings, and I think they can be classified along with sylphs simply as air beings.

Tobiasz: Is there another species of air beings you can tell us about?

Vento: There are bird guides. They initiate bird migrations and lead them to their destined regions.

Bartosz: Thank you for the information you've given us today, and we kindly ask you to prepare more knowledge about the cloud beings and bird guides.

Vento: My knowledge on this subject may not be sufficient, but I feel that other beings might appear who could speak more extensively about it. I am a wind being, and I can mainly talk about my species.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, and we'll hear from you again tomorrow!

2.10. Cloud Beings

The next day, we decided to talk with Vento about the cloud beings.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello, Vento! We hope you're ready to talk about the cloud beings.

Vento: Hello! I believe I can handle the task.

Bartosz: What can you tell us about the cloud beings?

Vento: As the name suggests, cloud beings live within the clouds. They are the ones who refine and care for these parts of nature that we call clouds. As you probably know, there are many types of clouds, and consequently, many species of cloud beings. They differ in appearance as well as in the tasks they are assigned to perform.

Tobiasz: What are their tasks?

Vento: As I mentioned, they refine the clouds, but that's not all. They support the process of cloud formation. You could also say they help shape the clouds, although most of this work is done by nature itself and its laws.

Tobiasz: Can cloud beings shape clouds into any forms they desire?

Vento: Yes, but it's not common. Cloud beings can shape clouds into any desired forms. If a man is pure enough, their volition can also influence this. The process works when cloud beings respond to and connect with the pure volition of a human.

Bartosz: Once, I was hoping to see a heart-shaped cloud, and I saw a heart formed from the clouds.

Vento: Yes. That confirms what I've just said.

Bartosz: What other tasks do cloud beings have?

Vento: Cloud beings decide when and where it will rain. Of course, they collaborate on this task with other nature beings, primarily with wind beings. Cloud beings also care for and tend to the crystals and droplets within the clouds, ensuring their purity. Their radiation plays a significant role in this process. As you can see, refining the clouds is a key part of their work. Refinement is the primary task of all nature beings. Through their guardian beings, cloud beings receive information on when and where rain should fall and in what amounts. This process is mostly carried out by nature itself, but cloud beings also have a degree of control over it.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to add?

Vento: I believe the knowledge that comes from my message is sufficient. Be aware, humans, that all processes in nature are either supported or directly carried out by nature beings. Let the understanding that flows from this simple message take root in you, and if it is the Creator's Will, it will be expanded upon in the future.

2.11. Bird Guides

Next, we decided to talk about bird guides.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Vento, can you tell us more about bird guides?

Vento: I have gained knowledge about these beings that I didn't have before. So, interacting with you also enriches my understanding.

Tobiasz: Please, begin.

Vento: Bird guides are air beings who, through their presence, support the migration of birds. They guide groups of birds to the regions of the planet where their future habitats will be. The guiding process itself is simple, but there are a few important aspects to mention. The beings who act as guides can communicate with the birds. To do this, they send out certain types of sounds that only birds can hear.

After a moment of silence...

Vento: These sounds can influence the decisions of the bird group regarding the migration route they choose.

Bartosz: Do bird guides also lead birds by flying in front of them?

Vento: They can do that, but it's not always necessary. Birds often already have a sense of where they should fly.

Bartosz: So the sounds you mentioned are a way of informing the birds where they should go?

Vento: Yes, but communication continues during the flight, and that's how the birds know where to go. The flight paths are often similar but not identical to those of previous years. The path may sometimes avoid certain disruptions, such as storms or strong winds.

Bartosz: Do bird guides create a kind of "corridor" for the birds to follow?

Vento: The corridor is created according to harmonious laws. The Divine Will ensures that no harm comes to the birds during their flight. Yes, bird guides create the safest and most beneficial flight paths, thus ensuring the birds' safety. Sometimes, they fly ahead of the birds and lead entire flocks. Tobiasz: How are these sounds produced? Do these beings use any special instruments?

Vento: They produce the sounds using their vocal apparatus. However, these sounds are inaudible to humans.

Bartosz: Do we distinguish different species of these guides?

Vento: Yes, the species of bird guides are matched and adapted to the various species of birds. Each bird species has its specific type of guide, which it fully trusts and follows.

Tobiasz: Can these beings be called fylgens?

Vento: Yes, that is one of the terms known in the world and is used to refer to bird guides.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you'd like to add?

Vento: People often describe bird migrations as being driven by their instinctual inner guidance. There is some truth to this, but only a grain, as this inner guidance is initiated by the bird guides specifically assigned for this purpose. These guides ensure the best possible flight routes for entire bird groups. This knowledge may be new to most people, but it is important that they become aware of it.

2.12. Hurricanes

The next day, we decided to talk with Vento about the formation of hurricanes.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello, Vento! Today, we'd like to talk about hurricanes...

Vento: Hello! I'm ready for the conversation.

Bartosz: So, what can you tell us about hurricanes?

Vento: Science identifies certain factors that must be in place for a hurricane to form. However, science overlooks one very important factor — the presence of nature beings during the occurrence of hurricanes.

Bartosz: Does one being create a hurricane, or is it a group of beings that drives it?

Vento: First, you must understand that hurricanes are formed by powerful nature beings, specifically high-ranking wind beings. Every hurricane is initiated by one powerful being, which plays a dominant role in its creation. However, there are also many supporting beings involved, not just wind beings.

After a brief moment of silence.

