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# 1. Introduction

## 1.1. Tobiasz's Foreword

After writing the books "Trees talk "Animistic beings talk Part 1", and "Animistic beings talk Part 2", it is time for the finale: "Animistic beings talk Part 3". In this part, we will focus on the forest beings, the flower beings, the animal guardians, as well as the giants. All these beings were very friendly and open to conversations with us. This book has the potential to greatly expand our understanding.

As humans, we often visit the forest for walks and frequently interact with flowers, but few of us perceive the many beings that serve in the forests and flowers. Even fewer have heard that, by the Will of the Creator, every animal has its own dedicated guardian. This book is about all of these things. Additionally, we had the rare pleasure of speaking with giants, which is an extraordinary experience for humans.

This book is the final part of our series, and I am immensely grateful to God for allowing me to participate in this journey — a journey in which we learn much about God's servants, whom humanity as a whole has forgotten. These servants of God always emphasize that all their noble work is done in accordance with and under the command of God's Will. They are immersed in this Will, and we, as humans, should take their example and also strive to live in accordance with it! Enjoy the reading!

## 1.2. Bartosz's Foreword

With this book, we conclude the project that Tobiasz and I began around September and October of 2023 when we wrote "Trees talk". Throughout this time, we have greatly enriched our knowledge. Every reader who goes through our books has the opportunity to learn more about the beings of nature, their beautiful service, and their work. Together with Tobiasz, we consider the knowledge gained from these books to be a great gift of Light for humanity.

In this part, we focused on the forest beings, the flower beings, the animal guardians, and the giants. The contact with the beings who speak throughout the pages of our book was an extraordinary experience for us. All of them, with great kindness and openness, shared with us insights about the nature of their service to the Light.

This short book first takes us into the forest, where the forest guardian plays a dominant role. Then, we gain knowledge about flowers and the caretaker who lovingly tends to them, as well as the flower beings. Next, we learn about the animal guardians, and finally, we gain understanding about the giants. I hope that this book brings something good into your life, dear reader. Enjoy the reading.

## 2. Forest Beings

### 2.1. Preliminary Information

*We have established contact with a being we have known for seven years. It is the forest guardian, whose forest we frequently visit.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello, Forest Guardian! It has been a long time since our first regular contacts. We are happy to speak with you again.

Forest Guardian: Hello! It was not the Will of the Light for us to communicate during that time. You had other matters to work through. Now I am back and ready to share with you knowledge about the forest and the beings that act there.

Bartosz: Can you tell us which beings we can discuss with you?

Forest Guardian: First of all, the forest follows certain rhythms that regulate the seasons. Even children know that nature sleeps in winter and is reborn in spring. Specific types of nature beings accompany these rhythms. I will try to present the most important of them and their tasks, which I will describe in more general terms. I will also address topics when I feel it is desired for me to speak about them. The knowledge that will emerge from my transmissions is meant to serve as a foundation, which will later be filled in with more detailed explanations.

Tobiasz: Thank you for these introductory words, and we look forward to our future conversations!

### 2.2. Forest Guardian Speaks About Himself

Bartosz: Can you tell us more about yourself? What do you do?

Forest Guardian: I am the guardian of the forest you visit. I oversee a fairly large area, which includes many nature beings. My role is both managerial and protective. I ensure that all processes in my area run smoothly. I support the nature beings as well as their guardians in their tasks. I also have a higher guardian who has a broader perspective and guides me in carrying out specific duties. He also makes me aware of various deficiencies that need to be addressed promptly. The forest is alive, and there is much to learn to care for it effectively.

*A moment later.*

Forest Guardian: One must stay alert and act continuously for the benefit of the plants, trees, and beings in the forest.

Bartosz: Could you roughly describe what you look like?

Forest Guardian: Since I am a being of the forest, I need to oversee the entire area. Therefore, I am a tall being. My height is around 3.0 meters, but I can also increase it, for example, when I want to check what is happening higher up in the tree canopies. However, my usual height, in which I most commonly appear, is around 3.0 meters.

Tobiasz: Do you wear clothes?

Forest Guardian: I do wear clothes, and they are in the colors of the forest, with green being the dominant one. My skin is also green. I don't want to say much more because there are many

guardians who look somewhat different from me. I think you would have to see me to describe it more accurately in human words.

Tobiasz: What are your duties?

Forest Guardian: When I notice, either myself or through my guidance, certain deficiencies or that forest processes are not running harmoniously, I inform specific beings and assign them particular tasks. However, to speak about this more broadly would require very detailed knowledge, so I am describing it in more general terms.

Bartosz: Are you a nature being?

Forest Guardian: I know, Bartosz, that you differentiate between nature beings and guardians. I feel like a nature being completely connected with the forest. I do not belong to the caste of guardians you mentioned in your previous books. I operate more locally and in close connection with the nature beings you can encounter in the forest. Just as an tree being is the internal guardian of a tree, I am the guardian of the entire forest.

Tobiasz: What else would you like to say by way of introduction about yourself?

Forest Guardian: I think our contact can be very fruitful for a better understanding of the forest. There are many things you already know or suspect, but there are also new things I want to share. I believe the knowledge emerging from my transmissions will be skeletal and general. Later, I trust that others will come after you to fill in and enrich it with further details.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

### 2.3. Tree Beings

*We connected with the old beech to complete the knowledge we included in our first book<sup>1</sup>.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello, friend!

Old Beech: Hello! It has been a while since we last spoke. I can see how much knowledge you both have gained. I respect you greatly because you are doing so much for the world, and the knowledge you possess is unique, even among nature beings.

Bartosz: I have a question for you: Based on our conversations, we concluded that every nature being has a sectoral and species-specific guardian... Is this the case with tree beings as well?

Old Beech: I have one guardian with whom I communicate, but I understand that other nature beings require dual guidance. My guardian, whom you called the "higher guardian," takes care of my proper development. We don't have influence over the earth's movements like the gnomes, so we don't require strictly dual guidance.

Bartosz: I also need to clarify and explain something... As readers may recall, I called your guardians "higher guardians". This term is somewhat misleading, even incorrect. It stems from an incident we had at the beginning of writing the book in a conversation with the birch trees. The guardian who approached us and blocked the connection was called a "higher guardian". At that time, I had only a vague understanding of the hierarchical and pyramidal structure of the guardians. Indeed, it was a

higher guardian who descended from the higher levels and conveyed the message to us. He wasn't a local guardian but one positioned a bit higher in the hierarchy. After that incident, I thought calling them "higher guardians" was appropriate, but today I know they should simply be called "guardians". Most of the conversations in our book were with local guardians, and they should simply be called "guardians."

Old Beech: Bartosz, you are very precise, and I appreciate that greatly.

Bartosz: Old beech, we spoke about the Tree of Life, which exists in the Animistic Realm, and you called the tree being living within it your leader. However, I feel that your leaders are other beings.

Old Beech: Out of surprise and emotion when asked that question, I called the Tree of Life being our leader. Bartosz, I am the oldest tree being you have spoken with, but my knowledge, compared to what you wish to share, is also incomplete. I think in terms of duties, the being of the Tree of Life is not the natural superior of all tree beings. However, he deserves full respect, and I believe calling him a representative leader would be appropriate.

*A moment later.*

Old Beech: However, as you have rightly noticed, our natural leader is another being. Here on Earth, we have our leader, whom not all tree beings are aware of. I, too, have only a vague understanding of him, but I know such a being exists. He is the planetary leader and answers to his counterpart in the Animistic Realm.

Tobiasz: We received the term "tree beings" from you, but we have also encountered terms like "tree elves," "dryads," and "tree spirits." How would you comment on these different terms?

Old Beech: I am convinced that the term "dryads" refers to us. I feel less connected to the term "tree elves," but I think it is acceptable to call us that. However, humanity should refrain from using the term "tree spirits", as we are not incarnate beings within the trees, but rather, we have a very strong connection with them. Spirits are earthly humans, and that term should only refer to their essence. I really like the term "tree beings," and from my point of view, I wish to be called that, though I cannot speak for all members of my species.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, friend, for this clarification. We think the topic of tree beings is now complete...

Old Beech: I am glad I could clarify certain issues. I see the knowledge you have, and truly, you already know a great deal about many species. I wish for the world to accept your books and use them as a foundation for further research and greater knowledge. May God's love support these processes and guide those who, like you, will come closer to the nature beings. I believe that in the new world to come, humans and nature beings will live in respect and symbiosis.

## 2.4. Forest Elves

*In our next conversation, we decided to talk to the Forest Guardian about forest elves.*

Tobiasz: Hello, Guardian! Tell us something about the forest elves.

Forest Guardian: Hello! First of all, forest elves should be distinguished from the beings you call tree beings. Although elves are born in trees, their role is somewhat different from that of the tree



beings. Tree beings provide internal care for the trees, while forest elves also care for the trees, but their activity is more external.

