Beings of the forest, flowers, guardians of animals and giants

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1. Introduction

1.1 Tobias' introduction

After writing the books: "Trees Speak", "Essentials Speak Part 1" and Essentials Speak Part 2" it is time for the final book, Essentials Speak Part 3. This part focuses on the beings of the forest, the beings of the flowers, the guardians of the animals and also the giants. All the beings were very friendly and open to talking to us. This book can expand our cognition immeasurably.

As humans, we are often in the forest on walks, and we all come into frequent contact with flowers too, but few people are aware of the many creatures that serve in the forests and flowers. Few of us have also heard of the fact that every animal has, by the will of the Creator, a dedicated guardian. This is what this book is all about. In addition, we also had the pleasure of talking to giants, which is extremely rare for humans.

This book is our final part of the series, and I am extremely grateful to God for being able to participate in this journey, a journey in which we learn a lot about God's servants that humanity as a whole has forgotten. These servants of God always emphasise that all their valiant work is always based on and at the command of God's will. They are immersed in this will and we humans should take example from them and also try to live based on it! Great reading!

1.2 Bartholomew's introduction

With this book, we are concluding the project that Tobias and I started in September/October 2023 by writing the book 'Trees speak'. During this time we have enriched our knowledge enormously. Every reader who reads our books also has the opportunity to learn more about the creatures of nature, their beautiful service and how they work. Together with Tobias, we regard the cognition coming out of these books as a great gift of Light to humanity.

In this section we focused on the beings of the forest, the beings of the flowers, the guardians of the animals and the giants. Contact with the beings who speak in the pages of our book was an extraordinary experience for us. All the beings gave us information about what their service to the Light is about with remarkable kindness and openness.

This short book introduces us at the beginning to the forest, where the forest guardian has a dominant role, then we gain knowledge about the flowers and about the guardian who takes care of the flowers as well as the flower creatures with great love. Then we learn about the guardians of the animals, and finally we gain cognition about the giants. I hope this book will bring something good into your life my dear reader. Enjoy your reading.

2. Creatures of the forest

2.1 Preliminary information

We have made a connection with a being we have known for seven years. It is the guardian of the forest, to which we often go.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello forest guardian! It has been a long time since our first regular contacts. We are happy to be able to talk to you again.

Keeper of the Forest: Welcome! It was not the will of the Light that we communicate at this time. You had other subjects to deal with. Now I return and am ready to give you knowledge of the forest and the beings that operate there.

Bartosz: Can you tell us what kind of beings we can talk to you about?

Keeper of the forest: First of all, the forest is subject to certain rhythms that regulate the seasons. Even children know that nature sleeps in winter and is reborn in spring. These rhythms are accompanied by specific species of natural creatures. I will try to present the most important of these and their tasks, which I will talk about more generally. I will also speak on subjects when I feel it is wanted to speak on them. The cognition to come out of my messages is to be the base which will be filled in by more detailed explanations later.

Tobias: Thank you for these words of introduction and we look forward to our future conversations!

2.2 The forest caretaker about himself

Bartosz: Can you tell us more about yourself? What do you do for a living?

Keeper of the forest: I am the caretaker of the forest that you go to. I have quite a large area under me, which includes a lot of natural beings. My role is managerial and caring. I make sure that all the processes in my area are running properly. I support the beings of nature as well as their guardians in their tasks. Personally, I also have a higher caretaker who has a broader insight and directs me to carry out certain activities. He also makes me aware of all sorts of deficiencies that need to be remedied on an ongoing basis. The forest is alive and many things need to be learnt in order to look after it effectively.

After a while.

Forest Guardian: Be vigilant and act on an ongoing basis for the benefit of the plants, trees and creatures concerned.

Bartosz: Could you describe more or less what you look like?

Keeper of the forest: By virtue of being a being in the forest, I have to look after the entire forest area. Therefore, I am a tall being. My height is about 3.0 m, but I can also increase it when, for

example, I want to check what fits higher up in the treetops. However, my fixed height where I usually manifest is around 3.0 m.

Tobias: Do you have clothes?

Keeper of the forest: I have clothes that are in the colours of the forest, so the dominant colour is green. My skin is also green. I wouldn't want to say more, because there are a lot of caretakers who look a bit different from me. I think you would have to see me to describe it in human words more precisely.

Tobias: What are your responsibilities?

Keeper of the forest: When I notice on my own or through my guidance certain deficiencies, or that the processes of the forest are taking place out of harmony, then I make specific beings aware of this and commission specific actions. However, to talk about this more extensively would require very detailed knowledge, so I talk about it in more general terms.

Bartosz: Are you a creature of nature?

Keeper of the forest: I know Bartosz that you make a distinction between beings of nature and caretakers. I feel I am a being of nature completely connected to the forest. I do not belong to the caste of caretakers that you have talked about in previous books. I operate more locally and in close connection with the beings of nature that can be found in the forest. Just as the woodsman is the inner guardian of the tree, I am the guardian of the whole forest.

Tobias: What else would you say by way of introduction about yourself?

Keeper of the forest: I think our contact can be very fruitful for a better understanding of the forest. There are many things that you already know or guess, but there are also new things that I want to talk about as well. I think that the cognition coming out of my messages will be skeletal and general. Later, I believe that more people will come after you to fill it in and enrich it with more details.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

2.3 Trees

We joined up with Old Beech to complete the knowledge we covered in our first book¹.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello my friend!

Old Beech: Hello! It's been a long time since we spoke. I see what extensive knowledge, you both already possess. I respect you a lot, because you do a lot for the world, and the knowledge you already possess is unique, even among the creatures of nature.

Bartholomew: I have a question for you: based on our discussions, we came to the conclusion that every creature of nature has a sectoral and species guardian... Is this also the case among spars?

Old Beech: I have one guardian that I talk to, but I understand that other beings of nature need dual guidance. My guardian, who you called a 'higher guardian', makes sure I develop properly. We are not influenced like, for example, gnomes by the movements of the earth and we don't need strictly double guidance.

Bartosz: I also need to clarify and clarify something... As readers may remember, I have referred to your guardians as 'higher guardians'. This term itself is a bit misleading, even inappropriate. It stems from an incident we had at the beginning of writing the book in a conversation with the birch trees. The guardian who approached us and blocked the connection was called a 'higher guardian'. At the time I had a vague idea of the hierarchical and pyramidal structure of caregivers. In fact, it was a higher guardian who came down from higher levels and gave us information. It was not a local guardian, but one standing a little higher in the hierarchy. I thought after this incident that calling caregivers 'higher caregivers' was appropriate, however today I know that they should simply be called 'caregivers'. Most of the conversations in our book have just been with local carers and they should simply be called 'carers'.

Old Beech: Bartosz you are very precise and I like that very much.

Bartholomew: Old Beech we were talking about the tree of life which is in the circle of essence and you called the spar within it your leader. However, I feel that your leaders are other beings.

Old Beech: On the basis of my surprise and emotion at this question, I called the spar of the tree of life our leader. I am Bartosh the oldest spar you have spoken to, however my knowledge compared to what you want to share is also incomplete. I think that when it comes to tasks, the essence of the tree of life is not the natural superior of all spars. However, he is to be given full respect and I think calling him a representative leader would be most appropriate.

After a while.

Old Beech: However, as you have managed to notice, our natural leader is another being. Here on earth we have our own leader, which not all spars know about. I too have a vague idea of him, but I know that such a being exists. He is the planetary leader and reports to his counterpart in the vital circle.

Tobias: From you we have received the form 'spars', but we have also encountered the names 'tree elves', 'driads', 'tree spirits'. How would you comment on these other verbal forms?

Old Beech: I am convinced that the form "driads" refers to us. "Tree elves" I less feel is appropriate, however I feel it is acceptable to call us that. Humanity, on the other hand, should dispense with the form "tree spirits", as we are not tree incarnate beings, and more precisely we have a very strong connection to them. Spirits are earthly people and only the core should be referred to as such. I like the form "tree spirits" very much and from my point of view, I want to be called that, however, I cannot speak for all representatives of my species.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you friend for this complement. We think we have the subject of spars closed....

Old Beech: I am glad to have been able to clarify some points. I see the knowledge you have and you really already know a lot about many species. I wish the world to embrace your books and use them as a basis for further research and even more knowledge. May God's love support these processes and guide those who will be able, like you, to get closer to the creatures of nature. I believe that in the new world that is coming, people, together with the beings of nature, will live in respect and in symbiosis.

2.4 Forest elves

In the next conversation, we decided to talk to the caretaker about forest elves.

Tobias: Hello guardian! Tell us something about the forest elves.

Keeper of the Forest: Welcome! First and foremost, forest elves need to be separated from the beings you call spars. Although elves are born into trees, their role is somewhat different from the woodsmen. Sparlings are the internal care of the trees, whereas forest elves also care for the trees, however, their activity is external.