Vento: The power of a hurricane is no small thing, which is why the beings that initiate and shape them are truly mighty. They act under the orders of high animistic beings from the Animistic Sphere.

The entire process is controlled by the Divine Will, which means that every hurricane is fully willed by the Light.

Bartosz: I understand that the effects of a hurricane, such as destruction, are also anchored in the law?

Vento: You could say that there is no randomness in the material losses that affect humans. We must understand that the Divine Will controls all destruction through justice and love. Therefore, people must realize that all losses caused by the force of a hurricane are deserved. We, the beings of nature, cannot act independently, and in all our actions, we always reflect the Will of the Light.

Bartosz: I understand that the dominant being in the formation of a hurricane influences the supporting beings. Can you tell us more about this being?

Vento: Its circular, swirling movement can be seen as a mighty dance of the elements. This movement has a huge impact on the strength of the hurricane. Bartosz: Can humans prepare for these times in any way?

Very few people currently have such protection, which is why I call out to you, humans: Draw closer to the Creator in your daily lives! Strive with all your strength to live in harmony with His Laws! By doing so, the force of the hurricane or any other element will not touch you! Be vigilant and listen to the voice of your intuition, to your hearts. It will always show you the right path to survive the difficult times that are coming.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, Vento!

Vento: Thank you!

2.13. Abilities and Gender

After a few days' break, we resumed our conversations with Vento.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello, Vento!

Vento: Hello! What would you like to talk about?

Tobiasz: Today, we'd like to discuss abilities and gender...

Vento: Let me start with our gender. My type of activity is more masculine, but I am a very delicate being and, in a way, possess many feminine traits.

Tobiasz: Are all wind beings male?

Vento: All the wind beings I know are similar to me, meaning they have a masculine form with a strong presence of feminine characteristics. However, I can't speak for all, as I don't know every wind being.

Tobiasz: And how do you perceive sylphs?

Vento: I think it's similar to my situation. I also perceive bird guides and cloud beings in the same way. However, I can't speak for all of them, as there are many species I might not be familiar with.

Bartosz: We've learned about the abilities of other nature beings. Can you tell us about your abilities?

Vento: Our primary ability aligns with our main task: we can create and amplify the strength of the wind. In this area, we are specialists.

Tobiasz: Do you have the ability to relocate or change and increase your form?

Vento: The ability to relocate is common among older wind beings. We don't have the ability to increase our form. We can momentarily change our experiential form, but I don't personally use that ability.

Bartosz: I assume the same applies to sylphs, bird guides, and cloud beings?

Vento: Yes, we are closely related species, and the abilities I've described are present among them as well.

Tobiasz: I think we can wrap up this topic. Vento, would you like to add anything?

Vento: I believe that's all I can say on this subject. I will now conclude my conversations with you, as I feel my knowledge on further topics is insufficient, and an older being will come to you next.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, Vento, for your messages — you've truly given us a lot! Be a blessed wind being!

Vento: I feel fulfilled! Thank you!

2.14. The Beneficial Influence of Air and Wind

A moment later, two beings appeared, not just one, to expand our current understanding. We decided to begin with the beneficial influence of air and wind.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Welcome! Would you accept the names William and Victor that we would like to give you for the duration of this task?

William: Yes, I like that name very much. Remember, Bartosz, that I am a bit more cheerful so you can distinguish us.

Victor: I accept the name. To make it easier, I'll be heard in Bartosz's left ear, while William will be in the right...

Tobiasz: Tell us about the influence of air and wind on the health of earthly humans...

William: The purity and quality of air have a tremendous impact on health. We know that dirty and polluted air causes numerous diseases. Humans contribute to the worsening air quality, and we, as representatives of the air beings, urge humans to stop polluting the air and the entire planet so much.

Victor: We are aware that human influence on air quality is negative. Humans make the tasks of beings that purify the air, like sylphs, more difficult. We would like this book to raise human awareness about air and wind beings. We don't expect your gratitude for our actions, as gratitude belongs to the Creator, but we want you to know about our work and do more to not hinder our activities.

Bartosz: I understand that wind plays a significant role in purification in nature...

William: Yes, the beings living in trees, the trees themselves, and plants all wait for the cleansing that the wind provides. This process of purification is necessary from time to time for all of nature. Even storms, which often cause fear among beings, have an essential cleansing role. Thanks to them, nature gains vitality and brings refreshment to all beings.

Victor: Wind is essential. Even during the formation and transformation of the planet, wind played a vital role, and not much has changed since then. We, the wind beings, know about the benefits William mentioned, and with great love, we carry out our tasks. It brings immense joy to feel so useful and needed in the vastness of Creation.

Bartosz: Would you like to add anything to conclude this message?

William: I am honored to have shared these brief words and to present my perspective on this topic. I believe that my individual insight does not differ much from the overall view of this subject.

Victor: I feel that humanity will change, that events will lead to this change, and the people who survive the great purification will care more for the entire planet and the air.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, Victor and William!

William and Victor: Thank you as well! We'll stay in touch...

2.15. Rest and William and Victor's Call to a New Task

The next day, we continued our conversations with the two higher wind beings.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello! How do you handle rest and sleep?

William: We don't need as much sleep as humans, so we don't sleep as often, but we do rest, and it's desired that we have this time for ourselves.

Tobiasz: How do you rest?

Tobiasz: Welcome, being appointed to speak with us about animistic paradise of the beings of air and wind. Please, begin!

If humanity does not fail, there will be others among them who are called to build upon this general picture presented in your book. For example, there are multitudes of species of beings, and what your book contains is just the introduction to broader explanations.