Tobiasz: In our first book, one of the tree beings told us that forest elves carry out their tasks through their specific radiation. What can you say about this, and what would you add to this topic?

Forest Guardian: Yes, their radiation has a very positive effect on the trees. They can connect in many ways with the radiation of the tree, as well as with the tree itself, strengthening and even healing it.

Tobiasz: Can you list the ways you're referring to?

Forest Guardian: Elves generally don't have specific instructions on what to do; their actions are usually intuitive. For example, their dance around a tree increases their radiation and connects them with the tree. In this beautiful way, they can serve the forest and the trees. There are also other ways, and there is one I'd like to mention. The forest elves from the forest you visit saw you hugging the trees and started practicing this themselves. They didn't do this before, so you could say that elves can also learn from humans.

Bartosz: I've heard about this before, and thank you for mentioning it...

Tobiasz: I'm very positively surprised and touched...

Bartosz: Can you tell us about the different species of elves? I assume they vary from one another.

Forest Guardian: Of course, there are many species of elves. They primarily differ in size. The elves you know from my forest are relatively small and are very friendly toward humans. They are very open to contact, so it doesn't surprise me that one of them once contacted you, Bartosz. I'd like you to share that story here as well.

Tobiasz: Please, Bartosz!

Bartosz: It's a bit personal and private, but I can share something about it. The first time I made contact with a forest elf was in 2017. While in the forest, I was surprised to notice someone standing behind me. The elf also realized that I could see and sense him, and if I remember correctly, he started bringing me little gifts from the forest. The elf also sang me a song, and we became friends. I even remember him leaving the forest and visiting me at home. I recall his words about the rooms in my house. He said, "There's so little space here."

*After a moment, Bartosz continued..*

Bartosz: One evening, he was in my house and asked, "Can I sleep in your bed?" I don't remember if he actually slept; I perceived him more intuitively because I didn't have open clairvoyance. Then, one evening, the Forest Guardian suddenly appeared in my room and said, "Elves belong in the forest". At that moment, about five or six elves jumped out from under my bed, whose presence I hadn't been aware of. It turned out that the elves were curious about my relationship with their friend and had been secretly watching us. The Forest Guardian, with great love, took the elves with him and led them back to the forest. I didn't perceive any reproach from him, only love, which he extended to all the elves. I should also mention that the guardian at that time was your predecessor. After some time, he went to serve on higher levels, and you were assigned to take care of our forest. And that's how we met, dear guardian!

Forest Guardian: I think you could also share, at some point, what led to my predecessor's promotion.

Bartosz: I'll consider it, and maybe I'll mention it later in the book, but today's topic is different.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to add about the forest elves?

Forest Guardian: It is desired that the elves present their songs to you, and that you include them in this book. I would also like to add that I have a special fondness and love for the elves. Their childlike and intuitive service is a great inspiration to me, and I am very happy that I can nurture their development and support them on their path. Elves are some of my favorite charges. Of course, as part of my care for the forest, I also look after other species of beings, which I will mention later, but the elves you know are my favorites.

Bartosz: Lastly, I'd like to add something... After 2017, my contact with the beings faded somewhat. As I was told, it was beneficial for my development to close the connection for a time. I needed to focus on other topics important for my growth. However, I never forgot about the elves and other forest beings, and I often mentioned them in my poems. I'd like to take this opportunity to share one here:

*Friend elf*

*I remember well the forest paths  
where I wanted to walk with you  
you were an elf, I a man  
yet you became a brother to me*

*I saw you often, I recall  
pointed ears and long hair  
we shared a language in the woods  
the pulse of nature flowed through you*

*you cared for trees like an angel  
your tasks so grateful,  
and trees with wounds or illness  
you held close with your heart, so beautifully*

*and now that I don't see you  
I miss you, little one  
sometimes I only hear you  
between thoughts and musings*

*I remember well when, side by side  
we walked together in the forest  
I know I'll see you again someday  
you'll be an elf, I a man*

## 2.5. Songs of the Forest Elves

*Later that same day, the Forest Guardian appeared with the elf mentioned earlier.*

Bartosz: Hello, friend! It's good to hear you!

Elf: Hello! I'm sure you'll like my songs...

Tobiasz: Yes, we were going to ask you to sing some songs... You can start!

Elf:

*I give what is good, I give  
I give what is right, I give  
I give what is wise, I give  
I give what is usual, I give*

Tobiasz: Thank you, I think we know this beautiful, simple song... Would you like to sing something else?

Elf:

*The Lord is everything to me, my Guide so bright  
Man is like a brother in my sight  
I love him, even when he goes astray  
I know the world will shine again one day*

Bartosz: Beautiful! I have a question: were you improvising?

Elf: Yes, this song came to me automatically, and I'm proud that you appreciate it. Can I sing something else?

Bartosz: Of course!

Elf:

*The world is like a rose, like a bloom  
At times it crawls from shadows, out of gloom  
And though so many years have passed away  
I love it softly, simply, day by day*

Bartosz: Wonderful! Do you often sing intuitive songs?

Elf: Yes, it comes naturally, like when I dance.

Tobiasz: Do you play any instruments?

Elf: I don't, but my fellow elves play flutes...

*The Forest Guardian then interjected.*

Forest Guardian: I think that's enough. Our friend has shared the beauty that flows from him. If you wish, I can now describe what the elves you know look like.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, Guardian, for bringing the elf, and thank you, elf, for the beautiful songs!

Elf: I'm satisfied. Thank you!

## 2.6. The Appearance of Forest Elves

*We continued our conversation.*

Bartosz: Guardian, please begin!

Forest Guardian: There are many species of elves, which differ mainly in height. They also wear different clothes and have specific personalities. There are some elves who are less friendly toward humans, but the ones you know love people.

Tobiasz: Do the less friendly elves think badly of humans?

Forest Guardian: They see human flaws and, because of that, trust them less... But personally, I believe that if humans change and become more nature-friendly, those elves will also become closer to them.

Tobiasz: Alright, guardian, let's get back to the appearance of the forest elves.

Forest Guardian: First of all, elves have long, pointed ears, which are characteristic of their species. Their skin is pale.

*The elf, who was given a mirror, interrupted.*

Elf: The color of my skin is pale pink. I have very large, blue eyes. My clothes are green, decorated with leaves. I wear pointed shoes, a bit rounded at the end, in dark red.

Tobiasz: And what about your nose and hair?

Elf: My nose is similar to a human's, but a little more mischievous. My hair is black and quite long, falling below my shoulders. But there are also elves with shorter hair and in other colors. My face looks very youthful and cheerful. I feel like I am part of the forest, and my appearance reflects that.

Bartosz: Is this your permanent appearance, or can you change it?

Elf: I could change it, but I'm so used to this look that I never do.

Forest Guardian: Of course, there are many species of elves that differ in appearance, but their distinguishing feature is their long, pointed ears. This is what our little friend looks like, but consider it only a general image.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you! It was very nice spending this time with you!

Forest Guardian: Then, until our next conversation!

## 2.7. Forest Care and the Seasons

*Two days later, we spoke with the Forest Guardian again.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Hello, Guardian! Today we want to talk about the different types of care depending on the season.

Forest Guardian: Hello! Each season in the forest requires a different kind of care, which is why there are many guardians who are active only during specific seasons and times.

Bartosz: I understand that spring is a time of growth... Can you tell us more about that?

Forest Guardian: Yes, during this season, the growth guardians are the most active. They ensure that, after the winter pause and rest, growth proceeds properly. During this time, they are very active, and their role is invaluable. They have their ways of accelerating the growth of trees and plants. However, it is not desired to discuss that here. The forest has its secrets that we do not wish to reveal.

Bartosz: What happens in the summer, then?

Forest Guardian: Many guardians are active during the summer, such as the leaf guardians and root gnomes, who are also active during this time of the year. But I'd like to highlight the seed guardians, whose role begins in the summer. If we're dealing with orchards or fruit trees, the fruit guardians also become active, ensuring the proper ripening of each fruit.

Bartosz: What does the root gnome you mentioned do?

Forest Guardian: Root gnomes are a type of earth gnome that take care of tree roots. There are many subspecies of them, of course. They ensure proper root development and can even speed up root growth. They also support all processes in the roots, such as drawing water from the soil up to the higher parts of the tree.

Tobiasz: And in the autumn?

Forest Guardian: In autumn, the forest slowly falls asleep. Deciduous trees shed their leaves. These processes are also supported by specific guardians. For example, the process of leaves falling is assisted by guardians who help detach the leaves. Of course, the wind helps a lot, but there are beings that support this process.

Tobiasz: What happens in the winter then?

Forest Guardian: In winter, the entire forest sleeps, and beings such as elves, tree beings, and individual guardians also sleep or simply rest. All these beings have earned this rest, and it is desired by the Light that they prepare for the next season in this way.