Tobias: In our first book, one of the spars told us that forest elves already perform their tasks through their specific radiation... What would you say about this and what would you add in this regard?

Forest Guardian: Yes, their radiation has a very good effect on trees. They can combine in many ways with the radiation of the tree, as well as with the tree itself, and strengthen and even heal it.

Tobias: Can you list those ways you are talking about?

Keeper of the forest: Elves usually do not have guidelines on what to do and their actions are usually intuitive. E.g. their dancing next to some tree causes their radiance to increase and connect with the tree in question. In this beautiful way they can serve the forests and the trees. There are other ways too, and there is one I would like to mention. The forest elves of the forest you are visiting have seen you hugging trees and have started practising this themselves. They didn't do it before and you could say that elves can also learn from humans.

Bartholomew: I've heard of this before and thank you for mentioning it....

Tobias: I am very positively surprised and touched....

Bartholomew: Can you say something about the species of elves, as they are probably different?

Keeper of the forest: There are, of course, very many species of elves. They differ mainly in their height. These elves, which you happen to know from my forest, are relatively small and are very friendly to humans. They are very open to contact, so I am not surprised that one of them contacted you once Bartosz. I would like you to mention something about it and share it here as well....

Tobias: Please Bartholomew!

Bartosz: It's a bit private and so strictly mine, but I can say something about it. I first made contact with a forest elf in 2017. While in the forest, I was surprised because I noticed someone standing

behind me. This elf also noticed that I could see and feel him and started bringing me some gifts of the forest, if I remember correctly. Among other things, the elf sang me a certain song and you could say we became friends. I remember that he even came out of the forest and was a guest in my house. I remember his words about the rooms of my house. He stated: "How little space there is".

After a moment, Bartosz continued:

Bartosz: One day he was at my house in the evening and asked: "Can I sleep in the bed with you?" I don't remember anymore if he slept, I perceived him rather intuitively, because I didn't have open clairvoyance. Suddenly one evening the keeper of the forest appeared in my room and said: "The place of the elf is in the forest". At that moment about five or six elves, whose presence I was unaware of, jumped out from under my bed. As it turned out, the elves were curious about my relationship with their colleague and were secretly following us. The keeper of the forest lovingly took the elves with him and led them into the forest. I did not feel any resentment on his part but only the love he bestowed on all the elves. I must also mention that that guardian was your predecessor. After some time he went to serve on higher levels and you were assigned to look after our forest. And that is how we met dear guardian!

Keeper of the Forest: I think you could also mention what caused my predecessor's promotion at some point.

Bartosz: I will consider this and maybe later in the book I will mention it, however today's topic is different.

Tobias: Would you add anything else tentatively about the forest elves?

Keeper of the Forest: It is desired that the elves present you with their songs and that you include them in this book. I would also like to add that I have a special affection and love for the elves. Their childlike and intuitive service is a great inspiration to me and I am very happy to nurture and support them on their journey. The elves are some of my favourite charges. Of course, I also look after other species of creatures in my care of the forest, which I will mention later, but the elves you already know are my favourites.

Bartosz: Finally, I wanted to add something else... After 2017, my contact with beings dimmed a bit. As it was communicated to me at the time, it was beneficial for my development to close the connection. I was to be mindful of other topics important for my development. However, the elves and other beings of the forest were never forgotten and I often mentioned them in my poems. I took the opportunity to present one here:

Friend the elf

*I remember the forest paths well
on which I wanted to walk with you
you were an elf I was a human
and yet you have become my brother*

*and I have seen you often
pointed ears long hair*

*we had a common language in the forest
the pulse of nature still pulsed in you*

*you took care of the trees like an angel
your tasks so graceful
and diseased trees with some kind of wound
you cuddled with your heart how beautifully*

*and when I don't see you now
I miss you little baby
only sometimes will I hear you
between thinking and wondering*

*I remember well when paired
I walked with you in the forest
I know one day I will see you again
you be an elf I be a human*

2.5 Songs of the forest elves

The same day later, the keeper of the forest appeared with the aforementioned elf.

Bartholomew: Welcome my friend! Good to hear from you!

Elf: Welcome! I am sure you will like my songs....

Tobias: Well yes, we were going to ask you to sing songs... You can start!

Elf:

*I give what is good, I give
I give what is right, I give it
I give what is wise, I give it
I give what I usually give*

Tobias: Thank you, I think we know this beautiful simple song... Do you want to sing something else?

Elf:

*The Lord is everything to me that is a fact
man is like a brother in creation
I love him though he falls so
I know that again, the world will be beautiful*

Bartosz: Beautiful! I have a question: did you improvise?

Elf: Yes, this song came automatically and I am proud that you appreciate me. Is there anything else I can sing?

Bartosz: Of course!

Elf:

*the world is like a rose, like a flower
sometimes emerges like a cancer
and despite the passage of so many years
I love him quietly, just like that*

Very: Beautiful! Do you often sing intuitive songs?

Elf: Yes, the same thing comes when I dance, for example.

Tobias: Do you play any instruments?

Elf: I don't play, although my fellow elves play the pipes....

The keeper of the forest interjected.

Keeper of the forest: I think that is enough. Our friend has shared the beauty that emanates from it. If you want, I can now describe to you what the elves you know look like.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you guardian for bringing us an elf, and to you elves for the beautiful songs!

Elf: I am pleased. Thank you!

2.6 The appearance of forest elves

We continued our conversation.

Bartholomew: Keep going!

Keeper of the forest: There are many species of elves, which differ mainly in height. They also have different clothes and their specific characters. There are also elves that are less friendly to humans, but the ones you know love humans.

Tobias: Do these less human-friendly elves think badly of humans?

Keeper of the forest: They see people's faults and therefore trust them less... But personally, I think that if people change and are more friendly to nature, they will also get closer to them.

Tobias: Well guardian, let's get back to the appearance of the forest elves.

Keeper of the forest: First of all, elves have long pointed ears and this is characteristic of their species. Their skin is pale.

The elf who received the mirror interjected.

Elf: My skin colour is pale pink. I have blue eyes that are very large. My clothes are green, decorated with leaves. I have these pointed shoes, a little rounded at the end, dark red in colour.

Tobias: And the nose and the hair?

Elf: My nose is similar to a human's, but a little more wiry. My hair is black, quite long below my shoulders. But there are also elves who have shorter hair and in other colours too. My face is very youthful and happy. I feel that I am part of the forest and my appearance embodies that.

Bartosz: Is this your permanent look or can you change it?

Elf: I could change it, however I am so used to it that I never change it.

Keeper of the forest: Of course, there are many species of elves that differ in appearance, but their trademark is their long pointed ears. This is what our little friend looks like, and let this be an illustrative image only.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you! It was very nice to be able to spend this time with you!

Keeper of the Forest: In that case, until our next conversation!

2.7 Forest care and the seasons

Two days later, we spoke to the forest supervisor again.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello carer! Today we wanted to talk about the different types of care depending on the season.

Keeper of the Forest: Hello! Each season in the forest requires a different type of care and therefore there are many caretakers who are only active at a particular time and season.

Bartosz: I understand that spring is a period of growth... Can you say more about that?

Forest guardian: Yes, growth guardians are most active at this time of year. They are the ones who make sure that growth takes place properly after the winter break and after the winter rest. They are very active during this time and their role is invaluable. They have their ways of accelerating the growth of trees and plants. However, this is not wanted to be discussed here. The forest also has some secrets that we do not want to reveal.

Bartosz: What happens in the summer then?

Forest guardian: There are many guardians that are active in summer, for example there are of course leaf guardians and, for example, root gnats that are also active at this time of year. But here I

wanted to draw attention to the seed guardians, whose start of development is in summer. This is also the time of year when, if we are dealing with orchards or fruit trees, the guardians of the respective fruits start their activity, who ensure that the individual fruits ripen properly.

Bartosz: And what does the root gnome you mentioned do?

Keeper of the forest: Root gnomes are a species of soil gnomes that look after the roots of trees. There are, of course, many subspecies of them. They take care of the proper development of the roots and can be said to accelerate their growth. They also support all processes in the roots, such as the extraction of water from the soil to the higher parts of the tree.

Tobias: And in the autumn?

Keeper of the forest: In autumn, the forest is slowly put to sleep. The deciduous trees give up their leaves. These processes are of course also supported by specific caretakers. E.g. leaf fall is supported by the caretakers by detaching the leaves. Here, of course, the wind helps a lot, but there are creatures that support this process.

Tobias: What happens in winter then?

Keeper of the forest: In winter, the whole forest sleeps and creatures such as elves, sparrows or individual guardians also sleep or simply rest. All these creatures have earned this rest and it is willed by the Light so that in this way they can prepare for the next season.

Tobias: Are all these beings subject to you?