3. Water Beings

3.1. Preliminary Information

We have opened ourselves to contact with water beings. A nymph appeared.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Greetings, nymph! What can you say at the outset about the water beings, of which you are a representative?

Nymph: Greetings! This noble element, which is water, needs beings who care for it. We, water beings, mostly have female forms and dwell in rivers, ponds, lakes, seas, and oceans.

Tobiasz: What will we discuss with you, the water beings?

Nymph: First and foremost, we will introduce you to the main species of water beings, which include nymphs, rusalkas, and mermaids. We want to raise human awareness about water beings, so this description is meant to enrich your knowledge. It's not just our desire, but also the Will of the Light, to expand human understanding of us.

Bartosz: Could you tell us something general about your specific species?

Nymph: We have been on Earth for a very long time. We are also present on all planets where there is water. We nourish the water, and you could say we are the guardians of places where water exists. Our tasks resonate with the Will of God, and what we are assigned as our daily duties is always in alignment with God's Will.

Bartosz: What else will we be discussing?

Nymph: Like with other species, we want to briefly introduce you to the appearance of our female forms. We also want to talk about our guardianship, meaning our guidance. Finally, we will present the truth about our leaders and, if it is the Will of the Light, we will provide a brief description of our water capital.

Bartosz: Do nymphs, rusalkas, and mermaids also ennoble other planes of Creation? For me, this is obvious, but I would like you to explain how it works...

Nymph: Of course, we exist on gross-material planets, but also on other planes of Creation. Wherever there is water throughout Creation, there too are we. The main principle is that the higher the plane of Creation, the greater the maturity of the water beings that operate there. On Earth, we are here temporarily, and our main goal is to mature and return to the Animistic Realm. However, most of us do not think about this main goal and instead focus on the tasks dictated by God's Will.

Tobiasz: Would you like to add anything at the end of our introduction?

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you. We will keep you in our thoughts!

3.2. An Introduction to Rusalkas

Two days later, we began a discussion with a water being named Ruslana. She is a representative of the rusalkas species.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Greetings, Ruslana! What can you tell us about your species?

Ruslana: We are water beings who take care of and ennoble streams and smaller rivers. We are often confused with nymphs, who are larger than us and operate in larger rivers, ponds, and lakes. There are many species of us, and we fulfill our duties, which are assigned to us by the Light, with joy.

Bartosz: Is a nymph actually the same species as a rusalka, just larger?

Tobiasz: Tell us, what is it like to be a rusalka, and how do you feel on a daily basis?

Ruslana: It's an incredible feeling to be a rusalka, needed by the Creator and Creation. We, rusalkas, joyfully carry out every task dictated to us by God's Will. As a result, we are often smiling and simply in good mood. We feel good in our bodies and are grateful for the form of our bodies, which was also shaped by God's Will.

Bartosz: Dear Ruslana, what can you say about the influence of humans on your experience and work?

Ruslana: Unfortunately, humans make our tasks very difficult. They do not take care of the cleanliness of rivers and streams. Tobiasz: This question pertains to all nature beings, but I'll ask you as a rusalka... Are there lazy and sluggish rusalkas who neglect their tasks?

Ruslana: I'm not sure how it is on other planets, but on Earth, such cases are practically non-existent. All earthly rusalkas perform their tasks with joy and admirable diligence.

Tobiasz: What else would you add as an introduction?

Ruslana: We are grateful to the Lord for all the tasks we perform. It is our will that humans learn the truth about us and our unique activities. Therefore, we are happy that this book can provide this knowledge to humanity. We believe that based on the knowledge that flows from it, humans will change and take better care of both nature and water itself, which is a gift from the Creator.

Tobiasz: Thank you for this introductory insight!

Ruslana: Thank you!

3.3. An Introduction to Nymphs

After a short break, we decided to speak with a nymph who appeared. With her consent, we gave her the name Neira.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Greetings, Neira! What can you tell us about your species as an introduction?

Neira: Greetings! First of all, I want to note that you've given me a beautiful name. I think I'll use it. We, nymphs, are very similar to rusalkas. We look like their older sisters. Our area of water care involves larger rivers, ponds, and lakes. We have noble tasks within Creation, and we are grateful for our existence.

Bartosz: Since you are larger, do you also care for larger areas than the rusalkas?

Tobiasz: I'm touched by your answer...

Bartosz: Is there one nymph assigned to each lake?

Neira: A nymph of a specific species and size is assigned to a lake of corresponding size. Typically, one nymph tends to an entire lake. However, in very large bodies of water, more nymphs are needed, and their number is regulated by the guardians. Yet, such large lakes are not that common, and the rule "one nymph per lake" is widespread.

Tobiasz: You mentioned that you don't do anything for show... So, humility is common among you nymphs and other nature beings?

Neira: We know that many humans misunderstand humility. We are humble beings, which is mainly characterized by the fact that we do not elevate ourselves above other beings. There is no vanity within us. Although we are humble beings, we have immense joy and a strong desire to serve the Light.

Tobiasz: What you say is beautiful! We humans should follow the example of you nature beings...

Bartosz: Just like with the rusalkas, can you be transferred to a different area of work?

Neira: Yes, but it is relatively rare. It is generally the rule that one nymph is assigned to one lake permanently.

Tobiasz: What else would you like to tell people as an introduction to your species?

Neira: I think time will tell if humans will come closer to nature beings and begin to understand their great role in nature and all of Creation. Our role is very important, and we want humans to recognize and appreciate it. It is the Will of the Light for this to happen!