Tobiasz: Do all these beings subject to you?

Forest Guardian: Yes, everything that happens in the forest happens under my care. However, if I were their sole guardian, I wouldn't be able to oversee everything, which is why the smaller guardians I've mentioned also have their sectoral guardians, who guide them on where and how to act.

Bartosz: Would you like to add anything?

Forest Guardian: Based on the insights I've shared today, you can imagine the vast number of beings under my care and how many beings take care of the forest. I am grateful to God for ensuring that all forests are looked after in this way, so that every tree and every being can feel they are under protection.

## 2.8. The Law of Growth

Bartosz: Today I wanted to ask about growth, which is so rapidly awakened in the spring... Can you tell us more about this?

Forest Guardian: Yes. The proper growth is overseen by the growth guardians. Their actions are governed by the law of growth.

Bartosz: The law of growth?

Forest Guardian: The law of growth depends on the specific area and the species, for example, of trees. Based on this regulation, the beings provide care to ensure that growth aligns with these rules. The beings can stimulate growth, accelerating it, but when growth nears its seasonal peak, they have the right — and indeed, the obligation — to slow it down. The law of growth for a given area and species is regulated by higher guardians, who often work in cooperation with their counterparts from neighbouring areas. They listen to the will of even higher guardians, who act under the influence of God's Will. From this brief insight, the reader can conclude that the growth of plants, trees, and shrubs is a process that is desired and regulated by the Light.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else that should be conveyed on this topic?

Forest Guardian: The reader should be aware that God cares for the forests. He does so through specific beings and guardians. The processes occurring in the forest are not arbitrary but function under the influence of God's will. Nothing in nature is left to its own devices; everything is driven and regulated by the Will of our Creator.

## 2.9. The Influence of the Forest on Humans and Conclusion

*In the next conversation, we decided to summarize everything that had been shared with us about the forest.*

Tobiasz: Hello, Guardian! Today, we want to conclude our messages regarding the forest...

Forest Guardian: Hello! What I have conveyed to you in these few conversations is truly a foundation for future generations and for future seekers of truth — the truth about the forest and the nature beings that support it.

Tobiasz: I think it's also worth mentioning the beneficial effects the forest has on humans as a final note...

Forest Guardian: The forest has a very positive effect on all beings who spend time in it. It calms and soothes the nerves of the modern person, who is often stressed. There are also many benefits from walking in the forest, though I wouldn't want to speak about all of them, as I understand that numerous publications have already covered this topic. Know that the forest has a very good impact on our health, and I'd like to leave it at that.

Bartosz: I think we're approaching the conclusion of our conversations. What would you like to say in closing?

Forest Guardian: As I mentioned before, the messages you have recorded are a foundation for more detailed descriptions in the future. I also wanted to point out that the Light gives people the knowledge they are ready for. There are many secrets of the forest that I did not want to share here, and that you, Bartosz and Tobiasz, also know. Let this be a reward for your work. I believe that one day the time will come when the Light will allow these secrets of the forest, which you didn't write about here, to be revealed.

Tobiasz: Guardian, is there anything else you'd like to add?

Forest Guardian: This is my final message, and I am deeply convinced that I have fulfilled my task and provided humans with the knowledge about the forest that the Light desired. I am glad that it was

God's Will to allow this, and I am happy for every person who, through these messages, will gain at least a little understanding of nature and the processes within it. May the Light guide you, humans, to pure contact with nature and to friendship with us, the nature beings. Thank you!

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you, Forest Guardian! Be blessed!

## 3. Flower Beings

### 3.1. Preliminary Information

*We made contact with the caretaker of flower blossoms, who serves in the area around our home.*

Bartosz: Welcome! Who are you? Tell us something about yourself...

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Hello! I am a caretaker of flower blossoms. The sector I oversee, caring for the flowers and the flower beings, includes the area where your home is located.

Tobiasz: Do you only take care of the flower beings outside, or also the flowers in homes?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Thank you for the question, Tobiasz! I take care of both uncut flowers and cut ones. And to answer your next question in advance... Flower beings can also be present in cut flowers, and I take care of them as well. This includes the flowers in your home.

Bartosz: What will we be discussing in this book?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I will speak about what the Light desires. To begin, I will tell you a little about myself, and later I will also talk about the flower beings. I also have a special message for humanity regarding the cutting of flowers. This message is personally the most important to me, and I will present it at the end.

Tobiasz: Thank you, and we look forward to our conversations with you!

### 3.2. The Flower Blossom Caretaker Speaks about Herself

*We continued our conversation with the Flower Blossom Caretaker.*

Bartosz: We would like you to tell us something about yourself... How long have you been serving here? How large is the area you oversee?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Many years ago, before you were born, I was assigned to this sector where I now serve. Previously, there was another flower blossom caretaker here, who went on to serve elsewhere, though I don't know the details. The area I oversee includes several houses and plots of land surrounding yours.

Tobiasz: What does your service involve?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I typically watch over all the flower beings and flowers, ensuring that their development — meaning their blooming and the maturation of the flower beings — proceeds properly. My presence makes the flower ladies and flower fairies feel cared for and safe. I often tell them what is appropriate and beneficial for their development at any given moment. There are countless examples, but I think presenting them all here wouldn't be suitable.

Bartosz: Do you have superiors, or do you act intuitively?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I usually act intuitively and according to the moment. But of course, I also have superiors, or rather, one superior, who not only helps me serve and gives me guidance on how to support the beings and flowers, but also cares for my own personal development, as I, too, continue to grow.



Bartosz: Do you identify more as a nature being, or as a caretaker of nature beings?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I am a caretaker of nature beings, but I feel so connected to nature that I think calling me a nature being is also fitting.

Bartosz: Is it true that you are sometimes referred to as princesses?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Due to our appearance, we were often called that, but I prefer the title "flower blossom caretaker" because it better reflects the nature of my work.

Bartosz: Could you describe your appearance to us?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I am the size of an adult human. I wear a long blue gown, decorated with floral patterns.

Tobiasz: Do you wear shoes?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I could, but I personally choose not to.

Tobiasz: What is the color of your skin?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: It's similar to that of a person of the white race, though with a more pinkish hue.

Bartosz: And your face and hair?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: My face resembles that of a smiling earthly woman, around 25 to 30 years old. I smile almost constantly. My hair is blonde, long, and falls below my shoulders. On my head, I wear a small crown, which adds nobility and grace to my appearance. As for my attire, I also wear a veil, which, like my gown, is decorated with floral patterns. The veil reaches down to my waist. Ancient peoples knew us and often called us princesses because of our crowns. I think that's enough for now. I want to note that in different regions of the world, we might look a little different, but since you wanted to know my appearance, I've shared it with you.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you'd like to add about yourself?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I am very happy that fate has assigned me to the sector that includes your home. I feel that my messages might be something new for many people, but I also feel that it is high time to expand the knowledge that people already have. I also want to add that my service here, including in your sector, is a great pleasure for me, and I'm very happy to be able to care for both the flowers and their beings. I thank God for such a noble task and wish to continue serving Him to the best of my ability.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your beautiful words, and we look forward to continuing our service together.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Thank you. Think joyfully of the flowers and their beings.

### 3.3. Flower Fairies

*A few days later, we continued our conversations.*

Bartosz: Hello! Today, we want to talk about flower fairies, as they are more well-known in the world...

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Hello! There are many species of flower fairies, and each flower has its own specific species. They are incredibly beautiful, and knowledge of them has survived to this day. Even in modern times, when humans are generally distant from the Light, some people still see these wonderful beings.

Bartosz: Are flower fairies born in flowers?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, they descend into this Material Realm, which is still part of the earthly levels, and are born in flowers. However, not every flower hosts the birth of a flower fairy. Flower fairies are born in about 10 to 30% of flowers.

Tobiasz: Are they also referred to as flower elves?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Flower fairies have similar functions and tasks as forest elves, so calling them elves is also appropriate. Their ears are also elf-like, but flower fairies are always female, while forest elves are male.

Bartosz: Are flower fairies closely connected to their flowers? Can they be outside of them?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Like forest elves, flower fairies provide external support to flowers. They awaken in the flowers and then continue to support flowers of the same species. Thanks to their wings, they can fly to flowers of the same species, even those that are far away.

Tobiasz: How do they support the flowers?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Flower fairies have special wands filled with a specially prepared essence. This essence corresponds to the flower species and helps in the blooming process. Throughout the blooming process, the fairy can use the essence to support the flower, almost as if sprinkling it with something.

Tobiasz: Surely, their very radiance supports the blooming of flowers, doesn't it?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, this is connected to their bond with the flower species. Their gentle singing also has a very beneficial effect on the flowers.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you'd like to add on this topic?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Fairies can also dance, and by doing so, they intuitively support the flowers. Through their dance, they emit additional, stronger radiation that envelops the flower. Flower fairies are truly wonderful servants of the Creator. Thanks to them, flowers develop better and can maintain their mature form much longer.