Forest guardian: Yes, everything that happens in the forest happens under my care. However, if I were their caretaker alone, I wouldn't be able to see to everything, which is why the individual smaller caretakers I mentioned also have their sector caretakers, who point out to them where and how they should act.

Bartosz: Is there anything you would add?

Keeper of the forest: Based on the insights I have presented today, you can imagine how many beings are subject to me, how many beings take care of the forest. I am grateful to God that He has taken care of all the forests in this way, that every tree and every being can feel that they are taken care of.

2.8 Law of Growth

Bartholomew: I wanted to ask you today about the growth that is so vehemently aroused in the spring... Can you say more about that?

Forest guardian: Yes. Proper growth is supervised by growth guardians. Their actions are regulated by the law of growth.

Bartosz: The law of growth?

Keeper of the forest: The law of growth is dependent on the area and the species of the tree, for example. On the basis of this regulation, the beings carry out care so that the growth is in accordance with these regulations. The beings can fuel the growth, i.e. drive it, and when the growth is close to the seasonal maximum, they have the right and even have to suppress it. The law of growth for a given area and for a given species is regulated by the higher guardians, who often act in consultation with their counterparts of neighbouring areas. They listen to the will of even higher guardians, who act under the influence of God's will. Based on this brief insight, the reader can conclude that the growth of plants, trees or shrubs is also a process willed and regulated by the Light.

Tobias: Is there anything else you want to tell us about this?

Keeper of the forest: The reader should realise that the Lord God cares for the forests. He cares through specific beings and specific guardians. The processes in the forest are not arbitrary, but work under the influence of God's will. Nothing in nature is left to itself, and everything is driven and regulated by the will of our Creator.

2.9 Impact of the forest on humans and conclusion

In the following conversation we decided to summarise everything we had been told about the forest.

Tobias: Hello guardian! Today we want to culminate our messages about the forest....

Keeper of the Forest: Welcome! What I have passed on to you in these few talks is actually a base for future generations and for future seekers of truth, truth that concerns the forest and the natural beings that support it.

Tobias: I think it is also worth saying something at the end about the beneficial effects of the forest on humans....

Keeper of the forest: The forest has a very good effect on all the creatures that inhabit it. The forest calms and soothes the nerves of modern man, who is often under stress. There are also many benefits of a walk in the forest, but I don't want to talk about all of them as, as far as I know, there are already numerous publications on the subject. I would also like to mention that the forest has a very good effect on our health, and I would like to end here.

Bartosz: I think we are coming to the conclusion of our discussions. What would you like to say at the end?

Keeper of the Forest: As I said earlier your transmissions that you have written down are the basis for further more detailed descriptions in the future. I also wanted to point out that the Light gives such knowledge to people as they are ready for. There are also many secrets of the forest, which I did not want to talk about here, but which you also know and let this be a reward for you Bartosz and Tobias for your work. I believe that someday the time will come that the Light will allow you to reveal those secrets of the forest that you have not written about here.

Tobias: Guardian, is there anything else you would like to add?

Keeper of the forest: This is my last transmission and I am deeply convinced that I have fulfilled the task and given people the knowledge about the forest that was willed by the Light. I am glad that God's will has allowed this and I am happy for every person who, thanks to these transmissions, will understand nature and the processes within it at least a little. May the Light guide you people to pure contact with nature, and to friendship with us, the creatures of nature. Thank you!

Bartholomew and Tobias: Thank you, guardian of the forest! Be blessed!

3. The essence of flowers

3.1 Preliminary information

We got in touch with a floral caregiver who serves near our home.

Bartholomew: Welcome! Who are you? Tell us something about yourself...

Keeper of the flowers: Hello! I am the caretaker of flowers. My sector in which I look after flowers and flower beings is the sector which also includes your house.

Tobias: Do you only look after flower creatures outside? Or do you also look after the flowers in the houses?

Flower carer: Thank you Tobias for your question! I look after the uncut flowers, but also the cut flowers. And I anticipate your next question... There can also be flower beings in the cut flowers and I also take care of them. This also includes the flowers in your home.

Bartosz: What are we going to talk about in the pages of this book?

Keeper of the flowers: I will speak about what is wanted by the Light. To begin with, I will tell you a little about myself and then also about the beings of flowers. I also have a special message for humanity relating to the cutting of flowers. This message for me personally is the most important and I will present it at the end.

Tobias: Thank you and we look forward to talking to you!

3.2 The Flower Keeper about herself

We continued the conversation with the flower guardian.

Bartosz: We would like you to tell us something about yourself... How long have you been serving here? How big an area does your district cover?

Flower Keeper: Many years ago, before you were born, I was assigned to this sector where I serve. Before that, there was another inflorescence caretaker who went to serve elsewhere, but I don't know the details. The area I look after includes several houses and plots adjacent to yours.

Tobias: What does your service look like?

Flower Maid: I usually take care of all flower beings and flowers and make sure that the development, i.e. the blossoming of the flowers and the ripening of the beings goes well. My presence makes the flower maidens and flower fairies feel cared for and safe. I often tell them what is appropriate at the time and beneficial for further development. Thousands of examples could be multiplied, however, I think it is out of place to present them here.

Bartosz: Do you have your superiors or do you act intuitively?

Flower guardian: I usually act intuitively and according to the moment. But of course, I also have my supervisors, in fact one supervisor, who not only helps me serve and gives me guidance on how to support the beings and flowers, but also cares about my individual development, because I am also developing.

Bartholomew: Do you identify yourself more as a creature of nature or perhaps a protector of creatures of nature?

Keeper of flowers: I am a keeper of nature's creatures, but I feel so connected to nature that I think referring to me as a creature of nature is also appropriate.

Bartosz: Is it true that you are sometimes called princesses?

Flower Carer: Because of our appearance, we have often been called this, however I prefer the term flower carer, as it reflects more the nature of what I do.

Bartosz: Can you describe your appearance to us?

Flower Keeper: I am the size of an adult. I have a long blue dress, with floral patterns.

Tobias: Do you have footwear?

Flower Keeper: I could use it, but I personally don't.

Tobias: What is your skin colour?

Flower Keeper: Similar to the Caucasian man, except that it is more pink.

Bartosz: And the face and hair?

Flower Keeper: My face resembles a smiling earthy woman of 25, 30 years of age. My smile accompanies me practically all the time. My hair is blonde in colour, long below my shoulders. On my head I have this small crown, which adds to my nobility and grace. As for my clothes, I also have a veil which, like my dress, is decorated with floral patterns. The veil reaches down to my waist. The ancient peoples knew us and often called us princesses because of our crowns. I think that is enough. I want to point out that we may look slightly different in different regions of the world, but you wanted to know my look, so I shared.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you want to add about yourself at the end?

Flower Keeper: I am very happy to have been assigned by fate to a sector to which your house also belongs. I feel that my transmissions may be something new for many, however, I feel that it is high time to expand this knowledge that people already have. I would also like to add that my service here, also in your sector, is a great pleasure for me and I am very happy to be able to take care of both the flowers and their creatures. I thank God for such a noble task and wish to continue to serve Him to the best of my ability.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your beautiful words and we look forward to continuing to serve together.

Keeper of the flowers: thank you. Think with joy of the flowers and their beings.

3.3 Flower fairies

After a few days, we continued our conversations.

Bartholomew: Hello, today we wanted to talk about flower fairies, they are more famous in the world....

Keeper of the flowers: Welcome! There are many species of flower fairies. Each flower has its own specific species. They are incredibly beautiful, and the familiarity with them has continued to this day. Even in this day and age, where man is generally distant from the Light, some people recognise these magnificent beings.

Bartosz: Are flower fairies born in flowers?

Flower guardian: Yes, they descend into those matter that are still earthly levels and are born in flowers. However, not in every flower is a flower fairy born. Flower fairies are born in 10 to 30 per cent of flowers.

Tobias: Are they also called flower elves?

Flower Keeper: Flower fairies have a similar function and similar tasks to forest elves, also calling them elves is also appropriate. Their ears are also elvish, except that flower fairies are always female and forest elves male.

Bartosz: Are flower fairies closely connected to the flower? Can they reside outside the flower?

Flower guardian: Flower fairies, like forest elves, are more of an outward support of flowers. They awaken in the flowers and later support the flowers of a particular species. Because they have wings, they can flit to flowers even very far away of the same species.

Tobias: How do they support the flowers?

Flower guardian: Flower fairies have special wands that are filled with an essence specially prepared for this purpose. This is the essence of a particular species of flower and supports the flowering of the flower in question. During the entire flowering process, the fairy can support it with this essence. This process looks as if she is liquefying it with something.

Tobias: Surely their very radiation promotes the flowering of the flowers?

Inflorescence keeper: Yes, it has to do with their connection to the species. Their gentle singing has a very beneficial effect on the flowers.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you would add on this subject?