Tobiasz: Thank you, dear Neira!

Neira: Thank you!

3.4. An Introduction to Mermaids

In the evening of the same day, we began our conversation with a mermaid, whom Bartosz named Sirith for this task.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Greetings, Sirith! We're glad that you will expand our knowledge of mermaids... Please begin!

Sirith: Thank you for the beautiful name. I don't usually use names, but I like yours so much that I think I'll start using it.

After a brief pause.

Sirith: We are beings who ennoble the seas and oceans. We have been refining them practically since their existence began. We have many tasks that we carry out with grateful hearts, and our joy and desire to serve the Light drive us in our work, which always aligns with the Eternal Laws. We love God and His Creation, of which we are a part.

Tobiasz: We are in Silesia, where there is no sea. Where did you come from to meet with us?

Sirith: I am part of a great force that ennobles the waters of the Baltic Sea.

Tobiasz: Are mermaids only female, or do male mermaids also exist?

Sirith: Generally, most mermaids are female forms. However, there are also male mermaids, though they are much fewer in number.

Tobiasz: How many of you are there in our sea?

Sirith: That's a very difficult question. I've never counted. There are many species of us in each sea, and we often work in groups, where we support and encourage each other in our service.

Tobiasz: So, you don't work alone?

Sirith: I have two sisters with whom I care for a specific area. Mermaids have their designated areas of responsibility.

Bartosz: What is it like to be a mermaid?

Sirith: It's a beautiful experience. We have wonderful tasks that express the Will of God. We love experiencing life as mermaids. Our existence is full of joy and even moments of great bliss. We love all the beings in the seas and oceans because they are also part of our aquatic community. Our love drives us to support these other species of beings.

Tobiasz: What is love, according to mermaids?

Sirith: Love is trust, support, and service. Whoever truly loves also respects other beings and offers them what is beneficial to them.

Bartosz: What else would you add as an introduction?

Sirith: We mermaids are beings that provide the main support for the seas and oceans. We want humans to take better care of the cleanliness of these waters and to increase their awareness of us. That's why we are happy that this book is being written. May the Will of God guide people to the Truth.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, dear Sirith!

Sirith: Thank you!

3.5. The Role of Water

After a few days' break, we returned to our discussions. Ruslana appeared.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Greetings, Ruslana! What can you tell us about the role of water in Creation?

Ruslana: It is desired that this be spoken about. Water's role is crucial in building life on every planet. We, nature beings, know that water must be pure for its radiation to be pure as well. Unfortunately, humans have forgotten this, and this is the cause of sadness for many beings that need water to live.

Bartosz: How does the radiation of pure water affect humans?

Ruslana: First of all, water can be purified. Of course, humans can do this through filtering, but also by unconventional methods, such as sending positive thoughts and speaking kind words to the water. If a person does this with love, the water purified in this way will be the fruit of that love. Anyone can conduct an experiment at home by sending positive, loving thoughts to one jar of water and negative thoughts to another. The structure of the water will change, and after such an experiment, everyone will know that love can purify and ennoble water³.

Bartosz: Thank you. Can you say more about the effect of pure water on humans?

Ruslana: As you probably know, humans are made up of a significant percentage of water, so the radiation of pure water has a huge impact on them. Simply sitting near a lake with clean water allows you to feel this energy.

Tobiasz: And bathing in pure water?

Ruslana: Of course, cleansing the body in pure water also affects the spirit and its radiation. Before such a bath, you can set the intention that through this bath, you wish to cleanse not only your gross-material body but also your other fine bodies. If you express this intention sincerely and with love, the cleansing will be much more effective.

Bartosz: Could life on Earth exist without water?

³ This issue was studied by Dr. Masaru Emoto from Japan. For the experiment mentioned by Ruslana, it is also worth using rice.

Ruslana: Water is the giver of life. It is a component of plants, animals, and humans. Without it, there is no life. That's why scientists, who understand this, search for planets with water because they know life might exist there.

Tobiasz: How would you summarize this topic?

Ruslana: Water is the only substance on Earth that exists in all three states of matter. Based on this observation alone, we can see how important it is. Knowing that without water there is no life, we can develop within ourselves an inner respect for water. Although people know this truth, they do not care for the cleanliness of rivers, lakes, seas, and oceans. For them, quick profits are all that matter, but the losses they are incurring because of this are enormous. I know many beings have already told you this, but I want to repeat it: Take care of the Earth, for it is the giver of life. Take care of the water, because without it, life would not exist.

Tobiasz: Thank you for your beautiful message, Ruslana!

3.6. The Appearance of Rusalkas

After a few days' break, we resumed our conversations. Ruslana appeared.

Bartosz: Greetings, Ruslana! We wanted to talk about the appearance of rusalkas. To help with this, I'm giving you a mirror so you can describe your appearance.

Ruslana: Greetings! What a beautiful tool this mirror is. I didn't know of it. We rusalkas have a feminine appearance.

Tobiasz: Hello! What kind of clothing do you wear, and are you semi-transparent?

Ruslana: Only air beings are semi-transparent. Our density as beings is somewhat greater than that of air beings. Depending on the species of rusalka, the appearance also varies. I wear a short skirt down to the knees, in a blue-green color with local dominance of either green or blue. My feet are bare. I also wear a short top, blue in color, that reaches roughly to where humans have a navel.

Bartosz: And what color is your skin?

Ruslana: It is light blue. But it can also change depending on my mood at the time.