Bartosz: How many flowers does one fairy take care of?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: That depends on her maturity and willingness. Fairies support each other, and sometimes multiple fairies will care for the same flowers. I think one fairy can take care of five to ten flowers, but this is only an estimate and mainly applies to smaller flowers. Each flower species has different fairies, and the number of flowers they care for may vary.

Tobiasz: Could you summarize?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Flower fairies are a wonderful gift given to all flowers, and it is desired by the Light that flowers have this kind of support. One could say that without their help, flowers wouldn't be as beautiful, and all of Creation would lose something significant as a result.

### 3.4. Flower Ladies

Tobiasz: Let's now discuss the flower ladies.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: There is already some knowledge in the world about flower fairies, but there is practically no information about flower ladies. They are to flowers what tree beings are to trees. It is desired that every flower has a flower lady. They are very closely connected to the flowers and spend almost all their time within them.

Bartosz: I was allowed to use the term "flower lady", though perhaps one day, someone will find a better term to describe them.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I think "flower ladies" is an appropriate term for them.

Tobiasz: Do all flowers have flower ladies?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: It sometimes happens that flowers destined to be cut do not have flower ladies inside them. You can recognize this because such flowers have a less intense fragrance.

Bartosz: I understand that flower ladies descend into this dense matter seasonally, similar to how flower fairies do?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, as long as the flowers are alive, the flower ladies and fairies remain here. You understand correctly — some flower ladies descend for only a few days. They come down from the subtle material levels for the purpose of development. A single flower lady needs to descend into this dense matter hundreds or even thousands of times to reach full maturity. Then, both flower fairies and flower ladies enter the Animistic Realm, where their paradise is.

Tobiasz: How do they influence the flowers?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Of course, their mere presence and radiation have a very beneficial effect on the flower's development. However, what is characteristic and unique about them is that they emit the scent of the flower they inhabit. A flower without a flower lady does not have as intense a fragrance as one with a flower lady inside.

Bartosz: Are flower ladies aware, for example, when they enter an area where grass is being mowed?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes. Many flower ladies take the risk of entering areas where they may be destroyed. Taking such risks intensifies their desire for growth and development.

Bartosz: Do flower ladies suffer when flowers are destroyed?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: During the natural departure from a flower, meaning when the flower dies, flower ladies do not suffer at all. That's why it's not called "dying" but simply "departing". However, when a flower is destroyed, the flower ladies, who are deeply connected to it, do suffer. That's why I appeal to people not to destroy flowers thoughtlessly.

Tobiasz: Do they remember their previous descents?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: The more mature ones have a general sense of how long they have been experiencing, but it's not necessary. You could say they intuitively feel that this is not their first contact with a dense-material flower.

Tobiasz: Do they, like the fairies, sing and dance?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, of course. Flower ladies are very joyful beings, and both singing and dancing are expressions of that happiness. Naturally, this has a very beneficial effect on the flowers they inhabit.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you would like to add about the flower ladies?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: For many, the knowledge about flower ladies may be new, but the Light has deemed it necessary that I speak about them. I am grateful that I can care for such wonderful beings as the flower ladies. The Creator cares for the beauty of all Creation, and the flower ladies, who ennoble and beautify the flowers, are a wonderful testament to this.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

### 3.5. More about Flower Ladies

*A few days later, we continued our conversation.*

Bartosz: Hello, caretaker! Since the topic of flower ladies is quite new and I haven't encountered it in any publication, I want to ask a few more questions...

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Hello! Yes, I'm ready and listening.

Bartosz: I've met people who claim to talk to flowers. I understand that calling flowers the incarnations of flower ladies is incorrect, similar to how tree beings aren't directly trees. So, are people who claim to speak with flowers actually speaking with flower ladies?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, it's quite common for people to say they talk to flowers. This usually happens because they don't see the beings that are flower ladies but only hear them. Flower Ladies, like tree beings, often identify with the flower they inhabit. However, their knowledge isn't always fully accurate.

Bartosz: So why is there practically no knowledge about flower ladies in the world? After all, there is a lot of information about fairies, who live nearby.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: The lack of knowledge about flower ladies stems from the fact that they operate and live similarly to flower fairies in subtle dense-material levels, but on even more delicate planes. Observing flower ladies requires a more subtle vision than that needed to see fairies.

Bartosz: I must admit, the realization that almost every flower hosts a small being, a flower lady, was quite a surprising discovery for me. You could say that I'm now more careful not to step on a little daisy growing on the lawn.

Tobiasz: I feel the same way...

Bartosz: Why has the Light allowed this knowledge to be revealed now?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: That's an excellent question. The Light sees how poorly humans often treat flowers, cutting or destroying them thoughtlessly. The awareness that beings live within flowers should help change this undesirable habit. Humanity stands on the threshold of entering the New Earth. This knowledge is mainly intended for those people who will build the New Earth. People, respect flowers, for the beauty they give you is an invaluable gift from our Lord!

Bartosz: Thank you for that answer! I have one more question... Do the flower ladies of cut flowers, which people place in vases, suffer because they have to leave earlier?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Many flower ladies are actually quite pleased to ennoble a home. They usually depart a bit earlier than the ladies in uncut flowers, and while this involves some suffering, it is very small compared to the pain of those ladies who must leave suddenly due to the abrupt destruction of a flower.

Tobiasz: This brief conversation has given us a lot... Do you feel there's anything else to add?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: It is greatly desired that the knowledge of flower ladies be finally revealed. We know that not all destruction of flowers by humans can be avoided. Flower ladies themselves often take risks and descend into areas that are not safe for their existence. However, I believe that many sensitive people will understand that unnecessary destruction of flowers should be avoided. You, humans, are surrounded by the beauty of nature, which manifests also in flowers. Do not destroy this beauty senselessly.

### 3.6. The Appearance of Flower Fairies

*In the evening of the same day, we decided to ask the flower blossom caretaker about the appearance of flower fairies.*

Tobiasz: Hello again! We'd now like to talk about the appearance of flower fairies.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, I'm ready for this topic...

Bartosz: Please, go ahead.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: There is a character in the film "Peter Pan" who somewhat resembles the appearance of flower fairies. That character is, of course, Tinker Bell. However, flower fairies are not dressed as scantily. They have transparent wings and wands, which we've already discussed. They fly up to a flower and, with a touch of their wand, bestow it with the essence beneficial for its maturation.

Tobiasz: What are they dressed in, and what color is their skin?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: There are many species of flower fairies. Their dresses are usually shiny and glittering, reflecting the color and character of the flower they are associated with. Their skin is generally pale pink, and their hair is medium-length, depending on their preference. Their height, which varies depending on the size of the flower, is adjusted to allow them to emit beneficial radiation on the flower. Their dresses usually fall below the knees. Flower fairies do not wear any shoes.

Bartosz: Describe their face for us.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: The most distinctive feature of their face is their elf-like ears, which is why, as I mentioned, they can also be called flower elves. They have large, beautiful eyes, and their faces resemble that of a woman around twenty-five years old, though that's not always the case. Their lips are pink, and their eyebrows match the color of their hair, which varies depending on the species. Their noses resemble a typical human woman's nose.

*A moment later.*

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I hope that one of the future readers will be able to see and perhaps describe or even paint a flower fairy better.

### 3.7. The Appearance of Flower Ladies

*We immediately moved on to describing the appearance of flower ladies.*

Bartosz: Could you now describe the appearance of flower ladies for us?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Flower ladies have a more noble appearance than flower fairies. This nobility places them slightly higher in the levels of subtle materiality, and their form is also more delicate. Their height is adjusted to the size of the flower. They are similar in size to flower fairies, but they remain inside the flower almost continuously. Their dresses are longer than those of the fairies and reflect the color and character of the specific flower. They don't wear shoes.

Bartosz: Do they also have elf-like ears?

Tobiasz: And wings?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Their ears resemble human ears more closely, and since they stay inside the flower all the time, they do not have wings like the fairies do.

Bartosz: What about their skin color?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: They come in various shades, though it is usually a pale pink. However, I see only a small number of the many species of flower ladies in my daily work.

Tobiasz: Let's talk about their face.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: The face of a flower lady resembles that of a noble lady, who is usually smiling. Their eyes express the beauty and depth of their inner being. They are incredibly beautiful when they smile, and the wave of bliss that sometimes touches them makes their inner beauty radiate outward. Their nose is typically human, and their eyebrows subtly highlight their delicate beauty. Their hair is of various colors, usually styled elegantly and often adorned with a veil.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to add?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: The descriptions of both fairies and ladies are somewhat general and may vary across the many species. The most important thing is that both flower fairies and flower ladies are incredibly beautiful, and their beauty complements the beauty of the flowers they inhabit.