Flower guardian: Fairies can also dance and in this way intuitively support the flowers. By dancing, they also emit an additional, stronger radiation that envelops the flower. The fairies themselves are wonderful handmaidens of the Creator. Thanks to them, the flowers develop better and can maintain their mature form for longer.

Bartosz: How many flowers does one fairy have in her care?

Flower guardian: It depends on her maturity and also on her willingness. The fairies complement each other and sometimes the same flowers are supported by several fairies. I think one fairy is able to take care of five to ten flowers, however, this is only illustrative and applies to smaller flowers. Each flower species has different fairies and the numbers of flowers the fairies look after can vary.

Tobias: Maybe summarise...

Flower guardian: The flower fairies are a wonderful gift with which all flowers are endowed, and it is willed by the Light that flowers should have such support. It can be said that without this support the flowers would not be so beautiful and all creation would lose a lot.

3.4 Flower maidens

Tobias: Let's now move on to talking about flower ladies.

Flower guardian: There is already as much knowledge in the world about flower fairies, whereas there is virtually no information about flower maidens. They are to flowers more or less what trees are to trees. It is wished that every flower has a flower maiden. They are very strongly connected to the flowers and are practically inside the flowers all the time.

Bartholomew: I'm allowed to use the form 'flower maidens', although maybe one day someone will find a better form to describe them.

Flower Keeper: I think 'flower maidens' is the right form for them.

Tobias: Do all flowers have flower maidens?

Flower guardian: Sometimes flowers that are meant to be picked do not have flower maidens in them. This can be recognised by the fact that these flowers have a less intense fragrance.

Bartholomew: I understand that flower maidens descend into this thick matter seasonally, I understand that flower fairies have similarly?

Flower Keeper: As long as the flowers are alive, the flower maidens and fairies are here. You understand it well, some flower maidens descend for just a few days. They descend from the subtle-material levels for development. One flower maiden needs several hundred or even several thousand descents into this dense matter to reach full maturity. Then both fairies and flower maidens enter the circle of materiality, where their paradise is.

Tobias: How do they affect the flowers?

Inflorescence keeper: Of course, their very presence and radiation has a very beneficial effect on the development of the flower. However, what is characteristic and distinctive about them is that they emit the scent of the flower in question. A flower without a flower maiden does not have the same intense fragrance as a flower in which a flower maiden resides.

Bartosz: Are flower maids aware, for example, that they can enter an area where the grass is being cut?

Flower Maiden Keeper: Yes. Many flower maidens take the risk of entering areas where they may be damaged. Taking such risks intensifies the desire to mature and grow.

Bartosz: Do flower maidens suffer when flowers are destroyed?

Flower Keeper: During normal flower leaving, which is when the flower dies, the flower maidens do not suffer at all, so it is not called dying but only leaving. On the other hand, when the flower is destroyed the flower maidens, who are very connected to the flower, suffer. Therefore, I appeal for people not to destroy flowers thoughtlessly.

Tobias: Do they remember previous descents?

Keeper of the flower: The more mature ones already know more or less how long they have been experiencing, but it is not necessary. It can be said that they intuitively feel that this is not their first contact with a dense-material flower.

Tobias: Do they, like the fairies, dance and sing?

Flower Maid: Yes, of course. Flower maidens are very happy creatures and both dancing and singing is an expression of this happiness. Of course, this works very positively for the particular flower in which they currently reside.

Bartholomew: Anything else you want to add on the subject of flower maidens?

Flower Maiden: Knowing about flower maidens, may be new to many, but Light felt it was necessary to talk about them. I am grateful to be able to care for such wonderful beings, which are the flower maidens. The Creator cares for the beauty of all creation and the flower maidens, who ennoble and beautify the flowers, are wonderful proof of this.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

[3.5 More on flower maidens](#)

A few days later, we continued our conversation.

Bartosz: Hello keeper! As the topic of flower maidens is quite new and I haven't really come across it in any publications, I wanted to ask you a few more questions....

Keeper of the flowers: Hello! Yes, I am ready and listening.

Bartholomew: I have come across people who claim to talk to flowers. I understand that calling flowers the incarnation of flower maidens is incorrect, that is, that it is with them similar to the spars... So do people who claim to talk to flowers talk to maidens?

Flower Maiden: Yes, it is quite common for people to claim to talk to flowers. This is usually because they do not see the beings that the flower maidens are, but only hear them. Anyway, flower maidens, like spars, often identify themselves with a particular flower. Their knowledge is also not always completely correct.

Bartosz: Then I have a question. Why is there virtually no knowledge of flower maidens in the world? After all, there is a great deal of information about the fairies who live next door in many books.

Flower Maiden: The little knowledge of flower maidens is due to the fact that they act and live similarly to flower fairies also in the subtle densomateriality, however on even more subtle levels of it. Therefore, observing flower maidens requires a slightly more subtle eye than that of the fairies.

Bartholomew: I must admit that realising that there is a little creature in almost every flower, i.e. a flower maiden, was quite a surprising discovery for me. It's fair to say that I'm now more careful not to trample the little daisy that grows on the lawn.

Tobias: I have the same ...

Bartholomew: Why exactly has Light now allowed this knowledge?

Flower Keeper: Excellent question. Light sees humans treating flowers badly, often cutting them thoughtlessly or destroying them. The awareness that there are beings living in flowers should change this unwanted custom. Humanity is faced with entering the New Earth. This knowledge is mainly for those people who will build this New Earth. Respect the flowers people, for the beauty they give you is a priceless gift from our Lord!

Bartosz: Thank you for this answer! I have one more question... Do the flower maidens of the flowers that people cut and give to vases, for example, suffer from having to leave sooner?

Flower Keeper: Many flower maidens are even very happy to ennoble a particular house. Usually they pass away a little earlier than those flower maidens who live in flowers that have not been cut and this involves suffering, however, this suffering is very small compared to those flower maidens who have to suddenly pass away due to the sudden destruction of the flower.

Tobias: This short conversation has given us a lot... Do you feel there is anything more to add?

Keeper of the flowers: it is very much wished that the knowledge of the flower maidens is finally revealed. We know that all the damage to flowers that is done by man cannot be avoided. Flower maidens themselves often take risks and descend into areas that are not safe for their lives. However, I believe that many sensitive people will understand that activities such as unauthorised flower destruction should be avoided. You people are enveloped in the beauty of nature, which also manifests itself in flowers. Do not senselessly destroy this beauty.

3.6 The appearance of flower fairies

Towards the evening of the same day, we decided to ask the flower keeper about the appearance of the flower fairies.

Tobias: Welcome back! We now want to talk about the appearance of flower fairies.

Flower Keeper: Yes, I'm prepared for this topic....

Bartosz: Please start.

Flower guardian: There is one character from the film 'Peter Pan' that more or less captures the appearance of flower fairies. It is, of course, the bell. However, flower fairies are not so scantily clad. They have wings that are transparent and wands, which we have already mentioned. They fly up to the flower in question and, by nudging it with their wand, bestow upon it an essence that is beneficial to its ripening.

Tobias: How are they dressed and what colour is their skin?

Flower Keeper: There are a multitude of species of flower fairies. Usually their dresses are shiny and lustrous, and their colours reflect the character of the particular flower. Their skin is usually pale pink and their hair is moderately long depending on their preference. The height depends on the height of the flower in question and is more or less adjusted so that the fairy can act favourably with her radiance on that flower. Dresses are usually below the knees. Fairies do not wear any footwear.

Bartosz: Describe the face to us.

Flower Keeper: The distinctive feature of their face is their elfin ears, so as I said, they can also be called flower elves. They have large beautiful eyes and their faces resemble a woman of about twenty-five years old, but this is also not a rule. The lips are pink in colour. Eyebrows in hair colours depending on the species. The nose resembles a typical human female nose.

After a while.

Flower Keeper: I hope that some future reader will be able to see and perhaps better describe or even paint a flower fairy.

3.7 The appearance of flower maidens

We immediately moved on to describing the appearance of the flower ladies.

Bartosz: We now ask you to describe the appearance of the flower ladies.

Flower guardian: Flower maidens are more noble in their appearance than flower fairies. This nobility also makes them slightly higher in levels of subtle materiality, and their form is also slightly more subtle. Their height is adapted to the size of the flower. They are similar in size to the flower fairies, except that they are practically continuously inside the flower. Their dresses are longer than those of

the fairies and reflect the character of the flower in question with their colour. They have no footwear.

Bartosz: Do they also have elfin ears?

Tobias: And wings?

Flower Keeper: Their ears are more like human ears and, due to the fact that they stay in the flower all the time, they do not have the wings so characteristic of fairies.

Bartosz: And the colour of your skin?

Keeper of the inflorescences: Various shades, usually it is pale pink. However, I only see very few of the numerous flower maiden species on a daily basis.

Tobias: Let's move to the face.