Tobiasz: Describe your face to us.

Ruslana: My face is also pale blue, and my eyes are dark blue. My ears, nose, and mouth are like those of an earthly woman. Of course, we can also change the clothing we move around in, but there is generally a rule to cover most of our body.

Bartosz: Where does this rule come from?

Ruslana: It is a directive from the Light, so that we do not tempt young earthly men with our appearance.

Tobiasz: What color are your lips?

Ruslana: My lips are also blue, a pale blue, but a bit darker than the color of my skin.

Bartosz: How would you describe your hair and eyebrows?

Ruslana: Different rusalkas have different colors and lengths of hair. I have very long hair, reaching down to my waist. The color of my hair is dark blue, and my eyebrows are similar to those of a typical earthly woman, in the same color.

Tobiasz: Thank you. Is there anything else you would like to add?

Ruslana: I must say that my appearance is not standard among rusalkas. There are many species, differing in appearance and even in body size. My height is about 1.25 meters, and of course, there are taller rusalkas. The taller a being is, the larger the area they can protect. I hope my appearance gives humanity a rough idea of what we look like.

3.7. The Appearance of Nymphs

Next, we asked Neira about the appearance of nymphs.

Tobiasz: Greetings! Bartosz will now give you a mirror so that you can describe your appearance and how it compares to the appearance of other nymphs.

Neira: I'm touched; this is the first time anyone has given me a mirror. We nymphs are very similar to rusalkas. We look a bit like the older sisters of rusalkas. We also don't wear shoes, and our garments are designed to enhance our appearance.

Bartosz: Do you also wear a similar top and skirt?

Neira: Yes, my body is also pale blue, and my skirt, as well as what you call a top or shirt, are also blue. However, the color of my garments is slightly darker than that of the rusalkas.

Bartosz: How tall are you, approximately?

Neira: I feel like I'm somewhere between 1.60 and 1.65 meters tall. There are taller nymphs than I am, whose radiance covers larger bodies of water.

Bartosz: Do you wear necklaces or bracelets as decorations?

Neira: In my home, which is underwater, I have many treasures. Among them are bracelets and necklaces. But to be honest, I rarely wear them.

Bartosz: Where do you get them from?

Neira: Often, when the Light recognizes that we have completed a task well, we receive small gifts from our guardians.

Tobiasz: Describe your face for us.

Neira: The description would be very similar to what Ruslana presented. However, I've been in this part of matter a bit longer, so my facial features are more mature. But in general, I resemble an older sister of Ruslana.

Tobiasz: And what color are your eyes?

Neira: They are a very dark blue. My eyes are darker than Ruslana's.

Tobiasz: And your hair?

Neira: Here, there's a significant difference. My hair appears black at first glance. However, it is actually a very dark blue. It reaches about to my waist.

Tobiasz: Is there anything you'd like to add in conclusion?

Neira: There are, of course, many species of nymphs, all with different appearances. The mirror you gave me made me even more aware of how much I love my appearance. I'm grateful for the form and the look that the laws of creation have shaped for me.

Tobiasz: Thank you!

3.8. The Appearance of Mermaids

Next, we decided to speak with Sirith about the appearance of mermaids.

Bartosz: Greetings, Sirith! I'm giving you an opportunity to describe your appearance. What can you tell us about your appearance?

Sirith: As most readers probably know, from the waist down, I have the appearance of a fish, while from the waist up, I have the appearance of a woman.

Tobiasz: Describe your skin and the clothing you wear...

Sirith: My fish-like body is covered with scales that shimmer in multiple colors. The dominant color for me is green — a very light green. Each mermaid has a different dominant scale color. You can observe scales that shimmer in blue, green, and even red, although that's less common.

After a short pause.

Sirith: We take care of our tails to ensure they are clean and always shine with pure shades of color. In this way, we show gratitude to the Creator and appreciate the form in which we experience life.

Bartosz: So, what does the upper part of your body look like? What color is it?

Sirith: In my case, it's a pale blue, but I've seen mermaids with bodies in other colors, such as pale green or pink. We also wear short tops that cover part of the body. It is, of course, desired by the Light that we cover ourselves.

Tobiasz: Describe your face and hair.

Sirith: Regarding the body, it is also adorned with strands of seaweed. This is part of our experiential form.

After a brief pause.

Sirith: I have a deep gaze, accentuated by my large blue eyes. They are a dark blue. My hair is slightly shorter than that of the rusalkas, reaching just below my shoulder blades. It is light green. There are many species of mermaids with different types of hair. My form attracts certain fish that I also care for, but we'll discuss that in more detail on another occasion. My face resembles that of earthly women, and I'm usually a smiling being.

Bartosz: And the color of your lips?

Sirith: Dark blue.

Tobiasz: Thank you, dear Sirith! What would you add in conclusion?

Sirith: As far as I know, there are thousands of species of mermaids, so their appearances are usually diverse. Mermaids are famous for their beauty and the nobility of their form. Thank you for allowing me to share what we, mermaids, look like.

3.9. Luring Young Men

Two days later, we decided to talk with Ruslana about the luring of human men by water beings.

Bartosz: Greetings, Ruslana! What can you tell us about the so-called luring and tempting of young men by rusalkas, nymphs, and mermaids? Many legends and stories mention this phenomenon, so we are asking, does it actually happen?

Ruslana: Yes, it does happen, although it's not that common.

Bartosz: What then leads water beings like rusalkas, nymphs, and mermaids to such actions?