### 3.8. Apprentices

*The next day, a new topic arose for our discussions.*

Bartosz: Hello, Caretaker! You mentioned you had a new topic to discuss. Please, go ahead...

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Hello! There is something that readers of your books may suspect, but it hasn't been widely discussed. Every caretaker of nature beings, if they so wish, can have apprentices who want to train to become future caretakers.

Bartosz: Do you, dear caretaker, have any apprentices?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, I have three apprentices. They assist me in my service and are preparing to become flower blossom caretakers in the future. I love them dearly and want to teach them.

Bartosz: I feel like they probably look like little girls or young girls.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, they resemble human children, but they are not spirits; they belong to the animistic species, just like me. Every caretaker, before beginning their full service, was once an apprentice. It is desired that people know this as part of expanding their understanding.

Tobiasz: Does any of your apprentices wish to speak in this book?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Yes, please, Anna, go ahead and speak...

Apprentice Anna: Hello. I am delighted to be learning how to become a flower blossom caretaker in the future. I love all flowers and all the beings connected with them. I am grateful that our caretaker, who serves in the sector around your home, prepares us for future service with such patience and dedication. I look forward to the day when I, like her, can serve all the flowers and their associated beings. I thank the Creator for guiding us, and I am grateful for my existence and my role in Creation.

Tobiasz: Thank you for your words, and we wish you blessed growth! Caretaker, would you like to add anything on this topic?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: My apprentices learn very quickly. Currently, they take the form of children, and like earthly humans, they grow as they mature. I care for them deeply because I was once like them. It's not yet time to discuss where caretakers come from and how they begin their existence, but I can say that we, too, start as sparks, as animistic germ, and we descend into the lower levels of Creation. That should suffice for now.

Bartosz: Thank you for sharing this knowledge!

### 3.9. The Role and Influence of Flowers

*After a short break on the same day, we continued our conversation.*

Tobiasz: Dear Caretaker, what is the role of flowers in Creation?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I have a personal perspective on this topic, and I'd like to share it.

*A moment later.*

Flower Blossom Caretaker: In my opinion, the role of flowers is very similar to the role of femininity, which is why flower beings are female beings. The Creator gave flowers to all the worlds where nature develops in order to beautify and ennoble them. Women, more than men, tend to notice and appreciate this role. Let us be grateful that the Creator thought of the beauty of all Creation, and that we can enjoy this beauty by admiring and sensing flowers.

Bartosz: How do flowers affect humans?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Flowers have a very beneficial effect on both humans and other beings experiencing Creation. People who are more inwardly open, who feel the scent of flowers and notice their beauty, feel as if they are transported to an enchanted land full of trust in the Light, full of childlike wonder, love, and beauty. In today's world, flowers influence not only women but are also

increasingly awakening the inner selves of men. Flowers also have a therapeutic influence and can improve health, and I believe, in many cases, even heal various ailments. The influence of flowers is a beautiful gift, and I believe that the humanity of the New Earth will fully appreciate this. Today, it's recognized by individuals, but I believe the time will come when all of humanity will be aware of it.

Bartosz: Thank you, dear caretaker, for your beautiful words. I also believe that humanity will increasingly recognize the beneficial influence of flowers.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I want to add something else... Flowers are a great gift from the Light. I believe that an increasing part of humanity will stop treating flowers as mere objects, as has been the case, and will recognize their role and influence on all of Creation.

Tobiasz: Thank you!

### 3.10. Message for Humanity

Bartosz: At the beginning of our conversations, you mentioned a message for humanity regarding flowers. Are you ready to share it now?

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I am ready.

Tobiasz: Please, begin.

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Until now, humans have not treated flowers with the necessary respect and reverence. Dear people, you must realize that flowers are a gift from the Light, and it is desired that you treat them as such. From the moment humans arrived on Earth, the Light allowed the cutting of flowers to beautify homes and temples. However, the Light has never permitted the mindless destruction of flowers without any justified reason. This book provides knowledge about flower ladies and flower fairies. Some of them deeply desire to experience life close to humans, for example, in the flowers you place in vases. However, not all of them wish for this, and that's why I urge you to more consciously determine the purpose of the flowers you cut. This way, you will allow these beings to experience life according to their will and desire. We understand that while caring for gardens, you often cut or destroy flowers during mowing or other activities. The Light does not want to forbid you from doing this. But I urge you to do it thoughtfully, and quickly determine the purpose for the blossoms you handle. In many cases, your conscience will guide you as to whether cutting certain flowers is appropriate. Be mindful and never destroy flowers thoughtlessly. You can also ask for the Light's permission before cutting, and it may be granted to you, but keep in mind that this won't always be the case. Your conscience and sensitivity will reveal the truth in this matter. The Will of the Light is that you consider this message during your time on Earth.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you!

Flower Blossom Caretaker: I feel I have fulfilled my task.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: We are glad! Be blessed!

Flower Blossom Caretaker: Thank you. These are my final words in your book. I have given you knowledge about flowers and the beings of flowers, whom I love dearly. Use this knowledge responsibly and with great care, and build your connection with flowers and their beings thoughtfully.



## 4. Animal Caretakers

### 4.1. Preliminary Information

*We have opened ourselves to learn about Animal Caretakers. A being appeared.*

Bartosz: Greetings, Being! Who are you and what can we talk to you about?

Being: We are a group of entities responsible for caring for animals. We take care of them and want humanity to know about us. Unfortunately, there is little knowledge in the world about us, and we want to change that, at least partially. We won't discuss details such as our appearance because there are many different types of us, and what we provide will be general knowledge.

Bartosz: We've read about so-called animal guidance and know that specific beings like centaurs, fauns, and entities we've already spoken about, like fylgens and mermaids, are involved...

Animal Caretaker: Yes, those beings primarily guide groups or herds of wild animals. However, apart from these so-called guides, every animal has its own individual caretaker because every animal is truly a soul experiencing life and deserves love and care from the Light. We, the caretakers, are a reflection of God's love for all animals.

Bartosz: In reality, does every animal have its own individual caretaker, or are there exceptions?

Animal Caretaker: Yes, all animals, except for insects... Insects have group caretakers, and this type of care is sufficient for them.

Tobiasz: Maybe let's not go into details at this stage... Tell us, why do you want to talk about yourselves?

Animal Caretaker: Thank you for that question. First and foremost, we want to show the world that the Creator loves all animals, and we, animal caretakers, are an expression of that love. Humans very often treat animals as objects and don't think about the fact that animals have souls. Humanity is responsible for a significant portion of the suffering animals experience today. We, the animal caretakers, want to draw attention to this and appeal for change.

Bartosz: Is there anything else you'd like to add as an introduction?

Animal Caretaker: Humans often do not realize how much love God bestows on all of His Creations throughout the Universe. Every animal is worthy of the love that God gives them. Animals perfectly fulfill their roles depending on their species and have every right to develop in the World of Matter. However, on the path of animal development stands humanity, which does not respect animals and does not see them as their smaller brothers. We, the animal caretakers, deeply regret this fact, and our main message is directed at contemporary humanity to change and to understand that all animals are truly their smaller, unconscious brothers.

### 4.2. The Love of Caretakers for Their Charges

*After a short break, we continued the conversation.*

Bartosz: To expand the discussion, I want to ask something. What truly drives and guides you?

Animal Caretaker: God has bestowed upon us great love. It is a love for our charges, the animals we care for. Each of us looks after the animal we are responsible for as if it were our greatest treasure. There is unique dedication and service to the Light in this. We want the animals to develop, and our presence helps them in that process.

Bartosz: Do animals feel your love and support?

Animal Caretaker: Yes, animals feel our love and that we support them. We expect very little in return. When an animal is happy and enjoys its existence, that is reward enough for us for the love we give.

Tobiasz: Do you suffer when the animal suffers?

Animal Caretaker: That depends on the sensitivity of the individual caretaker. We do not want our charges to suffer, but we know what life is like and we also understand that suffering is often necessary for development. It is not only among humans that such experiences have a deeper meaning, but also in the growth of every animal — suffering is a part of their life.

Bartosz: Can you reveal what animal you care for?

Animal Caretaker: There is a pond near your house, and I care for one of the fish there. I am a caretaker of fish.

Bartosz: How much do you love your charge, and can you express it in some way?

Animal Caretaker: I love looking into the eyes of my charge. It is said that the eyes of a fish do not express emotions, but I see much more than humans do. I internally feel the needs of my charge and am very content when I sense its happiness. I love it deeply and do not want to let it down because I know that I am its only support.

### 4.3. Further Information about Animal Caretakers

*We continued our conversation.*

Tobiasz: What does your service as Caretaker entail?