Flower Keeper: The appearance of the face resembles that of a noble lady, who is usually smiling. The eyes express the beauty and depth of the inner being. They are extraordinarily beautiful when smiling, and the wave of bliss that sometimes touches them makes one see how they radiate inner beauty. The nose is typically human. The eyebrows delicately accentuate her subtle beauty. Hair of various colours that is usually elegantly styled, often adorned with a veil.

Tobias: Would you add anything else?

Flower Keeper: Both the description of fairies and maidens is quite illustrative and can arguably vary in many ways across numerous species. The bottom line is that both fairies and maidenhair are extremely beautiful and it is this beauty that complements the beauty contained in the flowers.

3.8 Male and female students

The next day, a new topic of conversation emerged.

Bartosz: Hello Guardian! You have communicated that you have a new topic to discuss. Please start...

Keeper of the flowers: Welcome! There is something that readers of your books have guessed, and yet it has not been discussed more widely. Any guardian of nature's creatures, if they so desire, can have students or pupils who wish to train to become future guardians or guardians.

Bartosz: Do you dear tutor have any students?

Inflorescence keeper: Yes, I have three female students. They help me in my ministry and are preparing to be flower keepers in the future as well. I have great love for them and I want to teach them.

Bartosz: I feel that they look like little girls or girls.

Flower Keeper: Yes, they resemble human children, however, they are not spirits, and they belong to a species of essence just as I do. Every guardian or caregiver, before starting their full-time service, was first a disciple. It is willed that people should also know this and in this way have greater cognition.

Tobias: Do any of the students wish to comment on the book?

Flower Keeper: Yes, I would ask you Anna to speak up....

Student Anna: Hello, I'm thrilled to be learning how to be a floral caregiver in the future. I love all flowers and all the creatures associated with them. I am grateful that our caregiver who serves in the sector around your house is preparing us for future service with such patience and such enthusiasm. I look forward to the thought that one day I will, like her, be able to serve all the flowers and the beings associated with them. I thank the Creator for guiding us and I am grateful for my being and my role in creation.

Tobias: Thank you for these words and we wish you a blessed development! Guardian, is there anything else you would like to say on this subject?

Flower Keeper: My pupils learn very quickly and now have a childlike form, and like earthly people they grow as they mature. I have great love for them because I was once like them. About where the nurturers come from and how they begin their existence, it is not yet time to speak, but what I can say is that we too begin as sparks, or vital germs, and descend to the lower levels of creation. That should be enough for humanity.

Bartosz: Thank you for this knowledge!

3.9 The role and impact of flowers

After a short break on the day, we continued the conversation.

Tobias: Dear caregiver, what is the role of flowers in creation?

Flower Keeper: I have a personal perspective on this subject and would like to present it.

After a while.

Keeper of the flowers: The role of flowers, in my opinion, is very similar to the role of femininity, which is why flower beings are feminine beings. The Creator gave all the worlds in which nature develops flowers to beautify and ennoble. Women recognise and appreciate this role more than men. Let us be grateful that the Creator thought of the beauty of all creation and that we can enjoy this beauty by admiring and feeling the flowers.

Bartosz: How do flowers affect people?

Keeper of the flowers: Flowers have a very beneficial effect on both humans and other experiencing beings in creation. People who are more inwardly open, who smell the scent of flowers and perceive their beauty, feel as if they are transported into an enchanted land full of trust in the Light, full of

childishness, love and beauty. Nowadays, flowers not only influence women, but increasingly awaken the insides of men. Flowers also have their own therapeutic influence and can improve health and, I believe, in many cases heal from many ailments. The influence of flowers is a beautiful gift and I believe that the humanity of the New Earth will fully appreciate this. Today it is recognised by individuals, but I believe the time will come when all of humanity will be aware of it.

Bartosz: Thank you dear caregiver for your beautiful words. I also believe that humanity will increasingly see the beneficial effects of flowers.

Flower Keeper: I want to add something else... Flowers are a great gift of Light. I believe that an increasing proportion of humanity will not treat flowers as objects, as before, and will recognise their role and influence on all subsequent creation.

Tobias: Thank you!

3.10. Message to humanity

Bartosz: At the beginning of our talks, you mentioned a message to humanity about flowers. Are you ready to present this message?

Keeper of the flowers: I am ready.

Tobias: Start, please.

Keeper of the Flowers: Up to now, man has not treated flowers with the necessary respect and deference. Dear people, you must realise that flowers are a gift from the Light and it is willed that you treat them precisely as a gift. From the beginning, when man arrived on earth, the Light permitted the cutting of flowers to beautify homes or temples. However, the Light has never permitted the wanton destruction of flowers, which was not justified by anything. This book gives knowledge about flower maidens and fairies. Some of them very much want to experience in the proximity of a human being, and therefore in the flowers that you place in vases. However, not all of them desire this and therefore I urge you to be more conscious of the purpose of the flowers in question. In this way you will allow these beings to experience according to their will and desire. We know that in caring for your gardens you often cut or destroy flowers while mowing or doing other things. The Light does not wish to forbid you to do this, but I urge you to do it with your head and to determine the purpose of the flowers in question as quickly as possible. In many cases, your conscience will tell you whether you can cut the flowers in question. Be considerate and never wantonly destroy flowers. You can also ask the Light for permission to cut and this permission may be granted, but you must take into account that this will not always be the case. Your conscience and your feelings will show you the truth in this matter. It is the will of the Light that you take this message into account during your stay on earth.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

Flower Keeper: I feel I have fulfilled the task.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: We rejoice! Be blessed!

Flower Keeper: Thank you. These are my last words in the pages of your book. I have given you knowledge about flowers and flower beings, which I love very much. Use this knowledge with responsibility and build your contact with the flowers and with their beings with great sensitivity.

4. Animal keepers

4.1 Preliminary information

We opened up to learning about animal carers. An essence emerged.

Bartosz: Hello creature! Who are you and what can we talk to you about?

The essence: we are a group of beings who take care of animals. We care for animals and we want humanity to know about us. There is, unfortunately, little knowledge in the world about us and we want to at least partially change that. We will not talk about details such as our appearance, as there are many different types of us, and what we will give you will be general cognition.

Bartholomew: We have been reading about the so-called animal guidance and we know that specific creatures like centaurs, fauns, as well as the creatures we have already talked about, i.e. phyllids and mermaids, deal with this....

Animal guardian: Yes, these beings mainly guide groups or herds of wild animals. However, in addition to these so-called guides, each animal has an individual guardian, as each animal is actually an experiencing soul that also deserves love and care from the Light. We, the guardians, are in fact a reflection of God's love for all animals.

Bartosz: In reality, does every animal have its own individual carer, or do exceptions happen?

Animal carer: Yes, all animals except insects... Insects have their own group carers and such care is quite sufficient for them.

Tobias: Maybe let's not go into detail at this stage... Tell me, why do you want to talk about yourself?

Animal Keeper: Thank you for this question. First of all, we want to show the world that the Creator loves all animals and we animal carers are an expression of this love. Man very often treats animals objectively and does not think about the fact that an animal has a soul. Man is responsible for a huge part of all the suffering that animals suffer today. We animal carers want to draw attention to this and call for change.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you want to add by way of introduction?

Keeper of the animals: Man often does not realise how much love God bestows on all his creatures throughout creation. Every animal is worthy of the love that God bestows upon it. Animals fulfil their tasks perfectly according to their species and have every right to develop in the matter of the world. However, in the way of the development of animals has stood man, who does not respect animals and does not think of them as smaller brothers. We animal carers deeply regret this fact and our main message is to modern man to change and to understand that all animals are in fact his smaller unconscious brothers.

4.2 The love of carers for their charges

After a short break, we continued the conversation.

Bartosz: To develop the discussion, I want to ask you something. What really drives you and what guides you?

Animal Keeper: God has given us a great love. It is a love for our charges, for the animals in our care. Each of us cares for the animal in our care as if it were our greatest treasure. There is a kind of devotion and service to the Light in this. We want the animals to thrive and our presence helps them to do so.

Bartosz: Do the animals feel your love and your support?

Animal Guardian: Yes, the animals feel our love and that we support them. We do not expect much in return. When an animal is happy and enjoys its existence, that is reward enough for us for our love.

Tobias: Do you suffer when an animal suffers?

Animal carer: It depends on the degree of sensitivity of the individual carer. We do not want our charges to suffer, but we know what life is like and we also take into account that suffering is often necessary on the path of development. It is not only among humans that such experiences have a deeper meaning, but also during the maturation of each animal - suffering is part of their life.

Bartosz: Can you reveal what animal you look after?

Animal keeper: There is a pond near your house and I look after one of the fish there. I am a fish keeper.

Bartholomew: How much do you love your mentee and can you express it in any way?

Animal caregiver: I love looking into the eyes of my charge. It is said that the eyes of a fish do not express feelings, however, I see much more than people do. I feel my charge's needs internally and I am very happy when I feel his happiness. I love him very much and I do not want to let him down because I know that I am the only support for him.