Ruslana: The main reason for this phenomenon is the downfall of earthly women. It is their attitude towards men that influences female nature beings to act in this way.

Tobiasz: Do they bear guilt for this?

Ruslana: Just like humans, nature beings are also bound by law. It is indeed the fault of those beings who engage in such behavior.

Tobiasz: Is atonement very painful for them?

Ruslana: First and foremost, such a being must return to the right path and once again serve with purity and love. Sometimes this is not easy, as the so-called luring often becomes a tendency. Nature beings who act this way must understand that they may be removed from their service.

Tobiasz: Is this removal from service the final punishment, or do they have to endure other suffering?

At this moment, a guardian appeared.

Guardian: Greetings! I had to interrupt the connection with Ruslana because your questions are entering into very advanced knowledge. The punishments for such beings are usually strict, but always just. Many beings have a deeply rooted tendency towards luring, which is connected with the vanity of earthly women. We don't want to talk about all the punishments because that is not the topic of this book. Let it be known that even among nature beings, falls occur, sometimes very deep ones. And we, the guardians, must also pay attention to this.

Bartosz: Dear Guardian, is this a common occurrence?

Guardian: Most beings are pure and would never resort to such luring. However, just as among humans, there are also a few black sheep among nature beings. Dear readers, please remember that these are isolated cases, which deviate from the norm.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you would like to add?

Guardian: Yes. I want to say that if any person reading this text in the future encounters such luring, they should rebuke that nature being and treat them harshly with stern words.

Tobiasz: Thank you, Guardian!

3.10. On the Guidance and Leadership of Water Beings

The next day, the Guardian we previously spoke with appeared, and we decided to discuss the topic of quidance.

Bartosz: Greetings! What can you tell us about yourself?

Guardian: I am a guardian of rusalkas. I'm a sector guardian and oversee several rusalkas. We, the sector guardians, ensure that the rusalkas are aware of their tasks and perform them to the best of their ability. From my knowledge, the situation is similar for the sector guardians of nymphs and mermaids.

Bartosz: Besides sector guardians, are there also what we might call species guardians?

Guardian: Yes! Every nature being has two types of guardians. The species guardian ensures that the being develops according to the general expectations of its species. In other words, it ensures that their radiance continually ennobles their surroundings in accordance with the nature of their species.

Tobiasz: I understand there is a hierarchy and pyramid structure among the guardians?

Guardian: Yes, that's correct. Every higher-ranking guardian who oversees those below listens to the will and guidance of those above. The will of the highest guardians is shaped by the Will of God. We see in this the Creator's Design, ensuring everything resonates with His Will. There is great wisdom in the hierarchical and pyramid structure, and any deviation from the norm is quickly noticed and corrected.

Bartosz: You are a guardian of rusalkas... Do you communicate with them often?

Guardian: I communicate with them only when necessary. In general, rusalkas know what to do and carry out their tasks intuitively. If there's a sudden change, I inform them. Rusalkas always listen to me because they know I am an extension of God's Will.

Tobiasz: Are there also female guardians among the water beings' guardian caste?

Guardian: Yes. Female guardians usually care for the younger water beings mentioned in this book. They ensure proper development and guide them toward maturity. Once the beings reach a certain level of maturity, male guardians take over leadership.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you would like to add?

Guardian: I'm glad I could give you a general picture of the guidance over water beings. This overview is sufficient, and nothing more needs to be added. It is always the Will of God that guides us, and that is the most important point I wish to emphasize in my message.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your message!

3.11. The Tasks of Rusalkas

In the afternoon of the same day, we decided to speak with Ruslana about the tasks of rusalkas.

Tobiasz: Greetings, Ruslana! What can you tell us about the tasks of rusalkas?

Ruslana: Greetings! First and foremost, our main task is to cleanse and refresh the waters. We achieve this through our specific radiance, which is tailored to the particular river.

Bartosz: Do you also have any influence on the fish in the river?

Ruslana: We can support the fish that see us. We understand their needs and can help fulfill them, for example, by pointing them to food sources. However, fish also have their own guardians, whose will we must respect. Generally, we can cooperate with them.

Bartosz: Do you have any other tasks besides this?

Ruslana: We also have an influence on the strength of the river's current. We can regulate it through our actions, although when great floods occur, we are no longer able to make adjustments.

Bartosz: Can you explain how you do that?

Ruslana: It's simple. Our movement affects it. For example, when we swim against the current, we connect with the flow and weaken it, but such actions are rare, and we don't perform them often.

Bartosz: Do the guardians assign you any special tasks?

Ruslana: Yes, sometimes they inform us where we need to go to refresh and cleanse specific areas. I always gladly listen to my guardians, who have a broader view and point out the places where we are needed.

Tobiasz: Do you have time for rest and sleep?

Ruslana: Yes. Each of us has our own resting place. It's usually underwater, but we can also rest on the shore.

Bartosz: Do you sleep?

Ruslana: In winter, we have more time for sleep and rest, but in summer, we sometimes sleep as well. Nature beings also rest and regenerate through sleep.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to add?

Ruslana: We rusalkas are designed and shaped by Creation in such a way that our radiance ennobles the rivers. Our mere presence is a blessing for the rivers, and we are happy to participate in the ennoblement of nature and all of Creation.

Tobiasz: Thank you!

3.12. The Tasks of Nymphs

We immediately moved on to discussing the tasks of nymphs.

Tobiasz: Greetings, Neira! What can you tell us about the tasks of nymphs?