Animal Caretaker: Primarily, my closeness and presence have a significant impact on how my charge feels. I also have numerous tools I can use to interact with my charge to support its further development. However, it is not the right time to discuss those details. The mere awareness that we exist and support animals is already a significant step in understanding nature. It's not the time to delve into specifics.

Tobiasz: Do animals know of your existence, and can they see you?

Animal Caretaker: They see us only when it is necessary. We can reveal ourselves to them, for example, to warn them of something, but this doesn't happen often. I am convinced that my charge is aware of my presence and my support. I know it feels a kind of longing when I'm not near. That's how I sense this matter, dear Tobiasz.

Bartosz: Do you, animal caretakers, also have superiors?

Animal Caretaker: Thank you for that question. Yes, we have superiors, and they, in turn, have even higher superiors. Our higher guidance reaches up to the Animistic Realm. There, the plans for specific

species on Earth are anchored in God's Will. As you probably know, many species have appeared and then disappeared on Earth. Such processes are regulated by God's Will, and in the entire history of our planet, there have been no accidents in this regard. We, the caretakers, must also adapt to this Will. Based on what I have said, you can form an image of us, the animal caretakers. This image shows that we are guided by both love and God's Will.

Bartosz: Do you have any information about how long certain animal species will remain on Earth?

Animal Caretaker: I don't have advanced knowledge on this topic. But I suspect many things. It is not desired for me to speak about it in detail, but there are certain plans concerning many animal species.

Bartosz: I understand that the extinction of many animal species due to human activity is not desired by the Light.

Animal Caretaker: As you can probably guess, the Light takes into account human activity on Earth and its impact on the extinction of species. However, it is not God's Will for this to happen. God wants joyful coexistence between humans and animals on this planet. Humans should not only consider this but must adapt to God's Will, as the increasing Pressure of the Light on our planet demands it.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to add?

Animal Caretaker: The presence of animals on Earth is regulated by God's Will. Each species has its allotted time for development, and usually, that time is utilized. Animals develop properly, but it is humans who have stood in their way of development and begun to treat them as their property. Animals do not belong to humans; they belong to the Light, and only when the Light allows the use of animals for human purposes, may humans do so. Let humans remember this.

#### 4.4. The Treatment of Animals by Humans

*The next day, we continued our conversations with the Animal Caretaker.*

Bartosz: Hello, Caretaker! There are many videos on the internet showing how terribly, or rather, how brutally, animals raised for meat are treated. Could you comment on this?

Animal Caretaker: This is not a joyful message, but it is necessary. We, the animal caretakers, suffer greatly because of how humans treat livestock. The people working in meat production facilities or slaughterhouses are unaware that they are, in fact, taking the lives of living beings that possess souls. Animals are kept in cramped spaces or cages, often filled with their own waste. They spend their entire lives in such conditions, and if they fall ill, they are immediately killed as they no longer promise future profit. The method of slaughtering animals for meat is, in many cases, and in some countries always, unworthy of humanity. Animals witness the slaughter of others, are filled with fear, and, of course, suffer unimaginably. This is a terrible subject for us, and the caretakers who watch over these animals also suffer.

*After a short pause.*

Animal Caretaker: Long ago, the Light permitted humans to consume animal meat. However, humans turned it into a business driven by lust for profit. This greed has blinded humanity to such an extent that they no longer see the truth about animals. That truth is that animals have souls and experience pain, suffering, and fear just like humans do. In the New Earth, or the Promised New Kingdom, there

will be no more consent for such treatment of animals. Human, before you kill an animal and use its meat for food, give it the chance to enjoy life. People are often unaware that the suffering related to an animal's death can be reduced to almost nothing.

*After a break.*

Animal Caretaker: I love all animals, and I would wish for humans to gradually stop consuming their meat. But I feel that this process should be gradual. A sudden elimination of all meat from the diet could be detrimental to many people. Your bodies have been accustomed to eating meat for millennia, and in my view, this cannot be changed overnight.

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Thank you for your words, which have contributed so much.

#### 4.5. The Impact of Caring for Animals on Humans

Bartosz: You brought up the topic of humans caring for animals...

Animal Caretaker: The fact that we take care of animals should not be the only way for them to receive support. Humans should also care for animals, and I know that many people with pure hearts already do this. With this topic, I wanted to highlight how much humans can gain through such care.

Tobiasz: Please, expand on this.

Animal Caretaker: A person who cares for animals gains spiritually. His sensitivity and awareness of the presence of other living beings increases. Such a person learns love and begins to see the beauty of animals' souls. I deeply appreciate people who care for animals because they make our tasks easier.

Tobiasz: Is there anything else you'd like to say?

Animal Caretaker: Animals are sentient beings with beautiful souls. Show them the love they deserve. Hug, pet, and comfort them, and you will see their sincere reaction to your display of closeness. Animals also need love, and every person who loves animals is a noble fruit of this Creation.

#### 4.6. Experiences of Bartosz and Tobiasz

Animal Caretaker: Bartosz, it is desired that you share your experiences with animals.

Tobiasz: I know what experiences you're referring to, and I'm glad they will be included in this book!

Bartosz: The first experience is about our cat "Drako", who passed away some time ago. It was when he was still a small kitten. At the time, he had a toy permanently tied to a chair with a string. One day, he was playing with the toy, and I suddenly heard terrifying yelps. The cries were very alarming. I ran over and saw that "Drako" had gotten so badly tangled in the string that he began to choke. I rushed to help him but couldn't at first because the string was tightly wrapped around his neck. I ran to get scissors and as gently as I could, I cut the string. Drako was initially in shock and jumped away, but after calming down, he came to me, and I felt as if he was thanking me. At that moment, I heard the voice of his caretaker, who thanked me for what I had done. This was my first contact with an animal caretaker.

*After a brief pause.*

Bartosz: The second incident is one I didn't want to share, but I will at the request of the caretaker, as I also feel the Light wants me to share it. One day, I was talking to my father about the stray dogs in our area. He told me about a pair of dogs that were always together and seemed to be good friends. Some time passed after that conversation, and while walking home from work, I came across an incident. A dog was lying on the road, apparently hit by a car. It was a shock to me because I saw that the dog was still alive. I wanted to approach the dog, but there were people around, and at the time, I thought they were the owners. Not wanting to interfere, I walked away. But inside, I felt a strong urge to help. I knew the dog was suffering, and I wanted to alleviate its pain somehow. I decided to try and separate the dog's soul from its dense-material body, but I felt I needed permission from the Light. My guides informed me that there was indeed permission for this process. I performed the separation, and immediately, the dog's soul appeared before me, which I could clearly see. It was incredibly joyful, wagging its tail and jumping towards me. I realized I had spared it much suffering. I then began my usual process of guiding the soul to a level of Creation suited to its maturity. I had done this several times before, so I knew it needed to be done. A few weeks later, in roughly the same spot where the dog's body had been, another dog ran up to me, wagging its tail and jumping on me with joy. I didn't know what to do, and this happy dog accompanied me for much of my walk to the bus stop. It was only later that I realized that this dog was likely aware of the separation and guidance of the other dog's soul. Perhaps they had known each other, and this dog was grateful to me for it. I suspect that these two dogs were the friends my father had mentioned earlier. Dear Caretaker, do you think animals can sense such things?

Animal Caretaker: There are animals that can see souls, and above all, they have a strong sense of perception. These two dogs might not necessarily have been the friends your father spoke of, but the second dog could have sensed that you have a friendly attitude towards animals. Through your noble act, you earned their goodwill. Thank you for sharing this. It is pleasing to God that this account is included in the book. Tobiasz, I feel you may have something to share as well...

Tobiasz: Yes! A few years ago, I was walking in the forest. As usual, I was hugging my friends — the trees. This time, I was walking alone, as I usually go with Bartosz. At one point, an older man passed by, and we started talking. I told him about hugging trees, and he confirmed that he does it too. He said he has a large, old tree near his house — probably an oak, if I remember correctly — and that he often hugs it. I was happy to hear this, as not many people still know how trees can support us. We talked for a while, and he looked at me, confessing something. He said he felt a deep sense of guilt because he had spent much of his life working in a slaughterhouse, killing animals. It was a very sincere and sad confession. I felt a lot of sympathy for him, and I didn't quite know what to think at the time, as I wasn't fully aware of how cruelly animals are treated in those places. I tried to comfort and support him. I only remembered this conversation while writing this chapter of the book. I now understand why that old man felt so much regret when thinking about what he had done for so many years, as it was likely not pleasing to God. I hope that this man will find a way to make amends and that his soul will find peace.

Animal Caretaker: Thank you, Tobiasz. In this case, the guilt and accompanying sense of responsibility point to the truth. That man is now aware that the mistreatment of animals, which he was part of, was against God's will. I'm glad that this man realized this, even if it took him his whole life. I hope that with this recognition, he will permanently change his attitude towards animals and find peace. Thank you, Tobiasz. I believe your account has contributed greatly to our discussions, and serves as an excellent example and testimony to what we are speaking about.