4.3 Further information on animal carers

We continued our conversation.

Tobias: What does your service as a caregiver entail?

Animal caregiver: First and foremost, my proximity and presence has a great impact on my mentee's feelings. I also have a lot of tools that I can use to interact with my mentee for further development. However, it is not wanted at the moment to talk about this. Knowing that we exist and support animals is already a big step in learning about nature. Now is not the time to talk about the details.

Tobias: Do the animals know of your existence and can they see you?

Animal Keeper: They only see us when it is necessary. We may show ourselves to them to, for example, warn them of something, however, this does not happen very often. I am convinced that my charge is aware of my presence and my support. I know that he feels a kind of longing when I am not with him. This is how my dear Tobias feels about this subject.

Bartholomew: Do you animal carers also have your own supervisors?

Animal Keeper: Thank you for this question. Yes, we have our supervisors and these in turn have even higher supervisors. Our higher guidance extends all the way to the circle of significance. There, the plans for specific species on earth are anchored in the will of God. As you probably know, on earth many species have appeared and then disappeared. Such processes are governed by God's will and throughout the history of our planet there have been no coincidences in this regard. We, the caretakers also have to adapt to this will. On the basis of what I have said, you can build a picture for yourselves of us animal caretakers. This image says that we are guided by both love and God's will.

Bartosz: Do you have any information on how particular animal species will be on earth for a long time to come?

Animal Keeper: I don't have advanced knowledge of the subject. But there are many things I guess. It is not wanted to talk about it exactly, but there are some plans for many animal species.

Bartosz: I understand that the disappearance of many animal species due to human activity is not wanted by the Light.

Keeper of the Animals: as you may have guessed, Light takes into account human activity on earth and its impact on the extinction of species. However, it is not God's will for this to happen. The Lord God wants a happy coexistence of man and animals on this planet. Man not only has to take this into account, but even has to conform to God's will, as this forces more and more pressure of the Light on our planet.

Tobias: Is there anything else you want to add?

Keeper of animals: The stay of animals on earth is regulated by God's will. Each species is given its time to develop and usually this time is used up. Animals develop properly, and only man is the one who stood in their way of development and began to treat them as his property. The animal is not man's property, but belongs to the Light, and only when the Light allows the animal to be used for man's purposes can he do so. Let man remember this.

4.4 Treatment of animals by humans

The next day we continued our discussions with the animal keeper.

Bartosz: Hello Guardian! There are many videos on the internet showing how atrociously, or to put it in bestial terms, the animals from which meat is extracted for food are treated. Could you please comment on this?

Animal carer: This is not a happy message, however necessary. We animal carers suffer greatly from the way humans treat farm animals. People in factories, meat production facilities or

slaughterhouses are not aware that they are actually depriving living beings with souls of their lives. Animals are kept in cramped quarters or cages often filled with their own faeces. The animals spend their entire lives in such a place and, if they become ill, they are immediately killed as those that do not yield a profit in the future. The way in which animals are slaughtered for their meat is extremely often, and in many countries always, unworthy of human beings. Animals see others being slaughtered and are filled with fear and, of course, suffer unimaginably. This is a terrible subject for us, and the carers who look after these animals also suffer.

After a short while.

Animal Keeper: The light long ago allowed man to eat animal flesh. However, man has made a business out of it based on his lust for profit. This lust has blinded man to such an extent that he no longer sees the truth about animals at all. This truth states that animals have souls and feel pain, suffering and fear just like humans do. In the New Earth, or the New Promised Kingdom, there will be no more acceptance of such treatment of animals. Man, before you kill an animal and use its meat for food, give it the opportunity to enjoy life. People are often unaware of the fact that the suffering associated with the death of an animal can be reduced to practically zero.

After the break.

Animal Guardian: I love all animals and wish humans would move away from eating their meat, however I feel the process should be gradual. Suddenly removing all meat from your diet can be detrimental to many people. Your bodies have been accustomed to eating meat for millennia and in my opinion this cannot be jumped over.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your contributions, which have contributed a lot.

4.5 Impact of animal care on humans

Bartholomew: You dropped a topic about people caring for animals....

Animal Guardian: The fact that we look after animals should not be the only way to support them. People should also care for animals and I know that many people with pure hearts are already doing this. With this topic, I wanted to draw attention to how much people can gain from such care.

Tobias: Please elaborate.

Animal carer: The person who takes care of animals gains in a spiritual sense. His sensitivity and awareness of the presence of other living beings increases. Man learns to love and begins to see the beauty of animal souls. I very much appreciate people who take care of animals, because they make our tasks easier.

Tobias: Is there anything else you want to say?

Animal Keeper: Animals are sentient beings with beautiful souls. Show them the love they deserve. Hug them, stroke them, cuddle them and you will see their sincere reaction to such your show of affection. Animals need love too and any human being who loves animals is a noble fruit of this creation.

4.6 Experiences of Bartholomew and Tobias

Animal Keeper: It is coveted Bartholomew that you share your experiences with animals.

Tobias: I know what those experiences are and I'm glad they will be in this book!

Bartosz: The first experience concerns our cat "Drako", who has already passed away some time ago. It was a time when he was still a small kitten. At that time he had a certain toy permanently tied on a string to a chair. One day he was playing with this toy and I heard terrible moans. The moans were very frightening. I ran over and noticed that 'Drako' had become so awkwardly entangled in the string that he had started to choke. I ran up to him and at first I couldn't help him because the cord was squeezing his throat very tightly. I ran for the scissors and as gently as I could, I cut the cord off. Drako was initially shocked and jumped far away, but when he calmed down after a while, he came to me and I felt as if he was thanking me. At that moment I heard the voice of his handler thanking me for what I had done. It was my first contact with an animal carer.

After a short while.

Bartosz: The second incident I didn't want to share, but I will do so at the request of the guardian, because I also feel that the Light wants me to share it. One day I was talking to my father about stray dogs in our neighbourhood. He told me at the time that there are one or two that always stick together and seem to be good friends. Some time had passed since that conversation and while walking home from work, I came across an incident. There was a dog lying on the road that had probably been run over by a car. This came as a big shock to me because I saw that the dog was still alive. I wanted to get closer to the dog, but there were people with it and at that moment I thought they were its owners. I didn't want to disturb and I moved away from the whole incident, but internally I felt that I wanted to help somehow. I knew the dog was suffering and I wanted to stop the torment somehow. I decided that I would try to cut off the dog's soul, from its dense material body, however, I felt that I needed the Light's permission to do so. My guides conveyed to me that there was Light's consent for this process. I made the cut-off and immediately the soul of the dog, which I could see quite well, appeared by my side. It was extremely joyful and jumped towards me, wagging its tail. I realised that I had spared her a lot of suffering. I then began my standard process of draining the soul to a level of creation compatible with its maturity. I had already had several such discharges, so I knew it had to be done. A few weeks passed and, more or less in the same place where the body was lying, another dog came running up to me and started wagging its tail and jumping at me for joy. I didn't know what to do and this joyful dog accompanied me most of the way to the bus. It wasn't until a while later that I realised that this dog was aware of the process of cutting off and escorting that one, perhaps he knew him well and was grateful to me for it. I suspect the two dogs were friends my father had mentioned to me earlier. Dear carer, do you suspect that animals can feel such things?

Animal Keeper: There are animals that can see souls and above all feel very well. The two dogs were not necessarily the friends your father mentioned, but the other dog could feel that you were very friendly towards animals. With your noble deed, you gained their favour. Thank you for sharing this. It is pleasing to God that this entry is included in this book. Tobias, I feel you can share something too....

Tobias: Yes, one day a few years ago I was on a walk in the forest. As usual I was hugging my friends - the trees. This time I was alone on this walk, I usually go with Bartosz. At one point an older man walked past me and we started talking. I told him about hugging trees and he confirmed that he does it too. He said he had a big old tree next to his house, it was probably an oak, if I remember correctly. He said he often cuddles up to it. This made me happy, because not many people still know about how trees can support us. We talked for a while and he looked at me, confiding. He said he had a lot of remorse because he had worked a large part of his life in a slaughterhouse and killed animals. It was a very sincere and sad confession. I felt very sorry for him and didn't really know what to think about it, because at the time I wasn't fully aware of how cruelly animals are treated in these places. I tried to comfort and support him somehow. I only remembered this conversation while writing this chapter of the book. I understood why this elderly gentleman felt great sorrow when thinking about what he had been doing for many years, because probably what he was doing was not pleasing to God. I hope that this man will be able to make amends somehow and that his soul will find peace.

Animal Keeper: Thank you Tobias. In this case, the remorse and accompanying guilt points to the truth. This man is now aware that the mistreatment of animals, of which he was a part, stood in contradiction to God's will. I am glad that this man has realised this, although it probably took him a lifetime to do so. I hope that with this recognition, this man will permanently change his attitude towards animals and find peace. Thank you Tobias. I think your post has added a lot to our conversations and is a great example and testimony of what we are talking about.