Neira: Since we are called the older sisters of rusalkas, our tasks cannot be much different. Through our radiance, we ennoble larger rivers and lakes. Because we are larger, we have a broader area of influence, and our radiance covers greater spaces. As Ruslana said, we cleanse and refresh the water we radiate over.

Bartosz: Do you also assist the fish?

Neira: I personally leave that to their guardians. There are many species of fish, and they have many guardians. This is knowledge you don't yet possess, but I can expand it a bit.

Tobiasz: Please, do!

Neira: The guardians, both male and female, take care of the fish to ensure they always move within safe sectors. They communicate with the fish through a distinct sound or song. The fish understand this perfectly and react almost instantly. I think this is enough to give you a general idea.

Bartosz: Do you nymphs also live inside the river or lake?

Neira: Yes, we have our dwelling where we rest, deep on the bottom. I personally keep my treasures there, which I received from my guardians. And like rusalkas, we also sleep, mostly during the winter.

Bartosz: Do you have a small hut underwater?

Neira: Yes, that word fits well for our small homes. My hut was once shaped by animistic helpers who are experts in their craft.

Tobiasz: Do you have any other tasks?

Neira: For example, during a storm, we can increase the strength of the waves. In fact, a storm is a wonderful phenomenon in which all of nature is refreshed and cleansed. I love dancing to the rhythm of the storm, either deep in the lake or on the surface.

Bartosz: Do humans often hinder your work?

Neira: Unfortunately, humans pollute rivers, ponds, and lakes, which makes our tasks more difficult. People don't appreciate nature, though it was here before them and prepared the entire planet for them. Sadly, through their willfulness, humans trample on nature and pollute it.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you'd like to add?

Neira: Besides us, there are many other supportive beings in the waters, such as the aforementioned fish guardians. We nymphs take care of our small kingdoms to ensure they are always pure and accessible to both humans and animals. We are content and happy to be part of nature.

Tobiasz: Thank you!

3.13. The Tasks of Mermaids

Next, we moved on to discussing the mermaids.

Tobiasz: Greetings, Sirith! What can you tell us about the tasks of mermaids?

Sirith: Greetings! The main task of mermaids is to ennoble the seas and oceans. Just as rusalkas and nymphs cleanse and refresh rivers and lakes with their radiance, we, though locally, also cleanse areas within the seas and oceans through our radiance.

Bartosz: The ocean is quite large. I assume it would take many mermaids to purify it. I understand that you work locally under the direction of your guardians?

Sirith: Each mermaid or group of mermaids has their own sector, and together as a group, we maintain harmony in that sector. So, if a guardian points out a specific place that needs to be

cleansed, we immediately swim there. However, another of our main tasks, and perhaps even more important, is caring for the fish.

Bartosz: Do you communicate with them through your singing?

Sirith: Yes. The fish understand our singing and always move to the safe areas we direct them to with our song. There are many species of mermaids, each responsible for the care of specific fish species.

Tobiasz: Is your singing solely for the purpose you mentioned?

Sirith: We also communicate with each other through song. The singing itself has a calming, almost therapeutic effect on all living beings in the seas and oceans. It also purifies and has healing properties.

Tobiasz: Do you also use your singing to praise the Creator?

Sirith: Of course. Through our singing, we often express gratitude for the gift of life and for who we are. We are happy when we can serve our Lord.

Bartosz: Can humans hear your singing?

Sirith: Those who have opened their inner hearing well enough can hear it. Our singing, initiated deep within the seas and oceans, also reaches the surface. If someone with that gift expresses a pure intention, they will be able to hear us.

Tobiasz: In what language do you sing?

Sirith: We sing our songs in the universal language of mermaids. This language is understood by fish and most of the inhabitants of the seas and oceans. Whoever hears our singing once will remember it for the rest of their life.

Bartosz: Dear Sirith, thank you for your message. Is there anything else you'd like to add in conclusion?

Sirith: Each mermaid carries out her duties with love, as assigned by the Light. We are incredibly happy to serve the Light through our tasks. The satisfaction and fulfillment that follow each completed task motivate us to continue our joyful service. Thank you for letting me share something about us.

3.14. The Abilities of Water Beings

Two days later, we decided to speak with Ruslana's Guardian about the abilities of water beings.

Bartosz: Greetings! I understand that water beings have similar or the same abilities as other nature beings?

Guardian: There is one ability that is characteristic of water beings. Water beings, through their underwater dance, which involves movements unique to each species, can increase the strength of their radiance. In this way, they contribute to the more perfect ennoblement of the sector in which they operate. Each species has different movements, which I refer to as a dance. During such a dance, they experience deeper inner focus, which is what causes the increase in the strength of their radiance.

Bartosz: Can older beings, for example, also use abilities like relocation, voice alteration, or temporary shape-shifting?

Guardian: Yes. These are universal abilities of nature beings, though water beings rarely use them. There's also one ability you've spoken little about, which should be mentioned. Nature beings who are sufficiently mature can communicate with other beings, including humans, through images and visions. Often, such a vision or image conveys the essence of a subject more clearly and fosters a better understanding of the topic.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you would like to add?

Guardian: I think the topic is covered. However, it's worth mentioning the mermaids' singing that you've discussed. This singing is exceptionally beautiful, and any being who hears it can feel the closeness of nature and the Light itself.

Tobiasz: Thank you for this brief message!

Guardian: Thank you for inviting me to this conversation. I am honored to have contributed to expanding knowledge about water beings.

3.15. Interaction with Other Nature Beings and Humans

Some time later, Ruslana and her Guardian appeared.