## 4.7. Message to Humanity

Tobiasz: We ask for a message to humanity regarding their relationship with animals.

*A being appeared, appointed for this purpose, introducing himself as a Higher Animal Caretaker.*

Higher Animal Caretaker: Animals and humans live on the same planet, side by side. The Light desires that humans do not look down on animals or treat them as soulless beings, like objects or products. Animals are beautiful beings with souls, experiencing all aspects of life just as humans do. Look into the eyes of animals, and you will see the spark that gives them life. The Light has permitted humans to consume animal meat, but humans abuse this permission, making profit their primary goal. The pursuit of this goal often strips animals of their dignity, making their existence one of constant suffering. There is no consent from the Light for causing senseless suffering to animals. If humanity wishes to enter a new stage of development, it must change, and this change must also include how animals are treated. Strive to ensure that animals are joyful during their lives, and when you choose to kill them for meat, do so in accordance with God's Laws and His Will. Use all your resources to minimize their suffering as much as possible. Be grateful to the animals you use for food, for without them, you would have no meat or other products. Do not disregard the words of this message, for the Light will severely punish all those who continue to cause animals suffering. Take these words to heart and build the New Earth in peace and love, including love for animals.

## 5. Giants

### 5.1. First Contact

*A giant appeared, to whom we proposed the name Mau. He agreed, and we began our discussion.*

Bartosz: Hello, Mau!

Mau: Greetings to you! First of all, I want to point out that we rarely communicate with humans or share any messages about ourselves. Generally, humanity doesn't really deserve the truth about us, but since it is the Will of the Light for us to speak, we will give you a general understanding of who we are.

Tobiasz: Welcome! Please, tell us something as an introduction about yourselves.

Mau: We are loyal to the Creator, and we serve Him. Many ancient peoples knew about us and respected us. We have always been close to those nations that served the Light. Today, there is no such nation on Earth. Most of us reside in the mountains, as that is where our homes are, but we also operate on the lowlands and anywhere else the Light sends us.

Bartosz: What can you share with us?

Mau: I think your questions will shape our discussions. Bartosz, you have a good sense of what to ask and which topics to address. We won't say much about details like our appearance. Let your intuition, Bartosz, and the intuition of Tobiasz guide our conversations.

Tobiasz: Perhaps add something as an introduction.

Mau: The Light has allowed us to give messages. As servants of the Light, we must follow this directive. We want people to know about us and think of us with respect. We hope your messages will help in this. We have been on Earth since its formation, working here, carrying out the Plans and Will of the Light.

### 5.2. The Tasks of Giants

*We continued our conversation with the giant Mau.*

Bartosz: Could you tell us something about the tasks of giants?

Mau: We have many tasks throughout Creation, as well as on Earth. Our crowning achievement, which I want to mention now, are the mountains of the world. We created the mountains through our service, under the direction of the Light.

Bartosz: I understand that what are called orogenic movements are movements that you create?

Mau: Yes, orogenic movements are the result of our activities, as seen by humans.

Bartosz: Are continental drifts and, consequently, their collisions that can form mountains, also your work?

Mau: The continental drift is managed by powerful beings who, due to their size, can also be called giants. We often collaborate with these beings and share common goals. Our primary goal is to transform the planet into the image desired by the Light.

Tobiasz: And earthquakes and volcanic eruptions?

Mau: Yes. All major changes that occur on Earth are either carried out by us or supported by us. Many of these processes are done together with our brothers, the Cyclopes. We have divisions of responsibilities, which are assigned by higher guides. I don't want to go into too much detail, as these divisions may vary in different regions of the world. I focus mainly on my own duties, which I carry out diligently.

Bartosz: And where are you currently performing your tasks and serving?

Mau: I have been associated with the mountains, specifically the Tatra Mountains, for a very long time. There, I perform the tasks assigned to me by higher guardians.

Bartosz: Who assigns you tasks?

Mau: Many beings are involved in that. We are closely connected with the Titans in the Animistic Realm. There are also other entities whom we call our leaders, and under the pressure of God's Will, they direct our actions.

Tobiasz: Can you tell us what tasks you are currently working on?

Mau: We, giants, also have our secrets, but I can tell you that many processes in the mountains are initiated by us. A simple rockslide is usually caused by our actions. Of course, we don't act on our own, as all processes are strictly planned and regulated by the Creator's Will.

Tobiasz: Do you want to add anything more about your tasks and your service?

Mau: This conversation has given you a general understanding of our tasks and what we do in our service. As for how we carry out these tasks, let that remain our secret. Perhaps one day humanity will be worthy of more detailed information.

### 5.3. Master Builders

*We moved on to the next topic in our conversation with the giant Mau.*

Bartosz: According to many accounts and books, you participated in the construction of numerous buildings. Even today, modern construction techniques would not be able to replicate them. Can you expand on this topic?

Mau: In addition to the earthly processes we mentioned in the previous section, we giants also have other fields of activity. One of these is constructing great structures. It is desired that people know the truth, that we are truly the ones responsible for building them.

Bartosz: Many peoples, like the Incas, likely benefited from your help... Did you work at their request?

Mau: The mere requests of those nations or peoples could never be enough. Only if God permitted the construction of a given structure and fulfilled the request would we take action. However, not all buildings were the result of human requests. There were also structures that were gifts from the Light to a certain people, if they deserved it or earned it through their service. There are also buildings that were strictly planned by the Light, and their construction had no connection to any nation or people. One such building is the Great Pyramid in Egypt.



Bartosz: Can you say something about the process of joining large stone objects, which fascinates many researchers? Can you tell us more about the entire construction process?

Mau: As one of the few species, we can directly influence dense matter. This gift allows us to construct objects. During construction, we use special tools, which I prefer not to discuss in detail. We do not reveal all our secrets to humanity, which is why, when building, we often work under the cover of night or fog.

Tobiasz: I have a question unrelated to this section... What is it like to be a giant?

Mau: Thank you for that question! Being a giant is a wonderful thing, Tobiasz. We are filled with joy because we are part of this Creation and can serve our Lord. We are content and delighted with every mission and every assignment, even the smallest task, that the Light assigns us. By carrying out these tasks, we become a useful part of the entire Creation. The fact that our service is pleasing to God makes us happy beings. Your question, Tobiasz, has filled me with joy because I can share with humans how wonderful it is to be a giant serving the Light.

Tobiasz: A beautiful answer! I am touched... Is there anything else you would like to say?

Mau: During our time on Earth, we giants have supported humans many times. The most beautiful result of this support is the numerous structures we have built. It is desired that we speak more about the Great Pyramid, which is the most important structure built by giants. Let our next conversation be about that.

#### 5.4. The Great Pyramid

*Two days later, we resumed our conversation with Mau.*

Bartosz: Hello Mau! One of the structures built by giants in cooperation with humans is the Great Pyramid. We've read books on this subject: "The Great Pyramid Reveals its Secret" by Roselis von Sass and "The Great Pyramid Stone Calendar Decoded: Sphinx Mystery Revealed" by Aikao Virtaa. What can you tell us about this?

Mau: The Great Pyramid is a structure meticulously planned by the Light. None of its dimensions are accidental. It was built over many years, and it was intended to last until the present day. Its secret has been revealed, and the two books you mentioned explain everything. Many giants collaborated with humans during the construction process. It was a large-scale mobilization and a great task for all involved.

Tobiasz: It saddens me that, despite the fact that the truth about this structure and its significance has been discovered and revealed, so few people have come to understand it. The information that truth provides is of great importance and concerns every human being on this planet. I hope that through this book, more people will pay attention to facts that cannot be denied...

Mau: As has been revealed, the Great Pyramid is, in fact, a calendar of future events. The precision of this calendar is so accurate that even the greatest skeptic should consider that a higher power was involved in its planning and design. Many of the events hidden in this calendar have already occurred, most of them, in fact. For example, a key event was the birth and time on Earth of the Son of God, Jesus Christ. However, the most important thing is the foretelling of the so-called Last Judgment, which refers to the time we are living in now.

Tobiasz: As a giant, a being of nature, what would you say to people for whom this information is new? Information that could change their perception of the world?

Mau: You don't have to take what I've said as absolute truth. You should come to your own conclusions through research and investigation. I'm simply providing a spark for more advanced exploration, which anyone interested in this topic should pursue.

Bartosz: I think for those more interested in the subject, we can recommend the two books we mentioned.

Tobiasz: I would like to add that a lot of falsehoods have been spread about the Great Pyramid. First, people have no idea that you giants were involved in its construction. Second, very few are aware of the facts that reveal its true significance... I hope that our book will guide many seekers towards the truth on this topic... Mau, what would you add to conclude this section?