4.7 Message to humanity

Tobias: We ask for a message for humanity regarding humanity's interaction with animals.

A being appointed for this purpose appeared, who presented himself as a higher animal guardian.

Higher animal guardian: Animals and humans live on the same planet right next to each other. Light wants humans not to treat animals down and treat them as soulless beings like things or products. Animals are beautiful beings that have souls and feel all aspects of life just like humans. Look people in the eyes of animals and you will see the spark that gives them life. The Light has given man permission to eat animal flesh, however, man abuses this permission by setting profit as his main goal. The path to this goal often deprives animals of their dignity and makes their existence one great suffering. There is no consent of the Light to cause senseless suffering to animals. Man, if he wishes to enter a new stage of development, must change, and this change is to apply also to the treatment of animals. Strive to make animals happy while they are alive, and when you want to kill them and use them for meat, do so in accordance with God's laws and in accordance with God's will. Use all your means to minimise their suffering as much as you can. Be grateful to those animals you use for food, for without them you would not have meat and other products. Do not disregard the words of this message, for the Light will severely punish all those who continue to cause animal suffering. Take heed of these words and build the New Earth in peace and love for animals too.

5. Giants

5.1 First contact

A giant appeared to whom we suggested the name Mau. He agreed and we started a discussion.

Bartosz: Hello Mau!

Mau: Hello to you! At the outset I want to point out that we very rarely contact people and give any messages about ourselves. Generally people do not deserve the truth about us, but because it is the will of the Light that we speak about ourselves, we will give you a general insight about us.

Tobias: Hello, tell us something by way of introduction about you.

Mau: We are faithful to the Creator and serve Him. Many ancient peoples knew of us and respected us. We have always been close to those nations that served the Light. Today there is no such nation on earth. Most of us are based in the mountains, that is where our homes are, but we also operate in the lowlands and wherever the Light sends us.

Bartosz: What can you share with us?

Mau: I think your questions will shape our conversations. You, Bartholomew, have a great feel for what you can ask and what topics to cover. We won't talk too much about details such as our appearance. Let Bartosz your intuition and Tobias' intuition guide our conversations.

Tobias: Maybe add something by way of introduction.

Mau: The Light has allowed transmissions from us. We, as handmaidens of the Light, have to comply. We want people to know about us and think of us with respect. We hope that your transmissions will help with this. We have been on Earth practically since the beginning of its formation and we work here, carrying out the plans of the Light and His will.

5.2 Tasks of the giants

We continued our conversation with the Mau Giant.

Bartosz: Can you say something about the tasks of the giants?

Mau: We have many tasks throughout creation, as well as on earth. Our crowning work, which I want to mention now, is all the mountains of the world. We are the ones who created the mountains with our service on behalf of the Light.

Bartholomew: I understand that the so-called upward movements are the movements that you are creating?

Mau: Yes, mountain movements are a consequence of our activities as seen by people.

Bartosz: Are the drifts of the continents and consequently also the collisions of the continents that can form mountains also your work?

Mau: Powerful beings are responsible for the drift of the continents, which can also be called giants because of their size. We often cooperate with these beings and have common goals. Our most important goal is to transform the planet into the image that the Light wants.

Tobias: And earthquakes and volcanic eruptions?

Mau: Yes. All the powerful changes that are happening on earth are done by us or supported by us. We do many of these processes together with our Cyclops brothers. We have our divisions of responsibilities, which are defined by the higher guides. I don't want to go into details, because it is probably different in different parts of the world with this division. I mainly deal with my duties, which I meticulously fulfil.

Bartholomew: And where do you and your ministry currently stand?

Mau: I have been connected to the mountains, to the Tatras, for a very long time. That's where I do my tasks, which are commissioned by the higher guardians.

Bartosz: Who gives you the assignments?

Mau: There are a lot of beings involved. We are very much connected to the titans in the vital circle. There are also other beings that we call our leaders and they too, under the pressure of the divine will, force our actions.

Tobias: Can you say what those tasks are at the moment?

Mau: We giants also have our secrets, but I can tell you that there are many processes in the mountains that we initiate. A simple rock avalanche is usually caused by our actions. Of course, we do not act arbitrarily, and all processes are strictly planned and regulated by the will of the Creator.

Tobias: Is there anything else you want to add regarding the tasks and your service?

Mau: With this talk, we have more or less shown you our tasks and what we do in our service. How we perform these tasks should remain our secret. Perhaps one day people will deserve more detailed information.

5.3 Master builders

We moved on to the next topic in our conversation with the Mau Giant.

Bartosz: According to many accounts and many books, you took part in the construction of many buildings. Even today, modern building technology would not be able to reproduce them. Can you elaborate on this?

Mau: In addition to the earth processes we mentioned in the previous section, we giants have other fields of our activities. One of them is the building of great structures. It is wanting people to know the truth about the fact that we are actually responsible for building them.

Bartosz: Many peoples such as the Incas probably benefited from your help... Did you act on their requests?

Mau: The requests of these nations or peoples alone could never be sufficient. If God allowed a building to be built and simply fulfilled the request then and only then did we take our action. However, not all buildings were the fruit of people's requests. There were also buildings that were gifts of Light to a particular people when they deserved it or earned it through their service. There are also buildings that were strictly planned by the Light and their construction had no connection with any people or nation. Such a building is the Great Pyramid in Egypt.

Bartosz: Can you say something about the process of putting together the large rock objects that fascinate many researchers. Can you say more about the whole construction process?

Mau: We are one of the few species that can directly influence densomateriality. This gift also enables us to build objects. During construction, we use our special tools, which I don't want to talk about in more detail. We do not tell humanity all our secrets and therefore, when building objects, we often operate under the cover of night or fog.

Tobias: I have a question unrelated to this chapter... What is it like to be a giant?

Mau: Thank you for this question! Being a giant is a wonderful thing Tobias. Joy fills us for being part of this creation and being able to serve our Lord. We are content and rejoice in every mission and every even the smallest task that the Light dictates. By doing and carrying out the tasks given, we become a useful part of the whole creation. The fact that our service is pleasing to God makes us happy beings. Your question Tobias filled me with joy because I can share with people how wonderful it is to be a giant serving the Light.

Tobias: A beautiful answer! I am touched... Is there anything else you would like to say?

Mau: In our stay on earth, we giants have supported people many times. The most beautiful fruit of this support are the many buildings we have built. There is a desire for us to say more about the Great Pyramid, which is the most important building that the giants have built. Let our next conversation be about it.

5.4 The Great Pyramid

Two days later, we returned to our conversation with Mau.

Bartosz: Hello Mau! One of the structures that the giants built in collaboration with humans is the Great Pyramid. We have been reading books on the subject. They are: "The Great Pyramid Reveals its Secret" by Roselis von Sass and "The Great Pyramid Stone Calendar Decoded: Sphinx Mystery Revealed" by Aikao Virtaa. What can you say in this regard?

Mau: The Great Pyramid is a building meticulously planned by the Light. Its all dimensions are not accidental. It took many years to build it and it was willed to last until the present time. Its secret has been revealed and the two books you mentioned explain everything. Many giants collaborated with humans during the construction process. It was a large-scale mobilisation and a great task for all who took part.

Tobias: It saddens me that even though the truth about this object and its significance has been discovered and revealed, still so few people have come to it. The information that the truth gives us is of great importance and affects every human being on this planet. I hope that through this book, more people will pay attention to the facts that cannot be denied....

Mau: The Great Pyramid, as it has been revealed, is actually a calendar of future events. The precision of this calendar is so exact that even the greatest sceptic should consider that a force majeure was involved in its planning and design. Many of the events that are hidden in this calendar have already happened, in fact most of them. For example, the birth and sojourn on earth of the Son of God Jesus Christ was an important event. However, what is most important is the foreshadowing of the so-called Last Judgement, a time which is our present time.

Tobias: As a giant, a being of nature, what would you say to people for whom this is new information. Information that could change their perception of the world?

Mau: You do not have to take what I have said for granted. You should come to your own conclusions based on research and inquiry. I am only giving the impetus for more advanced research, which anyone interested in the subject should undertake.

Bartosz: I think we can recommend the two books we mentioned to those more interested in the subject.

Tobias: I would like to add that a great deal of untruths have already been told about the Great Pyramid. Firstly, people have no idea that it was you giants who participated in the construction process. Secondly, few people are aware of the facts showing its true significance.... I hope that our book will point the way to the truth about it for many seekers... Mau, what would you add to conclude this subsection?

Mau: I wanted to point out that it is not necessary for modern people to know everything about the Pyramid. It is, of course, one way of showing what period in the history of the world mankind is currently living in. What is necessary for man and much more important is his inner transformation and making sure that everything he emanates resonates with the will of God.