Bartosz: Welcome! We wanted to ask you about the interactions between water beings and other nature beings, as well as between them and humans.

Guardian: When it comes to interactions with humans, they are at a very low level, as very few people acknowledge that such beings exist. However, it does happen, and I'd like Ruslana to speak about it here.

Ruslana: I've been on Earth for a very long time, and interactions with humans have been extremely rare in my experience. I have a habit, which is quite common among water beings. On the heads of people who know us and see us, I place wreaths woven by me. It's my way of honoring those who are pure and appreciate the beauty of nature and its laws. I'd like to give you these wreaths now. Please accept them from me.

Ruslana placed wreaths around our necks.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, Ruslana!

Guardian: As for interactions between water beings and other nature beings, of course, these happen. They are usually driven by the need to carry out joint tasks. For example, earth gnomes beneath a river may also have an influence on the fauna and flora of that river. Perhaps Ruslana can elaborate.

Bartosz: Ruslana, do you have friends among other nature beings?

Ruslana: I once had a close connection with a certain gnome, but I'm not sure I'd call it friendship. Among nature beings, I'm currently friends with two rusalkas who work in my area.

Guardian: I think intraspecies friendships are more common among nature beings. This is because such beings understand each other better and share common goals. As a guardian of rusalkas, I also

have friendships among other guardians. Just as with me, it's easier for nature beings to become friends with those whose work they fully understand because it's similar to their own.

Tobiasz: Do you have any free time, and do you spend it together?

Guardian: We don't have fixed schedules. I generally focus on tasks that arise from the needs of the moment. I do have free time, which I either spend alone or talking with my friends, the other guardians. But I'm always alert and ready.

Ruslana: I like to rest in my little hut during my free moments. I usually feel more connected with the Creator during such times.

Tobiasz: Would you like to add anything else?

Guardian: Just like humans, nature beings and their guardians have time to fulfill their duties as well as time for rest. We know well what friendship is, and we also form such friendships. We appreciate humans who seek to connect with us and build friendships. We believe that such relationships will become more common on this planet.

Ruslana: I would just add that what the guardian said about friendships between humans and nature beings is very dear to our Creator. Let's draw closer to each other and serve the Light together, as this is desired.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

3.16. Disasters Related to the Element of Water

We decided to continue our conversation with the Guardian by asking about disasters related to the element of water.

Tobiasz: Welcome back! What can you tell us about natural disasters like floods, tsunamis, etc.?

Guardian: I think I can speak more broadly about floods, though I'm not a major expert on disasters. Floods are, of course, seen by humans as unwanted catastrophes, but they also bring benefits to nature. For example, the Egyptians appreciated the annual flooding of the Nile because they were grateful for the benefits these floods brought to their soil.

After a moment of silence.

Guardian: From my conversation with Bartosz, I know that heavy rains and the associated floods in Bangladesh allow the people there to harvest crops three times a year. However, I can say more about the destructive power of floods.

After a short pause.

Guardian: The fact that someone suffers due to this element is not accidental. Like everything in nature, the effects of floods are also rooted in law.

Tobiasz: People don't have this knowledge and often reject it... What would you say to those who seek the truth on this matter?

Guardian: Both floods and large tsunamis, which can bring death, are formed by beings anchored in the Will of God. Nature beings are not allowed to act otherwise, and often they wouldn't even be able to. Therefore, one must understand that nature brings people fair consequences. However, if

humans were more aware of the existence of nature beings, they could be warned more often. Unfortunately, the error of ignorance in this matter can sometimes cost earthly lives.

Bartosz: Is there anything you would like to add?

Guardian: The element of water brings life, but it can also bring destruction. Humans living on this planet should respect this element more and approach it with reverence. Humanity can no longer feel like the master of nature because they are not. Nature is made available to humans to provide benefits, and according to the Law of Balance, humans should reciprocate. People of Earth, use and accept the gifts of nature, such as water, remembering that you should — and must — give back by maintaining the cleanliness and harmony of your waters.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your insights!

3.17. The Governors of the Seas

The next day, we decided to ask Ruslana's Guardian about the so-called governors of the seas.

Bartosz: Greetings, guardian! You mentioned you were prepared to share knowledge about the governors of the seas. We're listening!

Guardian: Every sea has its leader, a king. It is desired to call them governors. All kings have their partners, and together they rule over the seas. The power is divided between the male and female, between the governor and his wife. There are many female beings in the seas, and they are led by the woman.

Tobiasz: You're talking about the seas, but what about rivers, lakes, and oceans?

4. Epilogue

In conclusion, we would like to draw attention to one important aspect that applies to all nature beings, not just those discussed in this book. When interacting with beings, it is essential to continuously consider their level of maturity. This is extremely important because the knowledge presented in our books is already quite advanced, particularly when it comes to the abilities a given being may awaken (such as relocation or the ability to change body size).

It is crucial not to provide young beings with information about abilities that they might only awaken far in the future. These beings are simply not ready to develop certain abilities yet, and they might desire to do so prematurely. They are unaware of these skills, and it is not beneficial for them to possess such knowledge at this stage. Topics such as potential abilities should be avoided because it is not always possible to rely on a guardian to intervene and inform us of this limitation.

We mention this because we ourselves made many mistakes in this regard, especially in the beginning. This is a very important issue. Remember that the level of maturity should shape the nature of the contact and conversation. Young beings will gladly speak on other topics, and their current level of maturity in no way diminishes their worth.