Mau: I want to point out that it is not necessary for modern humans to know everything about the Pyramid. Of course, it is one way to understand the period in world history that humanity currently lives in. What is more important for humans, and far more crucial, is their inner transformation and ensuring that everything they radiate is in harmony with the Will of God.

## 5.5. Questions for the Giant

*Since conversations with giants are rare, we decided to ask Mau questions to learn more about giants and their wisdom.*

Tobiasz: Mau, tell us, what is love to you, as a giant?

Mau: Love is service. He who serves, loves. The fullest expression of love is, therefore, service to the Creator. He who serves the Creator loves Him and expresses this through his actions. Everything done in this way benefits the development of all Creation. Learn to love, humans — love for the Creator — because only this genuine service is the true manifestation of the life that you are.

Bartosz: Can a giant be friends with a human?

Mau: I sense a hidden meaning in the question and understand that you are seeking friends, even among giants. Of course, such friendships are possible. If a person is pure enough and free of vanity, giants can also approach them. We love people who serve the Light, and although it is extremely rare, we can form friendships with such individuals.

Bartosz: Could you become friends with us?

Mau: I see your potential and spiritual purity, so I see no obstacles.

*We smiled.*

Tobiasz: I'm glad to hear that... I have another question: What feelings do you have toward the majority of humanity, who do not serve the Light and are lost in darkness?

Mau: We giants see humanity's decline. It saddens us greatly. We love all people, but we see how they have turned away from the Light and how they treat nature. It is love, Tobiasz, but it is often in its stern form. We are stern because we must be. This is shaped within us by the Power of the Light, which demands this stance.

Tobiasz: I believe humanity will change, and its attitude toward nature will also be transformed. Through this, they will regain their connection with you — giants. Surely there will be beautiful structures built in which you will also participate. Do you know anything about this?

Mau: Yes, Tobiasz. It is God's Will that giants, in the New Kingdom, will draw closer to humanity. Many structures will likely be built, and I know there are such plans. However, humanity has a long road ahead, but that time will come. We are open and waiting for humanity's spiritual rebirth.

Tobiasz: I remember when I first learned that beings of nature, known as giants, exist. It seemed a bit unbelievable and almost like a fairy tale, but I trusted the feelings that told me it was true. I'm sure many people dismiss the possibility of your existence as a myth, while others might be afraid... What would you say about that?

Mau: Our existence is a fact. The fact that people dismiss our existence, and that of other nature beings, as mere fairy tales only reflects their great limitations. We are certainly not as beautiful as flower fairies, and upon first contact, people might indeed be frightened of us. Those who serve the Light will understand that we are exactly as we should be. Creation and the working of God's Will shaped us this way. Our voices, which are deep, may also scare many people, but they are precisely as they need to be. When a person understands that the Creative Will of God shaped us, and we, as products of that Will, act in accordance with it, all fear will disappear. Do not fear us, humans, but show us respect, for our kind fully deserves it.

Tobiasz: It's amazing to me that, through the process of writing our books and Bartosz's gift, I'm in contact with a giant, something I never dreamed of... Giants always seemed lofty and very distant from humanity...

Mau: Contact with us is distant for most of humanity. For many, it will never happen. The fact that Bartosz can speak with us is a great gift and grace from the Light. It is desired that Bartosz's gift brings benefit to all humanity. I know that your books provide this benefit, and I'm convinced that people who are pure within will appreciate them.

Bartosz: Do you smile often?

Mau: Our inner smile accompanies us almost constantly. Serving the Light brings us this joy. Any being that feels useful in Creation carries similar joy within. As for smiles on our faces, that depends on the disposition of each giant. I don't smile very often.

*He then smiled.*

Bartosz: Now you're smiling.

Mau: Yes, Bartosz, I've grown very fond of you, and I can honestly say that your company brings me smiles.

Tobiasz: Do giants pray to the Creator?

Mau: Our service is a form of prayer, but we also pray as an expression of gratitude and, although much less frequently, as requests.

Bartosz: I once received a message that I had contact with you in past lifetimes, and I feel it now.

Mau: You hold great love for us, Bartosz. It is evident. You likely had contact with many giants in the past.

Bartosz: I think we'll end here... Thank you, Mau!

Mau: I feel that my messages in your book have come to an end. However, I feel that our relationship does not end here, and I will visit you again. The Lord has sent me a portion of light as proof that I have fulfilled my task. May this relationship, born from our conversations, bring blessings and benefit to humanity.

Tobiasz: Thank you, Mau! Be a blessed being!

## 5.6. Cosmic Giants

*Another species of nature beings, which could also be called giants due to their size, are entities found in outer space, which we have named cosmic giants. They are a different species from the earth giants. Here is our conversation with one of their representatives, whom we named Tau for the purposes of this book.*

Bartosz and Tobiasz: Welcome, Tau! We are glad to be in contact with you!

Tau: Greetings! Our message to humanity will be brief. Our main concern is that humans know about our existence.

Tobiasz: Please, continue.

Tau: There is certain order in outer space that we maintain. There are many species of beings that you have called cosmic giants. We have numerous tasks that we joyfully fulfill. Our primary responsibility is maintaining order throughout space. This order is governed by God's Laws.

Bartosz: Do you also take care of celestial bodies?

Tau: Yes. However, that is not our primary task. We love every celestial body, as it was God's Will to form it. We provide care and play an active role during the formation of planets. The formation of Earth was also largely our work. We influenced the matter around the star, the sun, in such a way that a planet was formed. Of course, the creation of a planet and the emergence of life on it requires the fulfillment of many shared aspects, and other beings were also involved, but our role in this was significant.

Tobiasz: What is the order you mentioned?

Tau: As the name suggests, order is the enforcement of certain regulations. It is also about ensuring that chaos does not dominate in space. Every phenomenon in space is meticulously planned by the Light. We, the cosmic beings, ensure that this plan is fulfilled. We carry out all the tasks assigned to us by the higher caretakers from the Animistic Realm. As you can imagine, all plans for the dense Material Cosmos are governed by God's Will, and we simply ensure that it is carried out.

Bartosz: As you said, there are many species of you... Do you also regulate processes within entire galaxies, not just planets?

Tau: There are indeed many species of us, and some of the processes — or phenomena, as you better call them — that you mentioned are also regulated by us. The order of the entire Cosmos must be maintained and fulfilled. Every movement of celestial bodies, no matter how small, is meticulously planned and regulated by us.

Tobiasz: Would celestial bodies move without your involvement?

Tau: In principle, we initiate many of the movements of celestial bodies, and afterward, they continue on their designated paths without our further involvement. However, even then, we must ensure that no unwanted collisions occur or that there is no undesirable influence from other celestial bodies. So, you see what we are really overseeing.

Bartosz: Are collisions of celestial bodies, like meteors or asteroids, also planned?

Tau: Of course, Bartosz. Catastrophes such as an asteroid impact on a planet, for example, Earth, are also planned by the Light. One asteroid strike on a planet can lead to the extinction of many species. Usually, this happens because the time for the development of a particular species on that planet has come to an end. Therefore, there is no such thing as coincidence in this process.

Bartosz: Are cosmic catastrophes awaiting Earth?

Tau: That is not within my area of responsibility, and I feel that even if I knew, I wouldn't be able to speak about the details. But based on how I see the matter, I can say that it is a possibility.

Tobiasz: I think your statements have given us a lot. How would you summarize this conversation?

Tau: The awareness that beings also operate in outer space is very important knowledge. It is the will of the Light that people know about us. There is no process or phenomenon in space that is not governed by the Creator's Will. We, cosmic giants, or animistic cosmic beings, ensure that every phenomenon aligns with God's Will, and thus with the plan of the Light.

Tobiasz: Thank you, Tau! Be a blessed being of the Cosmos!

Tau: I see the result of your work in writing these books, and I am very pleased that you are giving so much to the world. I am also glad that you mentioned us. I am filled with joy because I have fulfilled my part of the task and conveyed the truth about us. It is not the time for more detailed descriptions, and the knowledge I have given you is sufficient for now.

Bartosz: I'm glad you enriched our knowledge and our readers' knowledge. Thank you, and I wish you much success in the paths of service you so bravely fulfill.

## 6. Bartosz's Experience

*There is an event we mentioned during our conversation with the Forest Guardian. In 2017, where the current Forest Guardian now resides, there was another who was called to serve at a higher level. Bartosz witnessed this promotion, and we are pleased to describe the event that made this advancement possible.*

Bartosz: It was 2017. At that time, I made my first serious contacts with elves, as well as with the Forest Guardian, who would visit me occasionally. One day, the Guardian was a guest in my room, listening to what I was reading. At that moment, I was reading "The Grail Message – In the Light of Truth", specifically the lecture titled "Thought Forms". As I read, the Guardian became deeply interested in the content. His interest turned into amazement, and every few sentences I read, he would repeat, "Amazing, amazing".