5.5 Questions for the giant

As conversations with giants are rare, we decided to ask Mau questions to get a closer look at the giants and their wisdom.

Tobias: Mau tell us what love is to you giant?

Mau: Love is service. He who serves, loves. The fullest expression of love, then, is service to the Creator. The one who serves the Creator loves Him and expresses this in his actions. Everything he

does in this way is beneficial to the development of all creation. Learn to love people, to love the Creator, for only this authentic service is the true manifestation of the life that you are.

Bartosz: Can a giant be friends with a human?

Mau: I suspect the hidden meaning of the question, and I understand that you are also looking for friends among giants. Of course such friendships are possible. If a person is pure enough and has no vanity in him, giants can also approach him. We love people who serve the Light and, even though it is extremely rare, we can enter into a friendship relationship with such people.

Bartosz: And would you be able to make friends with us?

Mau: I see your potentials and spiritual purity, therefore I see no obstacles.

We smiled.

Tobias: I welcome your answer... I have another question: what feelings do you have for the greater part of humanity that does not serve the Light and is plunged into darkness?

Mau: We giants see the decline of humanity. This is very sad for us. We give love to all humans, however, we see how they have turned away from the Light and how they treat nature. This is the love of Tobias, however it is most often in its rawness. We are raw because we have to be that way. This is how the force of the Light, which enforces this attitude, shapes our inner selves.

Tobias: I believe that humanity will change and their relationship with nature will also change. Through this, they will also regain their connection with you giants. Probably some beautiful buildings will be built, at the construction of which you will also participate. Do you know anything about this?

Mou: Yes Tobias. It is the will of God that the giants in the new Kingdom will come closer to the people. Doubtless many buildings will be built and I know that there are plans to do so. However, a long road awaits mankind, but that time will come one day. We are open and waiting for the spiritual rebirth of humanity.

Tobias: I remember when I found out that there were beings of nature called giants. It seemed a bit unbelievable and even a fairy tale to me, but I trusted my feelings that said it was true. I'm sure a lot of people put between fairy tales the possibility of your existence, while others may be afraid... What would you say about this?

Mau: Our existence is a fact. The fact that people throw our existence and the existence of other natural beings between fairy tales only proves their great limitation. Arguably, we are not as beautiful as the flower fairies and on first contacts one may actually be frightened of us. One who serves the Light will understand that we are exactly as we are meant to be. This is how we have been formed by creation and the working of God's will. Our voices, which are low, can also frighten many people; however, they too are exactly as they are meant to be. If a person understands that we have been formed by the creative will of God and we, as fruits of this will, also act in accordance with it, then all fear will disappear. Do not fear us humans, but give us respect, because our species fully deserves it.

Tobias: It is remarkable to me that thanks to our book writing project and Bartosz's gift, I even have contact with a giant, something I never even dreamed of... Giants have always seemed sublime to me and very distant from humanity....

Mau: Contact with us is a long way off for most of humanity. For many of them it will never happen. The fact that Bartholomew can speak to us is a great gift and grace of the Light. It is willed that Bartosh's gift will benefit all of humanity. I know that your books provide this benefit and I am convinced that inwardly pure people will appreciate them.

Bartosz: Do you smile often?

Mau: Our inner smile accompanies us practically all the time. Serving the Light gives us this joy. Every being who feels useful in creation carries a similar joy. The smile on our faces, on the other hand, depends on the disposition of the giant in question. I do not smile very often.

After which he smiled.

Bartosz: Now you have smiled.

Mau: Yes Bartosh, I have grown very fond of you and I can honestly tell you that your company makes me smile.

Tobias: Do giants pray to the Creator?

Mau: Our service is a prayer, but there are also prayers as a form of thanks, and also, although much less frequently, as a request.

Bartosz: I used to have a message that I had contacts with you in previous incarnations and I feel it now.

Mau: You give us a lot of love Bartosz. You can feel it. You have probably interacted with many giants in the past.

Bartholomew: I think we'll end there... Thank you Mau!

Mau: I feel that this is the end of my messages in your book. I feel that our relationship does not end here and I will continue to visit you. The Lord has sent me a portion of light as proof that I have fulfilled the task. May this account of my conversations with you bring blessing and benefit to the people.

Tobias: Thank you Mau! Be a blessed being!

5.6 Space giants

Another species of creatures of nature, which by virtue of their size could also be called giants, are creatures found in space, which we have called space giants. This is a different species of beings from

earth giants. Here is our conversation with one of the representatives. For the purpose of this book, we have named him Tau.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello Tau! We look forward to hearing from you!

Tau: Welcome! Our message to humanity will be brief. We mainly care about letting people know of our existence.

Tobias: So please continue.

Tau: There is a certain order in space that we take care of. There are many species of beings that you have called space giants. We have numerous tasks that we fulfil with joy. Our main task is to take care of order throughout space. This order is regulated by God's laws.

Bartosz: Do you also look after the heavenly bodies?

Tau: Yes. However, this is not our main task. We give love to every celestial body because it was God's will to form them. We care for and take an active part in the formation process of the planets. We also played a major part in the formation of the earth. We interacted with the matter around the sun star in such a way that a planet was formed. Of course, for the formation of a planet and then for life to arise on it, many common parts or aspects must be fulfilled and other beings also took part in the formation, but our role in this is also large.

Tobias: What is this order you mentioned?

Tau: As the name suggests, order is keeping an eye on certain regulations. Order is also making sure that chaos does not dominate space. Every phenomenon in space is meticulously planned by the Light. We, the beings of space, make sure that this plan is fulfilled. We fulfil whatever tasks the higher guardians of the vital circle commission us to do. As you may have guessed, all plans for the dense material cosmos are governed by the will of God, and we simply make sure that it is so.

Bartosz: As you said, there are many species of you... Do you also regulate the processes of whole galaxies, not just planets?

Tau: There are a lot of us species, also certain processes you mentioned, which are better called phenomena, are also regulated by us. The order of the whole cosmos must be preserved and fulfilled. Every movement of even the smallest celestial bodies is strictly planned and regulated by us.

Tobias: Would the heavenly bodies move without your participation?

Tau: In principle, we initiate many movements of celestial bodies and they then move in a well-defined direction without our participation. However, here, too, we have to ensure that there are no unwanted collisions or unwanted interactions with other celestial bodies. You can also see what we are actually guarding.

Bartosz: Are collisions of celestial bodies such as meteors or asteroids also planned?

Tau: Of course Bartosz. Cataclysms such as asteroid impacts on a planet such as the earth are also planned by the Light and one asteroid impact on a planet can lead to the extinction of many species. Usually the reason for this is that the time for the development of a species on a given planet has passed, also in this process there is no question of coincidence.

Bartosz: Does the earth face cataclysms of cosmic origin?

Tau: This is not my area of work and I feel that even if I knew, I couldn't talk about the details, but based on how I see the subject, I can comment that there is a possibility.

Tobias: I think your contributions have given us a lot. How would you sum up this conversation?

Tau: The awareness that there are beings in space too is a very important cognition. It is willed by the Light for people to know about us. There is no process or phenomenon in space that is not regulated by the will of the Creator. We cosmic giants or beings of space make sure that every phenomenon is precisely in accordance with the will of God and therefore with the plan of the Light.

Tobias: Thank you Tau! Be a blessed being of the cosmos!

Tau: I see the result of your work in creating the books and I am very happy that you give so much to the world. I am also happy that you have also mentioned us. I am filled with joy because I have fulfilled my part of the task and given you the truth about us. This is not the time for more detailed descriptions of us and the knowledge I have given you is quite sufficient for this moment.

Bartosz: I am glad that you have enriched our and the readers' knowledge. I thank you and wish you much happiness in the paths of service you bravely perform.

6. Bartholomew's experience

There is an incident that we mentioned when we spoke to the forest guardian. In 2017, where the current forest guardian is now stationed, another guardian was stationed who had been appointed to serve at a higher level. Bartosz witnessed this promotion and we wanted to describe here the event that made this promotion possible.

Bartosz: It was 2017, and at that time I made my first serious contact with elves, as well as with the keeper of the forest, who visited me from time to time. One day the keeper was a guest in my room and listened to what I happened to be reading. I was reading 'The Grail Message - In the Light of Truth' at the time, it was a lecture: "Thought Forms". During this reading, the mentor became very interested in the content. His interest turned into admiration and every few sentences I read he repeated: "Amazing, amazing". After I had finished reading this lecture, the guardian approached me with great calmness and said that he had just been promoted and would be raised to a higher level from which he would look after the forest. After these words he was elevated and I was stunned. After this event, another being appeared and communicated to me that the caretaker had just accepted 100% of the cognition from the lecture I had read and that his cognition had increased so much that he had been promoted to a higher level of creation.
